Announcement from Carol Alvey, Manager

ars parked in the street after midnight are in danger of being towed. Besides the inconvenience, getting the car back can be expensive (almost \$200). After ours was towed, a neighbor always let us know if we'd forgotten to put it in the driveway. I suggest banding together to help each other this way. Whe also tried turning on the porch light when the car was on the road. If nothing works for you and your car is towed, please don't call Carol Alvey in the middle of the night. Instead:

Parking a boat, rv, and trailer, etc., in the utility right of way just north of the clubhouse comes with rules: all vehicles must be registered

with the office, and only one vehicle per coach is allowed. Some vehicles which were parked there years ago have never moved. More concerning are vehicles that have never been registered in the office, including multiple vehicles parked by a single resident. If you are an offender, remove all extra vehicles and .get your one allowable vehicle registered. Also, please note: no storage sheds. IF RULES ARE NOT FOLLOWED, USE OF LOT WILL BE DISCONTINUED.

Overflowing garbage containers are also a problem. The Largo Sanitation Department is very strict about too full garbage containers. They use automatic picker-upper-and-dumpers (or whatever they're called) that will not work when the garbage containers are too full, so the workers will do one of 2 things: they may just not empty the over-full container, or they will push the extra garbage off the top and charge the park double. Just a reminder: Extra charges lead to increasing rents.

All garbage must be put in the bins behind the clubhouse. Do not put it on the ground. The garbage trucks empty the bins on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, but there are no set times.

Rent for 2022 is a \$25 increase. Tenants who have dogs in a non-pet section must have a doctor's prescription for a service dog, papers on service dog AND must pay the same rent amount as people who live in the pet section, \$650 on beginning January 1, 2022.

NO TV's or other electronics in the dumpsters, please. Pinellas County has a program for disposing of these items.

PLEASE follow all rules and regulations. Violators will receive a written notice of violation. Three violations of the same rule is grounds for eviction.

THE POOL: No floats are allowed in the pool. Noodles are allowed.

If you use an umbrella, fold it up when you leave the pool. Do not use when it is windy.

Pool will be renovated/repaired and will be closed during renovation, scheduled for March 2020.

BE SAFE! Break ins and theft have been occurring in the park recently. Keep your stuff put away, your doors locked, and don't answer your door to strangers. Report any suspicious activity the police and to management.

TO REDUCE SPEEDING through the park, the back gate will be closed 24/7. If you need an opener, contact Carol in the office. The speed limit is 15 mph.

THE PINELLAS COUNTY Humane Society is **AGAIN** investigating numerous cat poisonings in our park. Poisoning any animal is a federal felony punishable by up to 1 year in jail. It is also inhumane and causes the animal to suffer. Don't do it.

PLEASE DON'T FEED STRAYCATS.

PROTECT YOUR BELONGINGS. Residents have reported stolen landscape decorations, tricycles, etc. Lock up tempting items or install a motion detector light to deter thieving thugs. Also, consider reporting late night walkers.

COMPLAINTS AGAINST YOUR NEIGHBOR MUST BE IN WRITING AND SIGNED. Give the written complaint to the office or drop it in the mail slot in the office door. Verbal and unsigned complaints cannot be addressed.

MANAGEMENT WILL ALSO ADDRESS COMPLAINTS ONLY IN WRITING.

Rules: The Park has rules that everyone received and reviewed when they bought or rented their coach. They are also printed annually in the Directory (September issue of Bay Ranch Review). **Please read and follow them**. Failure to follow rules is grounds for eviction, and management has shown that it is willing to evict.

Rules commonly broken:

- 1. Parking on grass or sidewalk, overnight on street, and/or every day.
- 2. Parking overnight at the Clubhouse without Office authorization.
- 3. Failing to register at the office all persons living with you.
- 4. Piling garbage in front of garbage bins. When you throw garbage, throw it to the back so when you open the door, it doesn't fall out and there is space.
- 5. Failure to maintain, paint and/or clean mobile home, trim, awnings, planter and driveway.

Sewage remains an intractable problem. Drains continue to back up because grease, vinyl/rubber gloves, paper towels and other inappropriate items are flushed. <u>Bay Ranch will not pay to unclog sewers when the clog is caused by inappropriate items put down the sewer. The tenant will have to pay for this problem.</u>

Eds. Note: It is inappropriate to flush anything other than toilet paper, and doing so causes costly sewer clogs. If the park pays, we all will ultimately, through rent increases.

Also, those so-called flushable personal cleansing cloths are really **NOT FLUSHABLE.** They do not disintegrate in the sewer system, and they WILL clog the sewer someplace in the system. Lots of people like to use these cloths in the bathroom, but PLEASE do not put them in the toilet. Limit what goes into the toilet to toilet paper. Eds.

Note: My housemates and I had to hire a plumber when our own drain system clogged due to dishwasher detergent that was not well dissolved. We had virtual rocks of detergent blocking the drain. Our solution (after paying the plumber): liquid detergent.

Those metal electric service boxes behind each mobile home belong to Duke Energy. **Please** do not service or pay to service them yourself.

