

irst, I would like to thank everyone that contributed articles, recipes, etc. If you don't see it in this issue, I will use it the following month. Please keep them coming, remember News & Views is printed every month, and can be read online when you return north for the summer.

Please check the main shut off for the water to your mobile home. If it is leaking, or the handle is broke off, etc. Please notify me so I can get it on the maintenance work list. If you should have a water issue, it could prevent us from having to shut off part of the park to fix it. This valve shuts off the water from the park supply to your mobile. The park is responsible up to this shutoff; if you need to hire a plumber to replace a toilet or fix a leak, they can not do it unless we can shut off the water supply just to your mobile. Shutting off any section of the park for repairs needs to be scheduled unless it is an emergency. The park has 3 main shutoffs.

By the time this article goes to print, Mr. Larson will have okayed having a new pool heater installed (this is 1 week from the old one going bad to having a new one). He never hesitates if something needs to be replaced. I am also in the process of getting quotes on having the rest of the palm trees trimmed; once I a choose a company the work will be scheduled. During the rent committee meeting, he promised he would get the 12th street parking lot resurfaced but the contractor he has been using is about 6 months behind in his work, so he is looking into another company. I say all this because most residents do not know what goes on "behind the scenes." Yes, we have annual increases, but he is a businessman, and the park bills increase the same as everyone else's.

With all that being said, to date 10% of the rent checks have been for the wrong amount. Simple math.....add \$20 to what you were paying!

Remember that there is an activities calendar in the cabinet by the back entrance to the clubhouse; I will make a monthly schedule for February and March and have them posted. Just remember that I cannot account for last minute changes and additions!

BOOK REPORT

on Pendleton is sometimes referred to as the father of action/ adventure genre. In 1969 he launched the Mack Bolan Series. And the rest is history. He also wrote the Joe Cop, private eye series and Ashton Ford, psychic detective series. In fact, he has written mystery, crime fiction, action/adventure, suspense, and even comic script! In his career he has published over 125 books, into 25 foreign languages and over two hundred million copies! He has written under two different pen names Dan Britain and Stephen Gregory.

Don was born in Little Rock, Arkansas in 1927. He died in Arizona in 1995. He served in the US Navy during World War II and the Korean War. His first book was published in 1957 but he did not quit his aerospace engineer job until 1967 to become a full-time writer.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

CHOCOLATE GOOEY BUTTER COOKIES

Ingredients:

- 1 8 oz. brick of cream cheese, room temperature.
- 1 stick butter, room temperature.
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 (18 oz) box moist chocolate cake mix (Can make this a diabetic recipe by using a sugarfree cake mix)
- Confectioner's sugar, for dusting

Directions:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F

In a large bowl with an electric mixer, cream the cream cheese and butter until smooth. Beat in the egg and vanilla. Beat in the cake mix. Cover and refrigerate for 2 hours to firm up so that you can roll the batter into balls. Roll the chilled batter into Tbsp. sized balls and then roll them into powdered sugar, if desired. Place on an ungreased cookie sheet, 2 inches apart. Bake 12 mins. The cookies will remain soft and gooey. You can sprinkle them with powdered sugar, if desired.

Some of the benefits of our HOA are evident every year when the Park owner determines the lot rental rates for the upcoming year. For example, the Embassy HOA has a "Rent Review" committee of up to 5 homeowners from the Park. Florida law states that the Park Owner must give ninety days' notice of any rental increase to all homeowners. Our "Rent Review" committee can review this proposed increase, and if the increase seems excessive, the committee can compel the Park owner to attend a meeting with them and justify the increase. If this committee is not satisfied with the explanations given by the Park owner, the HOA can apply to the State of Florida for a mediator to be appointed. We have been very fortunate here at Embassy to have Mr. Larson listen to our concerns over the years, and as a result, our rents are among the lowest in Pinellas County. We have faith that this relationship with Mr. Larson will continue. We have seen several instances where other parks in our area without a HOA have been sold to large corporations, and this was soon followed by large rental increases-from \$100 to \$200 per month or more are common-and the residents could do nothing about it except pay the increase. If these parks had a HOA, the new owners would have to justify these increases.

There are also other benefits to having a HOA. If the Park owner decides to sell the Park, the HOA must be given the right to form a corporation or co-op and match the offer (i.e., the right of first refusal) There have been instances where the residents of other Parks in our area have done just that (i.e., Donovan's MHP for one). Our HOA has a legal fund to fight in court (if need be) issues that pertain the Park as a whole. (An argument with a neighbor would not qualify for access to this fund-the issue would have to pertain to the whole Park.)

The Embassy HOA elects eight Board members to serve alternating two-year terms. These eight members then fill the Executive positions of the HOA from within their ranks. Because of Covid, our normal sequence of meetings has been changed. We have postponed our Annual General Meeting date to Tuesday, February 8 at 10:00 a.m.-when we will be accepting nominations to replace three retiring executive members (Al Morrison, Mary Ann Casey, and Liz Wicklund). There will be a second meeting two weeks later – Tuesday, February 22nd at 10:00 a.m. in the Clubhouse for the election of residents to join the Board of Directors.

Because there have been many new residents welcomed into our Park during the past couple of years, we are updating our HOA Membership list. We invite all homeowners of Embassy to join the HOA. Please consider joining if you are not already a member. There is no cost to join (i.e., there are no membership fees!). All you have to do to join is provide a copy of your mobile home title to the Credentialing Officer (Currently Jessie Buchholtz). If you are a member and cannot make a meeting, please fill out a proxy appointing a current member to have your vote for any matters that come up that require a vote (except voting for the Board of Directors, you must be there in person) Proxies are available from any current board member or there are some in the Park office. Come to our February 8th meeting for complete details.
