



bjective: To provide St. Petersburg Free Clinic in Pinellas County women residents with a gently used purse and any personal female items such as toiletries, personal care items, socks, scarfs, lap blankets, necklaces, bracelets, etc.

The only items NOT acceptable are medications and alcohol-based mouthwash.

Delivery: Week of February 7, 2022 for distribution on Monday, February 14, 2022.

Background of St. Petersburg Free Clinic: The Baldwin Women's Residence provide safe transitional housing where those who are experiencing homelessness and recovering from substance use can gain stability in their recovery while obtaining and maintaining employment, saving money and rebuilding relationships. Residents must have 30 days of sobriety and lack permanent housing to qualify for our programs.

Many of the residents at any given time are employed and all are working toward achieving three months of savings.

Unique aspects of our residential program include no limit on length of stay. Some residents are ready to move out within a few months. Others are ready to move out in a year. We are willing to take the time necessary to ensure someone is truly ready to re-enter the "real world" successfully.




