

LOBSTER BISQUE

Ingredients:

- 4 Tbsp. butter
- 2 Medium Potatoes, peeled, cleaned, and cubed
- 1 cup Fresh mushrooms, chopped
- 1 stalk Celery, chopped
- 1 Medium Carrot, chopped
- 1/2 Onion, chopped
- 1 tsp. Smoked paprika
- 1/4 cup Flour
- ! 3 cups Seafood broth
- 1 1/2 cups Half-and-half
 - 4 tsp. tomato paste
- 2 Tbsp. squeezed Lemon juice
- 1 pkg. Lobster meat (you can use crab or shrimp meat)
- salt/pepper to taste
- fresh dill for the garnish

Directions:

• In a large saucepan, melt the butter over medium-low heat. Add potatoes, mushrooms, celery, carrot, and onion. Cook and stir until tender, about 10 minutes.

Lobster Bisque prep

- Add smoked paprika and flour, mix well. Stir in the Seafood broth, half-and-half, tomato paste, and lemon juice. Stir until well blended.
- Bring to a boil, then simmer for 15 to 20 minutes, until potatoes are cooked.
- Stir frequently until thickened. Adjust the flavor with salt and pepper. You can pour the mixture into the blender if you like.

Lobster meat

- Add the Lobster meat at the very end, simmer for 5 minutes until heated.
- Garnish with fresh dill, chopped green onions, or your favorites!



THE CURIOSITY CORNER

One Lazy Sunday Morning

In the 1800's, the big western powers were taking advantage of China at every opportunity, ignoring China's objections, to improve their trading positions and their sphere of influence in Southeast Asia. Japan however was a different story. Two centuries of strict seclusion policy by Japan, grudgingly came to an end when Commodore Mathew Perry pried open the door of diplomacy and trade in 1854. This process was not looked upon favorably by many in Japan however, and started a period known as Bakumatsu (1853)

-1868). A period of turmoil within the country, a time by some to settle scores centuries old, primarily between the pro-imperial nationalists and shogunate forces, others fought to expel the foreigners, the barbarians.

Many years of bloodshed finally came to an end in January 1868, when forces led by Satsuma-Chōshū seized the imperial palace in Kyoto, and on the following day placed fifteen-year-old Emperor Meiji on the throne. Three months later the Emperor made public his goals and course of action to modernize Japan, improve the country's moral, and win financial support for the new government. The document was called the Charter Oath. During this period, called the Meiji Restoration, emphasis was placed on economic and military development, providing a means for stability and national development. In about 25 years Japan became the only non-Western, major force world power in East Asia as a result of industrialized economic development.

During this period Japan had been exposed to some of the same type of unscrupulous trade agreements that the western powers were imposing upon China. (China, I believe, was looked upon as sort of a golden goose by the nine large world powers of the day, trying their best to extract special, and unfair, trade and territorial concessions from China.) Japan sent envoys to various countries to renegotiate their unfair trade agreements but to no avail. In an effort to learn more about western culture and their economic practices, Japan sent people to the western countries to be educated. They brought back new ideas and knowledge on which Japan could build and grow its budding empire.

Japan had military conflicts with some of its neighbors in centuries past, but its first military conflict since modernizing was the First Sino-Japanese War, 1894-1895, a military conflict with China over an area of influence on the Korean peninsula. After six months of military defeats China sued for peace. Japan acquired Taiwan, parts of northern China, Manchuria, and expanded their sphere of influence and territorial rights on the Korean Peninsula.

Japan's modernization changed the economy from an agrarian to an industrial manufacturing economy. While Japan could function rather well with an agricultural economy, the industrialized economy highlighted their lack of natural resources. They would have to expand their trade

agreements, and territory, to support the government's goal of expanding the empire.

Just after the beginning of the last century, Japan had become alarmed by Russia's expanding influence and encroachment in parts of China and the Korean Peninsula. Any encroachment by a foreign power into the Korean Peninsula was seen as a national security issue. Diplomatic negotiations were initiated to avoid an armed conflict. Negotiations ceased when it became apparent that a satisfactory compromise could not be reached, and both sides prepared for the inevitable.

The armed conflict began in February 1904 with Japan inflicting a series of devastating naval and land defeats upon the Russian forces over an 18-month period, culminating in the Treaty of Portsmouth in 1905, mediated by Theodore Roosevelt. The treaty gave Japan territory in Manchuria and Korea. Japan's prestige grew as a result of the conflict. It had won the first major, modern naval battle of the 20th century, and became the first Asian country to defeat a western power.

