- 2. Lentils- provide good amounts of fiber, magnesium, and potassium.
- 3. Oatmeal- contain complex carbohydrates, as well as water soluble fiber. This helps to slow down digestion and help stabilize levels of blood glucose. Oatmeal is also a great source of folate and potassium. It has been known to lower cholesterol levels and help reduce cardiovascular risk factors.

- 4. Fruits and Vegetables- Fruits and vegetables contain phytonutrients which are compounds that reduce the risk of heart disease, diabetes, and some cancers. Broccoli has a compound called sulforaphane, which has anti inflammatory qualities and anti cancer factors. Most fruits and vegetables ae excellent sources of antioxidants which combat free radicals, which are very damaging to the body. So think apples, berries, kale spinach, squash. Those Ibises!

ou've seen them around—white birds with long curved orange bills that are often dirty at the tips. The American White Ibis is found year-round in Florida. They are often seen in flocks. If you drive south on McMullen Booth Rd in the morning, you can often see flocks on the playing fields to the west.



Although the White Ibis is a wading and shore bird that historically feeds in mudflats, marshes, and mangroves, it has learned that plenty of food can be found in lawns, such as at golf courses, subdivisions, and sports fields. Wet areas are best for foraging, so they are often out after rain. They probe the earth with that long bill, finding grubs and other crawlers. They also help to aerate the lawn while poking around.

Immature Ibises are brown, and you might think a young Ibis is a Limpkin. But Limpkins have shorter, thicker bills and those distinctive white arrowhead markings on their wings. Mature Ibises are all-white but have four ink-black wingtips on each wing that are usually visible only when they fly.

Over the past several months I've seen a lone White Ibis near Dove Lake, and I've also seen small groups taking a stroll from lawn to lawn. I often wonder about that loner Ibis. Does it have trouble flying? Or does it just need some solitude? In any case, it's best not to feed Ibises, since human food such as bread is just not good for them—even if it's gluten free!
