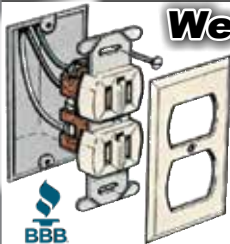

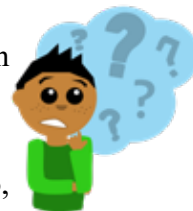

WHOOA, NELLIE! **Speed Limit is 15 miles per hour.** Watch speed around corners, especially as you get close to the Park's exits/entrances. Like a horse that breaks into a run when he sees the barn up ahead, sometimes our cars speed up when nearing the Park exit roads. Hold on to those reins! And take care when passing areas of heavy traffic: the pools, the golf course, the clubhouses, the post boxes.

Neighbors chatting, pets on a stroll with their humans, people walking or bicycling, golf carts or cars parked in the street, and delivery vehicles are all on our sidewalks and streets. THIS MONTH IN HISTORY

March 1, 1781 - Formal ratification of the Articles of Confederation was announced by Congress. Under the Articles, Congress was the sole governing body of the new American national government, consisting of the 13 original states. The Articles remained in effect through the Revolutionary War until 1789, when the current U.S. Constitution was adopted.

March 10, 1862 - The first issue of U.S. government paper money occurred as \$5, \$10 and \$20 bills began circulation.

March 24, 1989 - One of the largest oil spills in U.S. history occurred as the oil tanker Exxon Valdez ran aground in Prince William Sound off Alaska, resulting in 11 million gallons of oil leaking into the natural habitat over a stretch of 45 miles.

March 30, 1981 - Newly elected President Ronald Reagan was shot in the chest while walking toward his limousine in Washington, D.C., following a speech inside a hotel. The president was then rushed into surgery to remove a 22-caliber bullet from his left lung. "I should

have ducked," Reagan joked. Three others were also hit including Reagan's Press Secretary, James Brady, who was shot in the forehead but survived. The president soon recovered from the surgery and returned to his duties.

Birthday - American football legend Knute Rockne (1888-1931) was born in Voss, Norway. He coached the Notre Dame Football team for 13 seasons, amassing an overall record of 105 wins, 12 losses and 5 ties. He became famous for his locker room pep talks and the saying, "Win one for the Gipper." He was killed in an airplane crash on March 31, 1931, in Kansas.

SIGN-IN: Please continue to sign in on the Pro Shop patio clipboard and indicate time/date of play and either your annual membership number or pay to play. Please put your name and address on pay to play envelope. Drop Box for payment on Pro Shop patio.

As always, golfers should be aware of our golf course rules and general golf etiquette.

Benches on the Golf Course

The Golf Committee meets monthly to make decisions regarding all aspects relating to matters of the golf course. It has been determined that all 18 benches need replacing. This is a good opportunity to duplicate the method used several years ago for residents to purchase new memorial benches.

After much research, the Golf Committee has chosen a very sturdy 6' unit made of recycled plastic called "Malibu Bench" in a dark brown color; it weighs 178 pounds, so it is a very sturdy unit. The total cost of the bench is \$564.00, which includes tax and shipping.

The benches in the poorest shape will be replaced first. (Two have already collapsed and been removed).

We currently have 8 replacement benches spoken and paid for. Benches are being ordered 6 at a time and this will continue until all 18 are replaced. The location of a purchased bench and memorial will be determined by the following guidelines:

1. The original sponsor will be contacted to see if he/she would like to replace that bench. If so, then they would retain exclusivity for the spot and place their plaque on it.
2. If an original sponsor does not wish to sponsor a new bench, then that space will be offered to someone else with the understanding that the original sponsor's plaque will be transferred to the new bench along with a plaque created by the new sponsor.
3. For existing benches, if we have no member of the family still residing here in Palm Hill, the sponsor for the new bench will have a plaque placed to include their message, and the plaque that was on the old bench will be moved and placed on one of the Community Benches.

Our plan is to replace all 18 benches within the next year. With your assistance, we can reach our goal.