During World War I, Japan aligned itself with the Allied powers. Japan, desiring to expand its empire, primarily restricted its exploits to the holdings of the Central Powers in the Asian theater. Its only participation in the European theater was a dispatched naval fleet to the Mediterranean Sea to aid Allied shipping. Closer to home in July of 1918, Japan agreed to send 12,000 troops to participate in the American Expeditionary Force to Siberia to help the White Russians. Japan did not like the Communists and did not desire a communist country established close to its shores.

The territories taken from the Central Powers during the war, proved that Japan was a military power, and only seemed to fuel its desire to grow its empire, to become as influential on the world stage as the western powers. However, Japan did not possess an abundance of natural resources to fuel its growing national ambitions. The resources had to be purchased from other countries or taken from acquired territories. Japan had been pressuring China, since the late 1890s, to relinquish control of desired territory and other commercial interests to Japan. The United States, while having some reservations about the situation, did not actively oppose the practice because it wanted to protect its own Chinese interests. The decades following World War I saw episodes of conflicting interests between Japan and the United States. These instances, and growing political pressures within Japan, continued to push it further away from the United States.

To reduce its reliance on the United Sates for resources Japan decided to expand into East Asia and Manchuria, taking advantage of the chaotic revolutionary turmoil within China. In 1931, Japan moved into Manchuria (Northeast China) claiming it was liberating a local minority. Later in 1937, not satisfied with Manchuria, Japan formally invaded China. Now the revolutionary combatants of Mao Zedong's communists and Chiang Kai-shek's nationalists became wary allies against a common foe, Japan. Years of escalating negative world opinion, and condemnation by various countries towards Japan's expansion activities in China, was solidified when Japan invaded China and inflicted a series of atrocities such as the Nanking Massacre, also known as the Rape of Nanking.

These instances made it relatively clear to the U.S. that there was a high probability of a future military conflict with Japan. Diplomatic negotiations between Japan and the U.S. was initiated to hopefully prevent such an exchange over competing interests. However with tensions rising between the two countries, Japan's occupation of French Indochina and continued engagement in China, the United States and its allies felt compelled to freeze Japan's

assets and place a total embargo on strategic materials, such as scrap metal and oil that Japan vitally needed to sustain its expansionist war effort.

Facing dwindling domestic reserves of oil and materials, Japan decided to gamble. Japan realized that they could not win a prolonged war with the United Sates. Their only hope was to inflict a devastating blow sufficient enough to have two possible outcomes; convince the U.S. that continuing the conflict would result in unacceptable casualties and decide to leave Japan alone, or that Japan could cripple the U.S. sufficiently enough to give them time to acquire new sources of raw materials and build a strong defensible buffer zone. The government decided to execute a plan proposed by Isoroku Yamamoto, a massive three wave aerial attack on the U.S. Pacific fleet.

On November 26, 1941, the Japanese First Air Fleet set sail towards Hawaii, with the understanding that if negations with the United States were successful, the fleet would immediately return home. On Sunday morning, December 7th, at 6:00 a.m., after having received a coded message days before to "Climb Mt. Nitaka", six carriers turned into the wind, and launched the first wave of 183 planes. The target was Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. At 7:55 a.m. the Japanese planes began their attack. Sailors and civilians were eating breakfast, and colors prepared to be struck, caught totally by surprise with pilots so determined, the main battle line of the Pacific fleet was neutralized in 15 minutes.

Over an approximate period of a couple hours just over 350 planes pummeling the harbor. Japan dealt a severe blow to the Pacific fleet. Three of the nine battleships were damaged beyond repair. Severity of the damage inflicted on the remaining six varied, three had to be refloated before repairs could be made. Sixteen ships that day sustained damage, approximately 2,500 people perished. The reports back to the Japanese fleet apparently indicated that sending the third wave of planes was unnecessary. They had achieved their goal of crippling the



planes was unnecessary. They had achieved their goal of crippling the U.S. Pacific fleet. One can only speculate how the third wave would have affected the U.S. war effort.

The United Sates had tried to remain neutral, out of the conflicts developing around the world. Now it had been pushed into the fray. The day following the Pearl Harbor attack, the United States declared war on Japan. Several Days later on December 11th. Germany declared war on the United States. Six months after the attack, Japan would regret leaving Pearl Harbor's fuel storage tanks intact and missing the opportunity to sink the Pacific fleet aircraft carriers, and not sending the third wave. The fuel left within those tanks would fuel the aircraft carriers and planes, missed that day, to give Japan a decisive defeat at the battle of Midway. Their string of military victories since the turn of the century had come to an end. Japan and the Axis powers would soon find that America had the capability, and fortitude, to help the world reverse their dreams of global conquest. The question: Since the First World War wasn't, will this be the "War to End All Wars"? Will we always have the capability and fortitude to successfully engage and defeat our enemies?






