

elvin and Marbeth Bingman were busy in November building 15 dulcimers from kits purchased online. The dulcimers are Christmas gifts for 15 grand and great grandchildren.

It was Melvin's idea to build the dulcimers for the Christmas presents.

The dulcimer is a stringed instrument with folk music origins, and can be played flat on a table, on the floor, or held on one's lap. The dulcimer sounds are made by plucking with fingers, a stick or pinging with a "hammer".

Dulcimers are considered to be one of the easiest instruments to learn how to play, making

them ideal for beginners and children who wish to play an instrument. They are relatively quiet, and the music is relaxing.

#### APPALACHIA ORIGNS

According to the internet site cmuse.org, the dulcimer was developed during the early 1800s in the Appalachian Mountains among the Irish and Scottish immigrants. Some historians believe it can be traced back to the ancient lyre.

The instrument enjoyed a popular revival in the 1950s when Kentuckian Jean Ritchie, a Rhodes Scholar, took the dulcimer from her mountain home to New York City. While there she met and made music with Doc Watson. Later, recording artists Joni Mitchell and Cyndi Lauper used the dulcimer on some of their recordings.

Marbeth's fascination with the dulcimer began many years ago.

"Melvin and I went to see Uncle Sherman Wooton, who was making rocking chairs at The Museum of Appalachia in Norris, Tennessee. It was the fall festival. Harrison Ambrose was displaying and playing his dulcimers in the stand across

from Uncle Sherman. I heard the music and fell in love. Melvin bought me one for my birthday. Mr. Ambrose played it and told me that he put the music in. "Now go home and play until you get the music back out," Marbeth remembers him telling her.

"Well, it took me 10 years and an Elderhostel catalog to get the music back out," she said.

#### MUSICAL FAMILY LEGACY

Marbeth learned to play at the Elderhostel that summer in Nancy, Kentucky. Later that year Marbeth discovered a group playing dulcimers at Heritage Village in Largo and joined them. She then studied with Susan Boyer-Haley in Clearwater. Two of her grandsons joined her in those lessons.

"That was 20 years ago. I still love my dulcimers," Marbeth says.

The love of the dulcimer and music is being passed down through their extended family. Twin daughters play, and a family photo shows a baby granddaughter "playing" the washboard.

"Between us we have nine children, 20 grandchildren, 25 great-grandchildren and one great-great granddaughter. Only 15 of them got orders for dulcimers," Marbeth said.

"It's a labor of love and it's wonderful to work on this together."

### **UPDATED PROTOCOLS EFFECTIVE 11-1-2021**

**Covid Restrictions** 

n assessing the current corona virus situation and based on the current numbers, I lifted restrictions and facilities were opened effective November 1, 2021.

There are no mask mandates in force, all businesses I have dealt with, (Walgreens, Publix, Lowes, Home Depot, Restaurants. They had no mask requirements and no social distancing.

Cruise Lines have started back up out of Tampa, the Border, Canada and U.S. is open as of November 8.

Many of the residents here have had both shots and the booster shot.
