



Listening to the groundhog

ost of us know the story of Groundhog Day. On Feb. 2, the legend goes, a groundhog that comes up out of its burrow to check the weather will go back inside if it sees its shadow, and winter will continue for six more weeks. But if the sky is cloudy and it casts no shadow, the harsh winter weather is over.

Punxsutawney, Pa., hosts the best-known Groundhog Day event, featuring "Punxsutawney Phil" (who gained fame in the 1993 film Groundhog Day), but other towns in Pennsylvania and Maryland hold similar celebrations.

Where does the legend come from? It may have origins in ancient European beliefs involving a badger or a bear as a weather forecaster, as well as the pagan festival Imbolc, whose traditions point to a bear or a serpent as a herald of good or bad weather. In the United States, Groundhog Day can be traced back to 1841, when a Pennsylvania shopkeeper wrote in his diary that that Candlemas day (Feb. 2) was the day on which, "according to the Germans, the Groundhog peeps out of his winter quarters and if he sees his shadow he pops back for another six weeks nap, but if the day be cloudy he remains out, as the weather is to be moderate."

So keep an eye out for the groundhog's report, and dress appropriately.

Love is in the air on Feb. 14

Ithough today the word "Valentine" is synonymous with love, several early Christian martyrs shared the name. The Valentine most closely associated with the holiday was a priest who lived in Rome in the 3rd century. The Emperor Claudius II had outlawed marriage, under the theory that married men didn't

make fierce soldiers. When Valentine continued to perform weddings, Claudius had him put to death.

In another version of the story, Valentine attempted to convert Claudius to Christianity while in prison and was executed. In other tales, Valentine healed his jailer's blind daughter, and the two fell in love. According to legend, Valentine's final letter to her was signed, "From your Valentine."

Valentine's Day began to take off in the late 18th century, when a British publisher brought out a book called The Young Man's Valentine Writer, full of sentimental poems for lovers unable to compose their own romantic messages.

Better printing technology and lower postal rates combined to make holiday cards more convenient. The first line of Valentine's Day cards was launched in 1847 by Esther Howland, whose father owned a book and stationery store in Worcester, Mass.

Valentine's Day is celebrated today in many countries around the world, including the United States, Canada, Mexico, the United Kingdom, France, and Australia.

Pandemic eats away at savings and security for many

The economic impact of the pandemic has taken its toll on savings in the United States for many people, according to a poll commissioned by the Fund Our Future coalition and DailyPay. The survey of more than 2,000 U.S. adults found that 36% of those with incomes below \$50,000 have less money in savings than they did before the pandemic struck; only 13% have more. On the other hand, 41% of Americans with incomes of \$100,000 or more reported having greater savings than before; only 20% have less.



Understandably, 58% of Americans say they're worried about their financial situation, including 71% of those 18–34, 70% of renters, and 67% of people whose household income is under \$50,000.

Trust in science on the upswing

The COVID-19 has raised trust in science and scientists, according to a report in The New York Times. A survey of 119,000 people in 113 countries by the Welcome Trust, a health research foundation in London, found that approximately 80% trust science "some" or "a lot," and close to 75% say the same about scientists.

In the United States, 54% of Americans said they had "a lot" of trust in scientists, a nine percent increase from 2018, when the last survey was conducted. Trust in scientists increased by at least 10% in regions like East Asia, Latin America, Eastern Europe, and Southeast Asia.

Teen drug use down during pandemic

ne positive side effect of the pandemic seems to be that alcohol and drug use by teenagers fell dramatically, according to a study funded by the National Institutes of Health. Alcohol use decreased among eighth graders from 20.5% in 2020 to 17.2% in 2021, the research found, along with a decrease from 40.7% to 28.5% among 10th graders, and a smaller decrease for 12th graders, from 55.3% to 46.5%. Marijuana use fell from 11.4% to 7.1% among eighth graders, and use of drugs other than marijuana decreased from 7.7% to 4.6% in the same age group.

But quite often if you follow what it is that really fulfills and interests you, the rest falls into place."
