From Claudi's Kitchen:

Christmas Shortbread Cookies

With only a few ingredients, these Christmas Shortbread Cookies are a simple and delicious addition to your holiday baking!

Prep Time 10 minutes

Cook Time 10 minutes

Additional Time 30 minutes

Total Time 50 minutes

Ingredients:

- 1 cup unsalted butter, room temperature
- 1/4 cup plus 3 tablespoons powdered sugar
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract, optional
- 2-1/3 cups all-purpose four
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons red and green nonpareils
- 1. In a large bowl, add in the butter, powdered sugar, granulated sugar, and vanilla if you're using it.
- 2. Beat on medium with an electric mixer until creamed.
- 3. Add in the flour, salt, and nonpareils. Mix until the flour is incorporated and a stiff cookie dough forms.
- 4. Divide the cookie dough into 2 pieces and press the dough flat. Wrap each piece in plastic wrap and place in the refrigerator for at least 30 minutes to chill.
- 5. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper or a silicone mat.
- 6. Roll the dough out to 1/4-inch thickness on a lightly floured surface. Cut out your cookies and place them on the prepared cookie sheet.
- 7. Bake for 10 to 13 minutes or until the edges are golden brown. (See notes)
- 8. Let the cookies cool for 5 to 10 minutes on the cookie sheet and then transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.
- 9. Store in an airtight container at room temperature.

Notes

Yield: varies Prep Time 10 minutes Cook Time 10 minutes Additional Time 30 minutes Total Time 50 minutes

The bake time can vary depending on the size of your cookie cutter. I recommend keeping an eye on the cookies at the 8-minute mark.

Feel free to add a drizzle of melted chocolate for added pizzaz.

You don't need cookie cutters for this recipe! You can use a knife and cut the cookie dough into sticks, rectangles, or square shapes.



To freeze dough:

You can wrap the dough in a couple of plastic wrap layers and then a layer of aluminum foil and place them in large freezer-safe zip top bags for up to three months. When you are ready to bake, thaw the frozen dough overnight in the refrigerator before using it.

To freeze baked cookies:

Be sure the cookies are cooled completely before freezing! Line the bottom of an airtight freezer-safe container with freezer paper. Arrange an even layer of shortbread across the container's bottom, making sure the cookies do not overlap. Place another piece of freezer paper on top of the first layer.

Add more cookies in an even layer, and cover with freezer paper. Repeat this process of layering until you fill-up the entire container. Ensure the top layer of shortbread is completely covered by the freezer paper, then cover it securely with the lid. Freeze for up to six months. To serve, allow the cookies to thaw to room temperature.

Blue.... Throat Chakra

BLUE CHAKRA

The 5th chakra is the throat chakra and the 1st of the higher centers-associated with communication, self expression, and creativity through sound. It is about personal expression combined with responsibility. Developing the throat chakra means choosing words that bring value to communication.

In addition to sound, this chakra relates to hearing. It is sad that active listening is neglected in today society, and we need to develop the outer ear before the inner ear can be available to us.

By reacquainting yourself regularly with this chakra chart as a prelude to the section on the throat chakra, you will help to keep your mind focused on related issues, including the importance of expressing your emotion and communicating your truth to yourself and others.

Mastering the throat chakra helps us grasp the importance of purifying ourselves by honestly recognizing how we feel and having the confidence to communicate those emotions to others.

CHAKRA CHARACTERISTICS: See which of the following characteristics of excessive (too open), deficient (blocked) and balanced chakra energy you can relate to-and then determine (should you choose) to take the necessary action, using the tools and techniques given here.

TOO OPEN (chakra spins too fast) over talkative, dogmatic, self righteous, arrogant.

BLOCKED (chakra spins sluggishly or not at all) holds back from self-expression, unreliable, holds inconsistent views.



BALANCED (chakra maintains equilibrium and spins at correct vibrational speed) good communication, contented, finds it easy to meditate, artistically inspired.

The throat chakra is located centrally at the base of the neck.

The next time that you meet someone that seems to have trouble expressing themselves, see if their chin is held down, hiding the throat area in a childlike manner. This shows that this person is vulnerable in the 5th throat chakra. Such people must frequently clear their throat because it feels like it is being choked by the truths they are having to swallow. They may speak in an unexpectedly dull, monotonous tone. They may attempt to contribute to group discussions, but because of inarticulation or lack of enthusiasm they are frequently not "heard" by others. These are all clues to a dysfunctional throat chakra.

In its extreme form the negative archetype associated with the throat chakra is the masked self. Here we have someone incapable of opening and honestly expressing feelings. They may wish to refuse an unreasonable (or reasonable) request but say "yes" anyway. Anger and frustration then build up, further blocking the throat chakra, which may manifest itself physically as sore throat, glandular fever, stiff neck, and thyroid problems. The silence is not from lack of communication but lack of truthful expression. By contrast, communicators "walk their talk". They often have wonderful speaking voices which others enjoy listening to.

Communicators recognize their desire to express their hurt or anger but do so in such a way that it doesn't diminish the other person. They integrate both heart and mind in their communication with others.

Exercises for the throat chakra: For a lot of us the neck tends to be one of the areas in which we suffer from stiffness and tension due to stress and poor posture. If this area is hindered in any way stagnancy and blockages occur which also contribute to rigidity in the neck area. These inverted yoga poses help loosen the neck and stimulate the thyroid gland associated with the throat chakra.

- 1. Use a wall for support. Start off by sitting next to the wall.
- 2. Raise your legs so that they are flat against the wall and lie back with your butt against the wall.

Key crystals for the throat chakra are Turquoise, Sodalite, Lapis Lazuli, Celestite and Aquamarine.

Meditations for the throat chakra:

- 1. Sit or lie comfortably and breath slowly and deeply through your nose.
- 2. Tense each set of muscles in turn, from your feet to your head. Feel yourself sink heavily into the floor or chair.
- 3. Now focus on you lower head and neck and imagine a beautiful blue mist washing inside your mouth... bathing your throat cavity... swirling around your ears... caressing your neck..... gliding over your tongue... relaxing your jaw.....so that the area becomes free.
- 4. Be aware of any tension and draw the attention of the blue mist to that area so it can be released.