Call Duke Energy or Carol Alvey (see her cell phone number at the front of the Review) if vour electric needs service. Why? Well, in a couple of instances, residents have submitted bills for about \$4,500 for service. If the repair is the park's responsibility, we have an electrician who will do the work for \$1,500. It just makes economic sense.

From the box to the mobile home is the resident's responsibility. Please make your own arrangements with an electrician if that area needs repair. The office can tell you if the repair is your responsibility.

SAY SOMETHING DO SOMETHING Homeless people are moving into the park. In one instance, an empty coach was left unlocked and homeless people had moved in. In several instances, people have been sleeping in the driveways/patios of empty

homes. And others have been sleeping on the shuffleboard courts, sometimes using cushions from outside the clubhouse for mattresses.

Please watch out for your neighbor and neighborhood. If you see someone entering a home you know to be empty, or someone sitting or sleeping in that home's driveway/patio, or any other inappropriate behavior of this type, please call the Largo police. It is ok in this case to use 911 because you don't know what the danger is.

Cars left parked on the street after midnight **will be towed**. This is expensive and inconvenient. This is another opportunity to be a good neighbor:by reminding someone whose car is in the street after 10 pm. \

Cars parked on the street during the day should be staggered so emergency vehicles can pass by. Do not park on the grass or sidewalk.

You must register at the office and give a copy of the title to the manager if you have something parked in the field north of the clubhouse Wayne will show you where to park after you register.

- * Please, put ALL garbage in the dumpsters, even big and heavy items like furniture.
- * DO NOT dump behind, beside or anywhere near the trash bins. Put the garbage in the bins.
 - *Put household trash in the smaller trash bins.
- * Do not bring garbage to the bins on Monday morning. By that time, the bins are overflowing. Wait until Monday afternoon or later, when the bins are empty.
- * Pick up for furniture, tree brush/limbs and other debris will be on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday only. Put out trash after 5:00 p.m, the day before.

*DO NOT DISPOSE OF TVS OR ELECTRONICS IN THE PARK. DO NOT PUT THEM IN OR BESIDE THE DUMPSTER. We get fined. Call pinellascounty.org/recycle to dispose of them.

*If you need help disposing of something, someone in the park may help you for a fee

Larger families and visitors: Reminder: that rent is based on one or two household. Each person above the two must pay an additional \$30 a month, including visitors who stay over 30 days. Please be proactive about this and pay the money without first being reminded.

SMOKE ALARMS SAVE LIVES TEST MONTHLY

The following information remains in force:

Fires: Test your smoke detectors to make sure they work. Recommended action: purchase a fire extinguisher if you don't have one and know how to work it. If a fire starts, spray it with the fire extinguisher immediately and GET OUT OF THE HOUSE. Fire destroys mobile homes very quickly..

Management requests that you turn off your water heater when the water is off, to prevent the element from burning out. Eds. Note: According to diy.stackexchange. com/questions/3766, this needs to be empty. Tankless heaters don't need this.



Other announcements:

The stoves in the kitchen both work.

The purified water dispenser at the clubhouse operates on its own schedule. After someone has filled containers, it may take the dispenser some time to regenerate enough water for more containers. There is a light on the dispenser that tells whether it is ready.

Some have questioned why the application fee is "so high." One reason is to help cover garbage fees, since new owners usually throw away most of the furniture and electronics.

Mr. Larson (the owner) calls the lawn service for lawn care on an as-needed basis. The park pays for lawn mowing, etc., once a month but the need sometimes goes unnoticed. If you notice the lawn needs trimming, please let the office know so they can call Mr. Larson.

Sometimes an automobile will leak oil onto our new, nice looking pavement, creating an eyesore. If you notice a leak by your house, call the office to have it cleaned up. Let's keep these streets looking nice!

Lost and Found Dog/Cat: If you have found a dog or cat, you can post on a site called <u>pawboost.com</u> or call Animal Service on Walsingham. If you call, Animal Services will come out, free of charge, to pick up an animal.



FROM THE EDITOR

Tv birthday is on February 1 and always took my mother by surprise. She was old school, and cooked and baked her way to Christmas, which followed cooking for Thanksgiving and was followed by celebrating New Year's Eve with a small family party. At that point, she gave out a loooonnnngggg sigh that lasted until my birthday snuck up on her.



What does that have to do with any of the rest of you? It seems my mother was not alone in letting down her guard after the holidays. Yesterday (Feb. 11) I realized that the Review would soon be overdue at the publisher and I hadn't even started. Nor had any of my "contributors." Lucky for us we don't need to bake and decorate a cake or buy (who am I kidding? MAKE) a gift. But we do have to write.

If you read Neighbors, you know this is my last Review. I've enjoyed it for the most part, but the timing is hard because it is due at the publisher's 2-3 weeks before it comes out and so many of our special activities are planned or finalized after the copy has gone in. The editor before me filled the pages with jokes and humorous stories. That would have been even harder for me than trying to report on upcoming events.

One point is that the new editor (or possibly the Residents' Club) gets to decide what they want the Review to be. A third option (after the 2 mentioned above) would be to report on past events and let bulletin boards and Neighbors announce upcoming events.


