INTERVIEW WITH TIM BURGNER, "Hi-Lites" Editor

WHEN DID YOU BECOME EDITOR OF THE "Hi-Lites?"

y first edition was Jan., 2017 - a short 5 years ago. I inherited this job from Anne Scott who had been the editor for six (6) years. Anne announced that she was looking for someone to take the job. No one had stepped-up. One Sunday, Anne was walking with a friend on 4th street. I stopped her and explained that I had just ordered a refurbished Mac laptop on ebay. I told her that if it worked, I would take the editor's job. It did work and as "they" say, "The rest is history!"

HOW LONG DO YOU PLAN TO CONTINUE AS EDITOR?

What time is it? (Ha Ha)...Tom Finnegan has been doing his newsletter in WW 1 for 20 years! I don't see myself doing it that long. Honestly, I don't know how long I'll do it. Anne warned me that it was a "thankless job." There is a lot of "discouragement." The most frustrating part is sending out emails and receiving no reply. By now, I pretty much know who will respond and who won't before I send them something. I remember when I wrote Artie Robinson's dedication writing that he ALWAYS replied to my emails which is a 'BIG DEAL" to me.

SO WHY DO YOU KEEP DOING IT?

I do have my "faithful contributors" who ALWAYS send me something for the magazine. Many times they will also send notes of encouragement and thanks which has kept me going. I have learned a LOT on how to use my new MacBook Air - 4 years old now. That has been probably the best part of this job. I can now routinely do things that I had NO idea how to do 5 years ago. I remember telling people when I first began that I wanted the "Hi-Lites" to look like a



"professional" publication. There is a HUGE difference between what is sent out today vs. what what sent out 5 years ago! When I first began, my goal was to get 200 people on the email list. It is now over 300.

WHAT IS YOUR PHILOSOPHY?

I make an effort to get a **LOT** of people Involved and acknowledge them for their contributions to the magazine. Recently, the magazine was divided into MANY departments. I am hopeful that more people will adopt one or more "orphan" departments and <u>be in charge of them monthly</u>. The goal is to get *many* different people involved in the magazine.

I try to treat this as a "real job." When someone sends me something, I make sure they know I received the item and they are appreciated for having sent it. Every article, picture, cartoon is credited to the person who sent it. In short, this is not my magazine, it is **YOURS**. I have always made it a point to send replies to people ASAP. (I always laugh when someone sends me something and makes it a point to ask me to please let them know I received it. I tell them, "IF you don't hear back from me, that means I never received it." I **ALWAYS** reply to my emails and texts very quickly.

WHY DO YOU CALL IT A MAGAZINE?

The published park edition is now a newsletter. It has all of the written articles. It is full of ads instead of pictures and cartoons. The email edition is *FULL* of pictures, cartoons, articles and *NO* ads. It is always over 100 pages. It truly is a magazine with 23 separate departments.

WHY THE MEMORY BOOK?

Our park has done very little with remembering the people who started this park. There are two plaques in the clubhouse with names . I wanted people to be remembered in the park. The *Memory Book* puts into pictures and words the important events and the park residents so they WILL be remembered. There are still people who have spent MANY hours doing things for the park over many years. Unless they do a "*Meet Your Neighbor/Neighbour*," they will have no tangible legacy which I feel is a shame.

WHAT DOES THE FUTURE HOLD?

It appears that the park is going back to the days where the same people are doing

EVERYTHING in the park. Before the virus, that had changed. More people were getting involved. Now we are backsliding. I have sat in ROC meetings listening to people in the back of the room "making fun" of things that were being said by the ROC board members.. I'm thinking, "What do **YOU** do for this park?" These people get no pay, yet they spend **MANY** hours working for the board. The day will come when no one will be willing to be on the board. I **HOPE** I'm wrong. People had to be appointed to the board this year because not enough "stepped up" to have an election! The people who take on these park jobs deserve **MUCH** credit....definitely **NOT** ridicule.



GOT RATS?

RODENT CONTROL

o nuts, seeds or food of any kind are to be put out for birds or squirrels as this attracts rats. Garbage must be kept inside until the morning of trash collection.

