

publish a new one each month. This being the Christmas season, we have a special colorful brunch item featured. And don't be afraid to share one of your own favorites for the next issue, just send it to me & we will get it published here next month.

This month's Holiday inspired Special recipe follows:

One-pan Raspberry French Toast

- 1 cup Raspberry jam
- 1 pkg. Cream Cheese cubed
- 2 cups $\frac{1}{2}$ & 1/2
- ½ cup packed lt. brown sugar
- Cooking spray

- 1 loaf French Bread cubed
- 4 large eggs
- 1 tsp ground Cinnamon
- maple syrup & whipped cream
- 1 pint fresh raspberries for top
- 1. Using microwave melt the jam in a small bowl until smooth (about 1 minute) stirring halfway through
- 2. Place ½ of the bread cubes in spray coated baking dish. Sprinkle with cheese cubes and drizzle with melted jam. Sprinkle on remaining bread cubes.
- 3. Whisk the eggs and ½ & ½ together adding in cinnamon & vanilla. Pour over bread mixture. Sprinkle with brown sugar. Cover with foil and refrigerate for 8 hours or overnight
- 4. Preheat oven to 325°F. Bake covered for 25 minutes. Uncover and add whole fresh berries to top. Continue to bake until bread is golden brown, and the mixture is set. (About 20 minutes.) Serve warm with maple syrup and whipped cream.



ID YOU KNOW? Rental parks without an active HOA with mandates established by FL statutes, especially incorporated as LHOA, and a member of the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida) our lobbyist in Tallahassee, seldom see this sort of information. LHOA is voluntary, does not own, manage, make the rules and membership is not included when you buy your home or in our rent! Join. 2022 Membership drive starts on October 1st to December 31st.

As a reminder to new residents, current LHOA Members and those who have not joined the deadline for the 2022 membership (\$15 a year) is December 31st 2021. A small insurance policy premium. Without these funds, the Association will have limited resources to meet its mandates. LHOA will have representatives at the weekly coffee, monthly board meetings and the November/December Member meetings.

What are the LHOA mandates? Be prepared to purchase the park within 90 days of receiving a letter stating that the park is being sold for a different use then a mobile home park. Members have the only vote! Second, the Board requests a meeting with the park owner or representative with 90 days of receiving the rental increase and property tax pass-on plus any issues effecting a majority of members (usually maintenance concerns.) And lastly and no less important be available to Members who have question or issues and desiring information. In your corner as it is the same as ours. LHOA is Florida registered corporation, files taxes and maintains that status each year. One of the few rental HOA's in the county that are incorporated.

LHOA is a member of the FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida.) The FMO is our only lobbying group looking out for resident/owners of all types of rental manufactured homes. The complete register of Officers and Directors is in the front of the Voice and posted on the HOA section of the resident's bulletin board in the laundry/PO box room.

Important for Members is the January Member meeting, to be scheduled, where the protocol for 4 open Director Positions for the following 2 years will be discussed along with the proposed budget for 2022. And, February is the Members Annual Meeting.

Join and maintain your LHOA membership no matter if full time or seasonal.

of Native Americans for the dedication of the Tomb Of The Unknown Soldier in 1921. He gave a short speech in his native tongue in honor of the soldier and the occasion. He placed his war-bonnet and coup stick upon the tomb, which are preserved in a display case in Arlington.

For the 100th anniversary of the Tomb, the Chief Plenty Coups Honor Guard is traveling from Montana to Arlington National Cemetery. he article last month centered on falls and how life changing that can be. A long term resident of our community provided some very strong testimony on living after a significant fall at home. I am sharing her words as so very well said. I hope you will read and listen. "Falling is easy. It's getting up that's the difficult part. I know. Three years ago, while sitting at my bar stool height dining room chair, I nodded off for a while. I woke up on the floor, with

I spent a month at Morton Plant and their rehabilitation facility, but I'll never be the same person I was before my fall."


