



Kai Chi Do literally translates to "Free Spirit Way" or, to say it another way, Way to Free Life Energy. Kai Chi Do is a system of movements utilizing Five Elements combined with music, meditation, and breathwork to free blocked energy. Anyone can do it. The Basic Movements of Kai Chi Do are simple and repetitive. They can be done sitting or standing. We self-regulate and pace ourselves through our breathing. There are 2 breathing techniques that we use: the SA breath- inhale and then exhale with a "SA" and the AH breath- a deep inhale and exhale with an "AH". The Breathwork techniques used in Kai Chi Do accelerate the benefits of the movements, aid circulation, and relax mental barriers. The music is fun and inspirational, increasing the unity of the group. Synchronized movement. Synchronized breath. Makes One Movement, One Breath, One Community.