Rats burrow in the sand to make their nests. There is condensation on the water lines under the coaches. For moisture the rats chew the insulation and use it for their nests. Rats do not like metal. A suggestion to protect your coach would be to purchase ½ wire mesh and attach it to the outside of the split block around the perimeter of your coach. Any tiny holes could be stuffed with steel wool. This would keep them from going under the coaches. If you

choose to install the wire mesh on the outside of the split block, it must be covered with either plastic lattice, vinyl or aluminum siding to meet our Architectural and Landscaping Standards (Section I.g.).

Home Depot or Lowes sells rat traps that can be baited with beef jerky laced with rat poison. The key is to keep the traps baited and checked daily.

A key factor in eliminating rats is to eliminate their food source and ease of burrowing. They do not like bougainvillea so they will not travel in or around that plant. Putting traps in the planting areas will help, and moving them from time to time will also help to catch the rats as they travel in search of food.

EDITOR'S NOTE: An older sales associate at Ace Hardware recently remarked that rats have become a BIG problem in all of Pinellas County. I would encourage you to set traps even if you have NO evidence of rats. You may be SURPRISED!

The book for March is a light, quick read, a departure from some of the more serious historical fiction we have read this year. The title is The Wrong End of the Table by Ayser Salman. The following is a summary of the book: Romantic struggles and strict immigrant parents inform a journey toward self-acceptance in this fast-paced, funny memoir by an Iraqi-born film editor and producer. Throughout a nomadic childhood spent in Iraq, the U.S., and Saudi Arabia, Salman was often the new kid. But family and faith remain constants in this series of vignettes that follow her through childhood, film school, and her career in Los Angeles. The chronological structure wears away as Salman gets older, leaving space for philosophical musings and slices of life: a heartfelt open letter to President Trump, a questioning of her Muslim practice, and a meditation on how long Iraqis take to say goodbye. But these chapters are, while colorful, too short and numerous to pack the same punch as the narrative parts. The last section of the book, focusing on dating, picks up the chronology and once again allows Salman's voice and humor to shine; she has a gift for chapter titles ("Land of the Free, Home of the McMuffin"), recounts funny anecdotes (including a conversation in which she and her mother decide she could never marry Salman Rushdie because it would be too confusing to be "Mrs. Ayser Salman Rushdie), and uses footnotes to great comic effect. Unevenly structured but always funny, this enjoyable and heartfelt book is great for a plane, the beach, or a free afternoon.

On another subject, but one I like to remind everyone of every month, is INSURANCE! If you have given me an updated copy of your homeowner's insurance lately, thank you. But, if you have not, or you aren't sure if you've lapsed or for those of you who know you are not carrying insurance on your home, this is the time to get that taken care of. I can't stress the importance of how necessary this is, and, because of that importance, we will be cracking down on anyone who doesn't have an updated policy on file with the office.

Next, and just as important, is updated contact information for all persons living in the park. If you have an email address, please give that info to the office and be sure if you've given it before, that it's updated. Don't assume that we have an updated email address because you gave it sometime in the past. I have several people with email addresses on file who, when I've sent out an email blast, they are being returned undeliverable. So, perhaps, at one time you did give the office your email address but since then it's changed. I also need updated phone numbers and, very important, emergency contact info. The reason I say updated is because recently, I had to call the emergency contact info on file of a resident however, it was very outdated and the emergency contact person on file was someone who passed away years ago. That will not help in an emergency.

Lastly, if you plan to sell your coach, please let the office know so that we may help you and/ or your realtor get it done correctly. The Governing Docs of the community are extremely helpful when it comes to the sale or purchase at Westwind II ROC, so of course, that's always a great resource, which you should keep handy, especially if you plan to sell since those documents should go to your relator and/or the buyers when you move. But, if you let me know, I'll be aware and the whole process will go more smoothly and, I'll help with any questions you may have. Keep in mind, anyone purchasing in the park is required to fill out an application, available in the office, and be screened prior to moving in. If anyone has any questions, please feel free to reach out.
