VICE PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENT

t is here, Election Time. As your outgoing VP, I would like to thank everyone for all the support you have given me throughout my term.

I would like to inform everyone on how the Elections are conducted:

A Ballot has been constructed for the positions available with the members who are running. This Ballot will only be available at the election, meaning no absentee votes. If your name is on the Title/Deed you are allowed to cast a Vote. Members who are voting must sign in to vote and if questioned, be able to show proof of eligibility. The nominating committee will have these Ballots and hand them to every member eligible to vote. This is a secret voting process. Members will, one at a time, place their Ballot into a secured container. Once all the voting is completed, the nominating committee will count the votes and determine the winners.

They will announce the winners during the meeting. If there is a tie, then the tie breaking process will take effect. After the meeting, the nomination committee will be dissolved. At this time, the new Officers will take the Oath of Office and be sworn in. They will have their first Executive meeting in April.




