

Recipes

Sausage & Pasta One Pot Soup



This soup will warm you up like a blanket during Fall & Winter. So comforting. It cooks all in one pot.

Ingredients

- 2 TBS cooking oil, DIVIDED
- 1 lb pork sausage (I use Jimmy Dean original pork sausage)
- 1 onion, diced
- 3 carrots, diced
- 2 celery, diced
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp black pepper
- 6 cups chicken broth
 - Instructions
- 1. In a large Dutch oven or soup pot heat 1 TBS cooking oil over medium high heat. Add in pork sausage. Break it up and cook until no longer pink. Remove sausage to a bowl and set aside.
- 2. Add an additional TBS of cooking oil to the same soup pot over medium high heat and add diced onion, celery, and carrots. Saute for 5-6 minutes until softened. Add in garlic and cook an additional 30 seconds. Season with salt & pepper.
- 3. Stir in tomatoes, green chilis, and chicken broth. Bring to a boil over high heat. Stir in dry pasta and cream cheese. Place lid on and lower heat to a simmer. Allow to simmer for 12-15 minutes until pasta is cooked through and tender. (Stir pot every so often during cook time to make sure pasta doesn't stick to bottom of pot.) NOTE: add more broth if needed.
- 4. Once pasta is done, turn off burner. Stir in heavy cream. Add all spinach and mix to combine.

Ingredients:

- 1 (16.3-oz) can 8-count refrigerated biscuits 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese (Pillsbury Grands)
- 6 eggs
- 3 Tbsp milk
- 1 Tbsp butter
- 8 slices bacon, cooked and chopped

Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F. Spray a 9-inch round cake pan with cooking spray.
- 2. In a large nonstick skillet, melt butter over medium heat. Whisk together eggs and milk. Pour egg mixture into skillet and let set slightly. Reduce heat to medium-low, and stir occasionally until scrambled eggs reach desired consistency. Season with salt and pepper.
- 3. Flatten each biscuit round to about 1/4-inch thickness. Top each round of dough with scrambled eggs, bacon, and cheese. Bring the edges of the dough together and pinch to seal. Place in pan seam-side-down.
- 4. In a small saucepan combine butter, brown sugar, mustard, Worcestershire and poppy I seeds. Bring to a boil and pour over biscuits.
- 5. Bake 20 to 25 minutes, until the biscuits are golden and cooked through.

Notes: Can substitute turkey bacon, sausage, or ham for bacon. Can use any cheese you prefer.


- 1. Line a baking sheet with an edge to it with parchment paper or tin foil. Place a wire cooling rack on top of the parchment paper.
- 2. Lay out how many cracker you want on to the wire rack leaving space in between. (How many crackers will be determined by how many you need for appetizers.)
- 3. Cut bacon slices into thirds. Put each 1/3 of a piece on top of the cracker. (How much bacon you need will be determined on how many bacon crackers you want.}
- 4. Place a generous amount of brown sugar in a mound on top of each bacon piece. Sprinkle black or ceyenne pepper on brown sugar.
- 5. Bake in a preheated oven at 350 degrees for 15-25 minutes until desired bacon texture is met.

Pineapple Cheese Ball - A Great Holiday Appetizer

Ingredients

- 2 (8 oz) pks cream cheese, room temperature 1/3 jar roasted red pepper, diced fine
- 1 1/2 cups crushed pineapple, drained
- 2 green onions sliced thinly

- 1/2 tsp Black Pepper

Instructions

- 1. In a large bowl combine together cream cheese, pineapple, green onions, bell pepper, roasted red bell pepper, salt, pepper, and 1/2 cup chopped pecans.
- 2. Place 2 sheets of plastic wrap on work surface to make 1 large plastic sheet. Place mixture into center of plastic wrap and using the plastic to help form the mixture into a ball shape. Keep mixture in the plastic wrap by gathering the ends of the plastic and twisting it to get the tight all shape. Place into a small bowl to help keep shape while placing in refrigerator to set up.
- 3. After 2 hours, remove cheese ball from refrigerator. Place the remaining chopped pecans on a clean work surface or onto parchment paper. Remove plastic from cheese ball. Place cheese ball in center of chopped pecans and roll until completely covered. Place on a serving plate with crackers.


