



- bake for 5-7 minutes. (Cake mix cookies will bake up tall and not spread too much so if you want a flatter cookie, pat the dough balls down a little before baking.)
- 4. Let cool for 2 minutes and then gently press an unwrapped Hershey Kiss into each cookie.

PORK ROLLS

1 onion coarsely grated 2 tsp fennel seeds 1 lb Garlic & Herb pork sausages, casing removed 1 1/2 sheets frozen puff pastry, thawed 1 Egg, lightly whisked

Step 1 Preheat oven to 200°C. Line a baking tray with baking paper. Heat a non-stick frying pan over medium heat. Add onion and 1 tsp fennel seeds. Cook, stirring, for 5 mins or until the onion softens. Cool slightly. Transfer to a bowl with the sausage. Use your hands to mix until combined. Divide into 3 portions.

Step 2 Cut the whole pastry sheet in half. Place 1 pastry half on a clean work surface. Shape 1 portion of sausage mixture into a 3cm x 24cm log. Place along 1 long edge of pastry half. Brush edges of pastry with a little egg. Roll up to enclose the filling. Cut into 4 pieces and place seam-side down on lined tray. Repeat with remaining pastry halves and sausage mixture. Brush with the remaining egg and sprinkle with the remaining 1 tsp fennel seeds.

Step 3 Bake for 25 mins or until the pastry is puffed and golden and the filling is cooked through.

Ingredients

- 1 box devil's food cake mix I prefer Pillsbury
- 2 eggs
- 1/3 C. oil
- 30-40 Hershey Kisses I used the Candy Cane ones but the mint would be great too!

Instructions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees and line cookies sheets with parchment paper.




