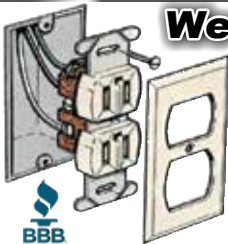

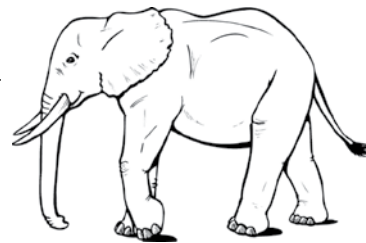


WHITE ELEPHANT SALE IS MARCH 5!

FERAL CATS IN OUR COMMUNITY

In the month of December, I addressed the HOA board to talk about the feral cats in our community. From riding around on my golf card, I have observed there are three adult cats and nine kittens. Four of those kittens are about 10 months old (old enough to breed). The other three kittens are about 4 months old. Adult cats produce 2-3 litters per year. I've been looking into a solution that will help the park and also the cats. I have been in touch with an organization called Meow Now, which I believe is part of Pinellas County Animal Services.



They are running a program called "TNVR" which stands for Trap Neuter Vaccinate and Return. They will come out and trap the cats, neuter and vaccinate against rabies and other diseases out there, and will clip their ear which identifies them as being neutered, and then return them to the exact spot they trapped them. They will not keep them or relocate them. The only thing they ask is that the cats be provided with food and water.

Now, I know that we are asked not to feed the cats and the reason is that they will get the mice and rats. It is very rare that you will see rats and mice where there are cats. Cats that are hungry can be trained to come eat at certain times. Therefore, food does not have to be left out for a long period of time. The plus side to this program is cats that are neutered are less prone to engage in nuisance behavior such as yowling, spraying to mark their territory or fight over mates. If a female is not sterilized, she will go into heat and her scent can be detected by male cats for a radius of one mile, which will bring more males into the park. Male cats have a stronger desire for mating than food. So, therefore, there is a good chance that once the females are sterilized, some of the males will leave the park to find a mate elsewhere. In fact, right now we currently have 2/3 more males in the park than females. So, there is hope to reduce the cat population if we sterilize the females.



Ten years prior to my retirement, I worked with organizations in New England and rescued many cats. There is the right way to feed them and the wrong way to feed them, so as not to attract other critters. I know there is going to be a lot of push back on this situation, some will say just let them eat the rats and mice.

First the rats and mice carry diseases and therefore, so will the cats. Second there is not enough rats and mice to provide food for 10 cats or more once they multiply. Some cats will die a slow painful death from malnutrition. It is abusive and neglectful to deny community cats food and water. I'm sure I the past some cats and litters have died due to this neglect. Cats are not meant to be wild animals to fend for themselves. They are feral due to human errors. Some were abandoned and found their way into the park, some were left behind and most were born here. They did not ask to be born in a park that will not provide food and water for them.

Meow Now is willing to come in and help us. The director is willing to come and talk about the program and answer any questions. Meow Now provides this successful service in many parks throughout Pinellas County. It has to be better than what we have now. Feral cats are running around, multiplying in not so good health, people feeding them, sneaking food at night so they won't get caught, which is the worst time to put food out.

I am asking the LHRO Board to give this program one year, to see how it works. I will work with the organization and help Meow Now to run the program. I will keep a log of the cats and report to the Board monthly or quarterly. I will also work with individuals that volunteer to feed them to ensure it is done the right way. I am not trying to break rules, I am just trying to help a hopeless situation. If anyone has any better ideas, then by all means, please come see me at Lot 232.

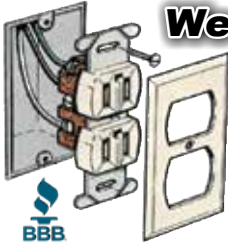

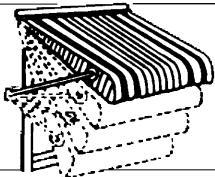

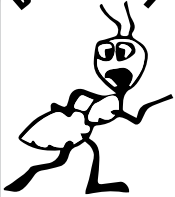

LHRO BOARD MEETING, February 10

(not official minutes, just notes from the Piper Editor)



