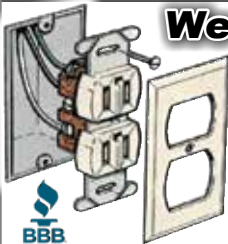

DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 10 FOR CANDIDATES TO FILE NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK ELECTION TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

MEET THE CANDIDATES EVENT PLANNED FOR DECEMBER 17

Each year, three seats on the nine-member Board of Directors are open for election. Directors serve for a three-year term.

In January 2022, terms of three board directors are expiring: Greg Hanke, Dick Lawler and Bob Newport (director and treasurer).

The staggering of terms allows the board to retain six directors and their knowledge and experience, while still gaining new members each year.

December 15, 4 p.m., final candidate bios and campaign statements due at the Office.

After Richard Thomas, Palm Hill Manager, LCAM, verifies the list of candidates, a final list will be publicized in all Palm Hill communication channels.

December 17, Meet the Candidates Event, tentatively scheduled as an in-person event from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the North Clubhouse.

Shareholders should stay alert for updated announcements through the Palm Hill communication channels: webmaster email blasts, Ch. 732 and website announcements.

Plans are under way for the Meet the Candidates Event to be broadcast on Channel 732 and through ZOOM. Invitations to the ZOOM event will be sent out by email blast from the Webmaster prior to the event.

Mailings: To meet notification requirements: For those shareholders who have NOT signed up to receive emails through the online voting website, mailings about the candidates and annual meeting will be sent out from the Palm Hill Office to the addresses of record on **December 20**. Those who have signed up to receive emails will receive the information on **December 20**.

January 19, 2022: All ballots and the proxy notice in that mailing must be returned to the Office by January 19; earlier if possible. The proxy notice returns will ensure a quorum for the annual meeting to commence as scheduled.

PALM HILL COUPLE CREATE LEGACY OF MUSIC IN THEIR "SANTA'S WORKSHOP"

Melvin and Marbeth Bingman were busy in November building 15 dulcimers from kits purchased online. The dulcimers are Christmas gifts for 15 grand and great grandchildren.

It was Melvin's idea to build the dulcimers for the Christmas presents.

The dulcimer is a stringed instrument with folk music origins, and can be played flat on a table, on the floor, or held on one's lap. The dulcimer sounds are made by plucking with fingers, a stick or pinging with a "hammer".

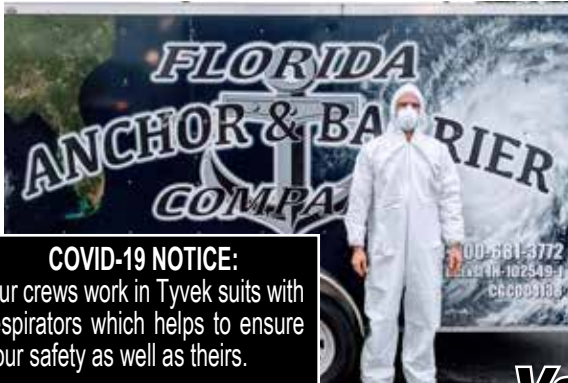

Dulcimers are considered to be one of the easiest instruments to learn how to play, making them ideal for beginners and children who wish to play an instrument. They are relatively quiet, and the music is relaxing.

APPALACHIA ORIGINS

According to the internet site cmuse.org, the dulcimer was developed during the early 1800s in the Appalachian Mountains among the Irish and Scottish immigrants. Some historians believe it can be traced back to the ancient lyre.

The instrument enjoyed a popular revival in the 1950s when Kentuckian Jean Ritchie, a Rhodes Scholar, took the dulcimer from her mountain home to New York City. While there she met and made music with Doc Watson. Later, recording artists Joni Mitchell and Cyndi Lauper used the dulcimer on some of their recordings.

Marbeth's fascination with the dulcimer began many years ago.

"Melvin and I went to see Uncle Sherman Wooton, who was making rocking chairs at The Museum of Appalachia in Norris, Tennessee. It was the fall festival. Harrison Ambrose was displaying and playing his dulcimers in the stand across from Uncle Sherman. I heard the music and fell in love. Melvin bought me one for my birthday. Mr. Ambrose played it and told me that he put the music in. "Now go home and play until you get the music back out," Marbeth remembers him telling her.

"Well, it took me 10 years and an Elderhostel catalog to get the music back out," she said.

MUSICAL FAMILY LEGACY

Marbeth learned to play at the Elderhostel that summer in Nancy, Kentucky. Later that year Marbeth discovered a group playing dulcimers at Heritage Village in Largo and joined them. She then studied with Susan Boyer-Haley in Clearwater. Two of her grandsons joined her in those lessons.

"That was 20 years ago. I still love my dulcimers," Marbeth says.

The love of the dulcimer and music is being passed down through their extended family. Twin daughters play, and a family photo shows a baby granddaughter "playing" the washboard.

"Between us we have nine children, 20 grandchildren, 25 great-grandchildren and one great-great granddaughter. Only 15 of them got orders for dulcimers," Marbeth said.

"It's a labor of love and it's wonderful to work on this together."

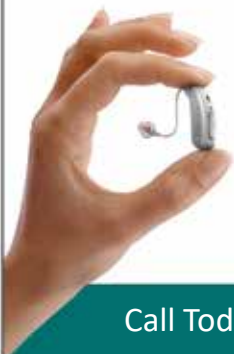

UPDATED PROTOCOLS EFFECTIVE 11-1-2021

Covid Restrictions

In assessing the current corona virus situation and based on the current numbers, I lifted restrictions and facilities were opened effective November 1, 2021.

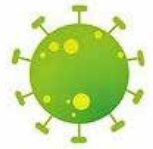
There are no mask mandates in force, all businesses I have dealt with, (Walgreens, Publix, Lowes, Home Depot, Restaurants. They had no mask requirements and no social distancing.

Cruise Lines have started back up out of Tampa, the Border, Canada and U.S. is open as of November 8.

Many of the residents here have had both shots and the booster shot.

To be prudent, we recommend that you still follow the CDC Guidelines:

- Wearing a mask especially in large crowds is highly recommended
- Social Distance when possible
- Wash/Sanitize hands frequently
- Monitor Symptoms, Fever, Chills, loss of smell and/or taste and seek medical attention if exhibiting any of these symptoms.



We will continue to monitor the state and county numbers on a daily basis and will adjust restrictions as necessary.
