#### **President's Report** By Ray Lamoureux #9

The 2022 budget meeting was held in the clubhouse for the first time since the virus has started, the attending residences were required to wear face masks, and everyone wore them thru out the meeting. There were a lot of questions on the raise in maintenance fees that was due to a large increase in insurance, water, sewer, and trash. The maintenance fee is now \$188.00 per month.



The reserves were also discussed about how they are funded in someof the reserves. The share buyback reserve is not used anymore because we can't issue mortgages for the share. There is \$298,000.00 in that reserve to only buy back shares that we don't do anymore. To move that money around other reserve items we need a vote from the shareholders. The vote will be on the ballot for the election of officers for the board in February. The vote needed is fifty percent plus one to move that money, but it must stay in the reserves.

The intent to run for the board will be mailed out by January tenth. The intent has to be returned before the end of the month there are two positions up for elections please consider running we have a lot of new people in the community and their input would be welcome on the board.

The board had the entire sewer lines camera to make sure there were no blockages. They found a collapsed pipe by the rear laundry that needs to be dug up and replaced. They also found blockages on First Avenue, Third Street and Fourth Street. All these problem areas will be addressed in the near future.

We have a large dead tree on First Street that needs to be removed and the tree is not completely on our property. It is going to take a crane to remove the part that is on our side of the fence.





#### **Medicare Scam Season**

T's Medicare open enrollment season through December 7. And while Medicare scams happen year-round, open enrollment season is a time when Medicare scammers, who love to take advantage of all of the attention being paid to Medicare, are particularly active. Here are a few examples of common scams related to Medicare and open enrollment.



#### **How It Works**

- You get a call claiming that Medicare is sending out new "plastic" Medicare card. All you need to do is verify your Medicare card number.
- You receive a call or home visit from a home health care agency offering to sign you up for services that Medicare will pay for.
- You get a call or see an ad offering state-of-the-art braces to relieve joint pain that Medicare will pay for.
- You get a call from a Medicare plan, offering a special "deal" on a new plan during open enrollment, perhaps along with a free gift or limited-time offer.

#### What You Should Know

- Medicare is sticking with the current paper card and is not sending out plastic cards.
- An ad or a call offering you free equipment, tests, or services from Medicare is a scam. They are only covered by Medicare under your Doctor's prescription.

#### What You Should Do

- Hang up on anyone calling and claiming they need to issue you a new plastic Medicare card. It's a scam.
- Only share your Medicare number with trusted healthcare providers, and never with someone who calls you out of the blue.
- Visit the AARP Fraud Resource Center to learn more about <u>Medicare scams and Medicare card scams</u>.




