





LHRO Board Meeting – December 9, 2021

(not official minutes, just notes from Piper Editor)

pen Forum – Mike Burgan (webmaster) said our website has been very busy the last 30 days – 3,554 visitors, half are return visitors, half are new, the Homes for Sale is busiest page with 506 hits in 30 days.



Sharon Shedd said many people are asking about planting trees or installing benches for Memorials of those lost. We are running out of space for these items and so she is researching doing bricks with names and dates engraved on them. More info to come. JoLynn Kendzora questioned the confusion regarding our share situation. This will be addressed either at the Jan 13 Members meeting or have a separate meeting. Judy Walling asked if there are grants or infrastructure money available to the park for fixing things like the drains or water lines. She also questioned what to do about the wild cat situation. Brenda Boudreau said there are about 3 adult and 9 kittens in the park. A group called Meow Now will come and trap them, take them and Test, Neuter, Vaccinate and Release (TNVR) and clip ears so we know they've been attended to, then release them back into the park. For them to do this, we need to give them food and water. Brenda would run the program, they would like a \$35 donation per cat. (Ed note: the issue is our rules do not allow feeding of animals of any kind at any time.) A meeting will be held in January to discuss this more in depth. Jeff Littleton said that the drainage problem is done, looks good, and at the time of this article is published grass is coming in nicely.

Presidents Report: Susan Zerbe said there will be no election on January 13 as no new people volunteered to be on the board so all old officers will stay. There is one director position open. She thanked Karen Larrimore for her service on the board, as Karen is leaving the park. Sue also said that infrastructure is part of our reserves.

Managers Report: Clarified that the Lake Highlander Buildings belong to the residents, but running the buildings is up to the Board (including pictures on the walls). The swan picture is not going back up. She also asked, Please DO NOT unplug anything at the clubhouse. Someone did and it messed up the cameras for days before it was figured out. Also, please take care of your homes and mailboxes. If you have an old plastic mail box that has seen better days, please go to the office and get a new one with new nameplate for \$25. The mold issue in the office has been fixed. Needed a ridge vent, rest of buildings were tested and are ok. Political flags – you have a right to fly it, but no signs on lawns. Storm drain is complete, grass is being taken care of and the new drains are 2" bigger.

Kathy Hartwell, Treasurer's Report – no written report but we're in good shape, budgets

on track, no problems. Board needs to vote on budget for 2022, Steve 2nd, no further discussion, passed unanimously. We are about \$45,000 to the good for the 2021 budget as of October 31. Audit coming in January 2022.

No standing committees report, no new business, meeting adjourned.

Lack of knowledge fuels health care worries

Te're all worried about the cost of medical care, whether we've got insurance or not. Business Wire reports that 75% of people with health insurance are nervous about suffering financial problems because of medical bills, only slightly less than the uninsured 77% who are just as worried.



The MITRE-Harris Poll Survey on Health Insurance Literacy and Perception found that 47% of people have experienced not having their insurance pay for as much as they expected, 42% have discovered that a procedure wasn't covered, and 33% didn't realize that a doctor or facility they used was out of network.

The problem may be our lack of understanding of health coverage. The survey found that 53% of people say they understand their plan only "somewhat," with just 33% feeling they know the details of their coverage "completely." Twenty-six percent said they never check what's covered ahead of time. Trying to figure out what is covered is the most frustrating aspect of health care to 28%, along with finding someone to answer their questions (20%), and determining whether a physician or hospital is or isn't in their network (20%).


