This is a reminder to all the "Snowbirds"— Please read Rule 12:

- 1. You must make arrangements to have your weeds taken care of while you are gone....this means all around your lot and not just once before you return. (NOTE: If you fail to have your lot maintained, first you will receive a letter that it is overgrown, giving you a time frame to have the work done; if not done, then the Park will do the work and you will be billed).
- 2. Any dead tree limbs that fall on the ground during a storm are required to be removed from your lot within 7 days of occurrence.
- 3. You must notify the office if someone in the Park is taking care of your mobile while you are gone-Name and phone number.
- 4. The office must have your "summer address" and phone number.

ALSO, if someone is going to use your mobile home while you are gone, the Park must be notified before they arrive. If you are letting someone park in your driveway, make sure the office is aware of it. This is for your safety; if a car is seen in your driveway and you are not here, we will know something is wrong.

Remember that there is an activities calendar in the cabinet by the back entrance to the clubhouse; I will make a monthly schedule for March and have them posted. Just remember that I cannot account for last minute changes and additions!

1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cups ground almonds (with coffee grinder)

Let oranges cool, cut to take the pits out and make them into "puree."

### <u>In a Bowl:</u>

Beat eggs and sugar until it is pale yellow (about 10 minutes)

Gradually add one at a time-baking powder, orange puree, almond's grind, and orange zest. Then, gradually add enough flour to make the dough as thick as cake dough is, normally.

Grease a 10" pan, pour the dough in and cook for about 55 minutes or when a toothpick comes out clean when you check the center of the cake.

### FROSTING (ORANGE FLAVOR)

### Ingredients:

- 1 cup Margarine
- 1 teaspoon Vanilla extract
- 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cups Icing Sugar
- 2 Tablespoons Orange Juice
- 1 Tablespoon Orange Zest

### **Preparation:**

With electric mixer, mix margarine and vanilla together.

Gradually add icing sugar, orange juice and orange zest to the mixture and beat until you get

a creamy frosting that holds itself together.

Philip R. Craig was born in Santa Monica in 1933 who grew up on a small ranch with no running water or electricity until he was 10. Originally, he went to Boston U to become a minister

getting a degree in religion and philosophy. But soon Craig got more interest in writing literature. While in college he got into fencing and became so good he was invited to join the Olympic fencing squad but had to decline due to a knee injury. He also met his wife, Shirley, while filling in as a fencing instruction

Philip didn't publish his first novel until he was 35. His best-known series is the J.W. Jackson Martha Vineyard ones. J.W.. is a true 20th century hero who fights evil in the guise of corrupt land developers, nefarious tourists, or people who kill or threaten his friends. He constantly finds himself having to clear his name or his friends name and keeping them safe. Jackson still finds time to enjoy the finer and simpler things in life i.e., fresh caught seafood, cooking, good friends, outdoor showers, and a beautiful wife!

Philip's books are very readable, have the power of escape and a keen sense of place.

### IRS WARNING: SCAMMERS WORK YEAR-ROUND; STAY VIGILANT!

**Context message scams:** these scams are sent to taxpayers' smartphones and have referenced Covid-19 and/or "stimulus payments." These messages often contain bogus links claiming to be IRS websites or other online tools. Other than IRS Secure Access, the IRS does not use text messages to discuss personal tax issues, such as those involving bills or refunds. The IRS also will not send taxpayers messages via social media platforms.




The IRS reminds everyone NOT to click links or open attachments in unsolicited, suspicious or unexpected test messages-whether from the IRS, state tax agencies or others in the tax community.

**Phone Scams:** The IRS does not leave pre-recorded, urgent or threatening messages. In many variations of the phone scam, victims are told if they do not call back, a warrant will be issued for their arrest. Other verbal threats include law-enforcement agency intervention, deportation or revocation of licenses.

The IRS (and its authorized private collection agencies) will never:

- Call to demand immediate payment using a specific payment method such as a prepaid debit card, gift card or wire transfer. The IRS does not accept these methods for tax payments.
- Threaten to immediately bring in local police or other law-enforcement groups to have the taxpayer arrested for not paying.
- Demand that taxes be paid without giving the taxpayer the opportunity to question or appeal the amount owed.
- Ask for credit or debit card numbers over the phone.




