



Ingredients:

Boneless Chuck Roast, flour & OILparsley flakes, 1/2tsp basil
1 can dram of mushroom soup......1/2tsp garlic powder, 1/2tsp pepper
1 C. beef broth.....80oz. can mushrooms undrained
1tsp marjoram

Flour chuck roast and brown on both sides in oil in a large skillet. Add remaining ingredients, cover and simmer on stove top. Bake in oven at 350, or cook in crock pot until very tender, turning meat occasionally. Thicken with cornstarch for gravy.

VETERAN'S CORNER

was amazed to read in the Army Times that throughout the military, there are more than 15,000 service members who have still refused to comply with the vaccine mandate; about 12,000 religious exemption requests have been filed. To date, only the Marine Corps has approved any of those request - three in the last month out of more than 3,000. Many of the ones that claimed religious exemptions refused to talk to any Chaplains that might be in favor of the vaccine. I for one remember that when I went into basic standing in line and not knowing what was going in your arms and was getting shots in both arms with a gun which they used back then. We had no say about it we just took them. Then every time you faced an overseas deployment you faced a whole series of new shots and had to keep your shot cards up or get disciplined. To me and anyone else that had any leadership role in the service you expected that when an order was given it would be obeyed or disciplinary action would follow. That is what you signed up for and learned in Basic and AIT. The reason for this is when you are in Combat you cannot have people questioning every decision or order that you give. You cannot have them say I don't feel like fighting today or I don't want to take that hill. So, as I see it this is more than just refusing to take a vaccine its refusing to obey orders. It is truly sad to see that this is happening and it's only a small percentage of the many brave men and women who are serving. I hope that it gets resolved or sadly they will get discharged. It was reported that two Battalion Commanders were relieved of their commands for failure to follow orders.

An all too familiar event is occurring in Hawaii. The Navy is set to begin removing contaminated water from a well that supplies drinking water to more than 93,000 people under a plan approved by federal and Hawaii state regulators last week. The service will remove up to five million gallons of water each day from the well known as Red Hill, which became contaminated in late November after a fuel spill at the Navy's Red Hill Bulk Fuel Facility. The fuel storage sits atop the aquifer that supplies water to more than 400,000 residents of Honolulu. According to the plan, the Interagency Drinking Water System Team, or IDWST, will use skimming pumps, booms and absorbent pads inside the well to remove or contain any contaminants. The water then will be moved into a capture zone and passed through a massive carbon filtration system before it is tested and discharged into a stream that feeds into Pearl harbor. As the Navy prepares to

start clearing out the Red Hill well, it also is flushing the water systems in multiple neighborhoods and beginning to flush and test tap water in affected homes. The service has completed flushing and testing of the system in 11 neighborhoods, reporting that the water meets or exceeds Environmental Protection Agency and Hawaii Department of Health standards for safe drinking water. On Saturday, the Navy announced, however, that two homes in the Hale Moku and Hokulani neighborhoods failed the tests, with one home exceeding acceptable



limits set by the state for diesel-based hydrocarbons by 29% and for oil by 17%. Sadly, as we all know this has happened way to many times and has resulted in people fighting for years and years to get benefits.

The Department of Veterans Affairs is planning to expand several programs that allow senior veterans to age in their homes or live in home-like settings as alternatives to elder care facilities. VA officials announced Monday they will expand the Home-Based Primary Care and Veteran-Directed Care programs, which provide medical care and caregiver services to housebound older veterans, and its Medical Foster Home programs, which provides housing and services to veterans who otherwise would be in nursing homes. The expansion is needed, said officials with the VA's Office of Geriatrics and Extended Care, to ensure that the department can support a growing number of veterans eligible for nursing home care. By 2039, the number of elderly veterans is expected to double from 2 million to 4 million. Since 1999, the Department of Veterans Affairs has been required to provide nursing home services to veterans who qualify for VA health care and have a service-connected disability rating of 70% or higher or are considered unemployable and have a disability rating of 60% or higher. Medical foster homes are places where veterans live full time in a home setting with a caregiver licensed to provide 24-hour support, meals, housing, help with daily living and companionship. The program places veterans in houses belonging to or managed by caregivers that are licensed by their states as assisted-living facilities.

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #45

his month the focus is the essential steps that keep our bodies prepared throughout the day. There are 4 pretty basic actions that occur in how we use our food (sugar and other nutrients.) What we eat, how much we eat, when we eat (a newer issue) and the last important one which is what we do with the food (movement.) I really don't like the word "exercise." Bet you don't either.



- 1. What we eat. Each food group has a sugar load. Some call it "carbs." Each food group has its own time to become sugar, pass into our blood stream and meet "insulin" made fresh daily and hourly in our pancreas that escorts the sugar into each and every cell. Candy the fastest (seconds) and meat the longest (almost an hour.) Complex and processed foods usually have multiple food groups.
- 2. <u>How much we eat.</u> Eating more than recommended in each food group means too much sugar will be available immediately or an hour from now when you really need some right now. Which makes our body "make" sugar even though you just ate. Oh boy! Or you get the sugar when you aren't going to use it. Another Oh boy!
- 3. When we eat. May be a new one for most of us. We were designed to get fresh food (sugar) every 3-4 hours after getting up at DAWN. Yes DAWN. All day until dusk. When we don't follow this there is metabolic chaos and confusion. We don't get food when our body first needs it (skipping breakfast) and eating at the end of the day when things are winding down. The end result is no fresh food (sugar) when our system is looking for it and then food (sugar) when not needed. Our body has to make sugar when it has been denied (yes denied.) and store sugar when it isn't being used (fat.) If our pancreas could talk to most of us it would be screaming for calm. It would tell us to eat what we were designed to eat, the quantities we were designed to find during the day and when, along our daily trail (movement) we would find it.
- 4. Movement. Formerly "exercise" for me. Simple. We ate and moved to eat, ate and moved until dusk when we found safety to sleep. Started all over the next day. If the average time the sugar is available to us is 40 minutes after we swallow, then do something and move. Walk, vacuum, ride a bike, move!! Our muscles use the most sugar!!! I mean it. Use them no matter how small the muscle, it is using sugar. Then have something to eat 3 hours later. It truly is simple. Get up, eat, move, eat move.... go to bed without a napkin on our laps.

The goal is not ending up with so much sugar (gas) in our tank when we aren't going (driving) anywhere. Fall asleep with enough sugar to get you to the morning when breakfast is waiting. Breakfast is not a donut and coffee! Of course, you knew that. Next month is solely on diabetes.

Chew well my friends.
