- 4 large carrots, peeled and cut
- 10 baby red potatoes, cut
- 1 onion, peeled and cut into small pieces
- 4 cups of water
- 1 (4lb) corned beef brisket with spice packet
- 6 oz beer
- 1/2 head cabbage, coarsely chopped

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Place carrots, potatoes, and onion into the bottom of a slow cooker, pour in the water and place the brisket on top of the veggies. Pour the bear over the brisket. Sprinkle the spices from the packet over the meat, cover, set cooker on high.
- 2. Cook for about 8 hrs. An hour before serving, stir in the cabbage and cook for one more hour.
- 3. No more dry corned beef!!!!! Cook this in your slow cooker all day and you guaranteed success!! Serve with soda bread for a warm and satisfying meal.
