



# Things That Make You Go...Hmmmmmm?

#### WHAT'S WITH NASA?

E all know NASA (National Aeronautical Space Agency) as our space agency. Sending probes to Mars, feeding supplies to the Space Station and landing men on the Moon. NASA awarded a grant in 2014 to a group of 24 theologians to answer how well humans will react to news that intelligent life exists on other planets. Research



### THE CURIOSITY CORNER

#### **The Winter Storms of 1888**

ne of the raging debates today is about the weather. Blame for the devastating tornadoes, hurricanes, or unusually wet rainy seasons, causing floods and landslides, is said to be caused by man's prolific use of fossil fuels. The reason often cited for these catastrophes is the buildup of CO2, a by-product of fossil fuel combustion, in our atmosphere that has a profound effect upon our climate. Mankind is doomed, (according to some individuals) if we don't change our ways



within twelve years. However, I'm not going to delve into the merits of each side of the debate or the geopolitical issues that do not seem to be considered, discussed, or deliberately ignored. The climate has oscillated throughout earth's history, and while man's activities certainly have some influence upon the weather & climate, we may find that we have little actual control over its fluctuations.

It seems that no matter where you live, you may experience a natural catastrophe. Parts of the country may experience droughts, floods, wildfires, or earthquakes. California may someday have up to a quarter of its coast slide beneath the waves of the Pacific Ocean. Volcanic eruptions in the Northwest. Hurricanes ravaging the southern and eastern coast states. Tornadoes sporadically grazing the countryside causing destruction anywhere from Oklahoma to New York, and winters that bring bitter cold and snow to most of the country. If you bother to investigate our past, you will find many instances of unusual, harsh, or catastrophic natural weather events.

The winter of 1888 provided a couple such notable weather events. These storms happened at the tail end of a six-year run of extreme weather, called the "Little Ice Age." Climate historian Thomas St. Martin wrote a paper or essay about the eruption of the Indonesian volcano, Krakatoa in August 1883, forming an atmospheric shield against the sun's warmth that plunged the globe into a deep freeze from 1882 to 1888.

The country experienced two devastating blizzards that year, one in January, the other in March. The morning of January 12th had been unusually mild and warm, a nice reprieve from the cold, icy weather conditions of the previous day. So later that day, when the storm system swiftly dropped down from Canada into the U. S. on January 12th and 13th, extending from Colorado to the Great Lakes, many people were caught unprepared. According to some accounts, the temperature dropped approx.  $100^{\circ}$  F in 24 hours. The resulting severe cold wave extended all the way to southern California and created a blizzard for the northern Plains and upper Mississippi Valley. The blizzard trapped many children in schoolhouses where they froze to death. This blizzard has been referred to by several different names; the Schoolhouse Blizzard, Schoolchildren's Blizzard, or the Children's Blizzard. Across Nebraska, North Dakota, and Minnesota the storm brought high winds and blinding snow conditions, adults and children became victims of the blizzard, and thousands of cattle perished.

Most of the victims in rural areas were children, trying to make their way home from ...continued on page 33

school. This storm produced stories of heroism and tragedy. Schoolteacher Seymour Dopp in Pawnee City, Nebraska, kept his class of 17 at school when the storm began at 2 p.m. They stayed overnight, burning the stockpiled wood to keep warm. The following day their parents trudged over five-foot snow drifts to rescue their children. In South Dakota, in order to lead a class safely through the snow, two men tied a rope from the schoolhouse to the nearest shelter. In Nebraska, Minnie Freeman, a teacher, successfully led her children to shelter after the storm ripped the roof off of her schoolhouse.

However, there were also instances of people not as fortunate. Teacher Loie Royce tried to lead three children to the safety of her home, less than 90 yards from their school in Plainfield, Nebraska. They became lost, the children died of hypothermia and Royce lost her feet to frostbite. Farmer Erik Olson, of Beaver Creek, Minnesota, was found a mile and a half from his home several days after the storm. Only his feet were visible under the piles of snow. Some unfortunate individuals were not found until April, after enough snow had melted away to uncover their bodies. Ten-year-old Johnny Walsh of Avoca Minnesota froze to death trying to find his house. Six siblings died trying to make their way home from school. The storm is considered one of the worst blizzards in our nation's history, killing an estimated 235 to 500 people and setting, at the time, a record low of -65° F in the continental United States. Approximately two months later the East Coast would experience a harsh blizzard, known as The Great Blizzard of 1888.

March 10th brought pleasant weather to the Northeast, grass peeking through the snow, chirping birds and thoughts of an early spring. However, by the following day, Sunday afternoon, the temperature had dropped, and rain began to fall. Monday morning, March 12th, the rain changed to snow and the once warm breezes changed to powerful wind gusts of more than 50 miles per hour. In Albany, NY the snow had reached a depth of 2 ½ ft., most of which had fallen on that day, and by 7 PM that evening everything had come to a halt. Railroad travelers became stranded. Downtown hotels were crammed with frustrated travelers and people that lived on the city's fringes who couldn't make it home. Streets became



unpassable and the trains were not operating. No coal or milk was being delivered. Theaters and saloons were closed, and even the state legislature adjourned for a couple of days. The snow blocked front doors requiring some people to crawl out second story windows on to huge piles of snow. Snow drifts in Albany ranged from 10 to over 20 ft. high.

The storm, stretching from Maryland up to Maine and parts of Canada, severely impacted the northeastern states costing an equivalent of approx. \$650 million in damages. The storm immobilized many coastal cities. Many economically struggling people in New York City defied weather conditions and went to work, resulting in many accounts of people stranded or freezing to death. The storm claimed more than 400 people, 200 in New York City alone. The winds generated by this storm were so ferocious that more than 200 vessels were destroyed along the eastern seaboard, resulting in the death of 100 seamen. The winds created drifts 30 to 40 feet high, but the tallest drift in New York City was 52 feet. Outside the cities, telegraph poles were destroyed, and locomotives almost buried in snow drifts. On the 14th of March, a train that had started in Buffalo arrived in Albany. It had spent 3 days struggling to make it from Schenectady to Albany, approx. 21 miles, and was pulled in by 7 engines.



By Friday the weather had improved, and gangs of men and boys worked to clear major streets, roads, and stretches of railroad track. In Albany, N.Y. the storm would top its 20 worst snowstorms list, exceeding the next highest snow accumulation by 20 inches. It recorded an accumulation of 46.7 inches. The storm was nicknamed the "Great White Hurricane" with the highest recorded snowfall of 58 inches, in Saratoga Springs, N.Y.

We still feel the impact from this storm today. The failure to issue a "Cold Wave Warning" spurred congressional legislation, removing the meteorological service out of the War Department, and creating the Weather Bureau under the Dept. of Agriculture. The bill was signed by President Benjamin Harrison on October 1, 1890. The storm also helped city planners realize the value of underground subway systems and moving power and communication lines underground. We may come to realize that we have little control over our climate, and that adapting in a slow, methodical and thoughtful way is better than running around yelling the sky is falling, trying every conceivable solution in the hope we can impede or stop the inevitable.
