

The other day I had the opportunity to visit with my neighbor, Charley Chamarro. You may recall that Charley celebrated his 100th birthday on November 29th, 2021! That is an amazing accomplishment!

Charley was born in Summerlee, WV. His parents came to America from Spain, and I remember his wife Betty once telling me proudly that Charley is a Spaniard!

Like most young men of that time, Charley was drafted into the Army and was stationed in Germany and Austria during WWII. In 1944 he was in Florida for harbor training, and Charley thought then that when he retired he would come to Florida.

When the war ended, Charley returned to West Virginia where he met and married Betty in 1950.

The only work available in West Virginia was in the coal mines. He soon decided he was not going to spend his life working in the mines, so at the urging of his brothers, he moved to


Clarkston, Michigan where jobs were plentiful in the auto industry. He worked at GM, first unloading box cars, then working in several "cribs", until retiring in 1984.

WATER TOWER TURTLE

From our house here on Second Street we have enjoyed watching the changes to the water tower on Curlew Rd. It looks like the preliminary work is nearly finished – it's been scraped and is getting a coat of white paint. The mural of a pair of turtles is to be painted by on it St. Petersburg artist, Tom Stovall.

Henry, the gopher tortoise, is named after Henry Scharrer, a Swiss immigrant and nature lover who lived on Caladesi Island from 1892 to 1934. Sylvia, the sea turtle, is named after Sylvia Earle, an oceanographer who was raised in Dunedin.

The breakout turtle design "Henry and Sylvia" is intended to provide Dunedin citizens a striking and meaningful environmental portrait that encourages protection and survival of sea tortoises and gopher turtles, according to city art consultant Elizabeth Brincklow.

Hopefully the artist will soon be able to start work on Sylvia and Henry. So I can watch!