Open Forum – Rita Teeter #244 – mentioned that Lanai fans need to be replaced, barely move any air, Dan’s Fans have some good options. Mark Durbin, #2, questioned if Director position is open and that he would be interested in filling it, what does he have to do; questioned if we are a Resident Owned park, we should have more say than just the Board to Management; questioned why the purchase of new house was halted due to questions on having a mortgage and what mortgage company to use; wanted clarification of why our share was \$24,000 and now it’s being said it’s worth \$50,000 – why? (it was explained later that our attorney said the laws have changed and the share price is now included in the price of the house when it’s bought/sold and can be any amount you want it to be); also stated that people/groups that are using the Clubhouse are not cleaning it and returning tables to where they were before -- whose responsibility is it to make sure things are returned to back to normal? (Ed. Note: In the past, whoever uses Clubhouse for events should clean it, sweep floors, wipe down tables and return tables to the position they were in originally); please let people know that the products that are in refrigerator or storage rooms are not to be taken with permission or without paying, these items belong to specific groups; do the residents have a say in the décor of our common areas?; and Meow Now – we will still have stray cats if we go with their plan (the Board later stated that we have rules against feeding wild animals of any kind and that cats should NOT be fed – we will not be changing the rules).

Secretary Report – notices were posted, need to approve minutes from last meeting, which was in December as January was cancelled, minutes were approved. No correspondence to address.

President’s Report – in January the Board had a meeting with Attorney and he said it was okay to continue with two Directors missing but of the 5 left, 4 had to agree to pass anything. Also, soil movement is homeowner responsibility. The Annual Members Meeting will be March 10 at 7 pm. Also, on March 10 at 10 am is the next LHRO Board Meeting – so both meetings are on same day.

Manager’s Report – Please check your homes for mold and get them cleaned! There is a lot of mold showing on homes, may have to clean them 2 times per year, but please go walk around your home and check it and take care of it. If you trim bushes and do weeding, you need to bag it and put it out on garbage day or take it to the maintenance area and put it in the “yard waste” bin. Do not ask our maintenance men to take care of it. The compacter is for household trash only – do not put building materials or carpet in there. Contractors and installers should take care of their own trash. It costs us \$1800 each time to empty the compacter.

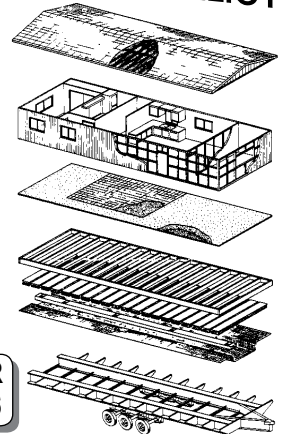

Due to the cost of gas and wear and tear, we will start charging a fee of \$10 to use the company truck. The Board approved this at today's meeting. If you need to borrow the truck, go to the office to pay the \$10 and they will give you a slip to take to maintenance. The truck is used 3-4 times per week by residents, and everyone is covered on our insurance policy. We DO NOT allow tools to be borrowed from maintenance due to liability reasons, and the fact that so many of them do not get returned. Due to questions about exterior alteration requests, the Board has put together a Review Committee to help Beth. You must get permission to change anything on the exterior – please go the office and fill out the paperwork and the Review Committee, consisting of Steve McCaskey, Mike Burgan and Beth, will review it. This committee and process was approved by the Board at today's meeting. If people do things without permission, we can ask you to remove it. Rules state that you MUST get permission.

Every home is private property – DO NOT trim bushes or weed anything without permission from the homeowner. If there is an issue, let the office know, and they will talk to the homeowner and charge them for our maintenance men to do the work. If you'd like to volunteer to help with this process, let Beth know. With regards to Meow Now, we can't put cat traps on property without owner's permission. Our rules state NO FEEDING animals outside. Advised by Attorney to enforce the rules. We must prove someone is feeding wild cats – take pictures if you can. Owners who are feeding them can be fined. With regard to Memorial benches, trees, etc. we have decided to use bricks and are scouting for a location. We can do a walkway or a wall with bricks engraved with your loved one's name. If you have ideas for a location, please give them to the office.

We will be replacing the washers and dryers in the laundry room. Maintenance man Mike will help prepare the room for the new stackable dryers and will remove the old ones. The new ones probably won't be available until May or June due to Covid supply issues. We will get three estimates for this project but expect it to cost approximately \$28,000 which we have in reserves specifically for this use. It was asked if we had considered getting a machine to change dollars into quarters, but it would have to go outside and we decided not to. Quarters are available at the office. Do we want a company to come in and do Covid testing? Everyone said "no, too late". Reserves study is coming along. Judy Walling mentioned that the fence by her unit #200 needs to be power washed. Beth said to let office know and maintenance will take care of it.



A question was asked about the share price of \$24,000. In 2010 or 2011 the office was doing closings and found that we were not qualified to do so, needs to be done by legal office or title office. The Attorney stated that due to law changes, the share is now a part of the price of your home and you can put whatever value you want on it – but has to be included with the price of the home when you sell/buy. The park is currently 100% resident owned. If the subject of selling the park ever comes up, there would need to be 75% approval by the residents in order to sell. It was just a general question.
