them and then collect the amount from you.

<u>Garbage & Trash</u> – If you have large items that you want to dispose of, please call the City of Pinellas Park at 727-369-0690 and schedule a special pick up. You can also call this number if your home/street was missed on trash pick-up day.

Office/Library Windows – I don't know the exact date yet but very soon the window replacement project will be starting.

New Mailboxes – I expect the new mailboxes will begin being used prior to this publication. Insurance Requirement & Document Enforcement – We have begun gathering insurance information. Please forward a copy of the declaration page for your homeowner's insurance or liability policy.

<u>Buffer Around Homes</u> – Section 3, Item 9 of the Rules and Regulations reads, "...A minimum 12" buffer area must be installed to prevent the vinyl from being damaged by lawn or park maintenance personnel. The Co-op is not responsible for any damage to vinyl siding."

<u>Underdrain Project</u> – By the time this edition of the Chronicle reaches you, the underdrain project should be complete. This work was done to repair and replace a portion of an underground drain that prevented rainwater from flowing to the canal properly.

<u>Lot Lines</u> – The office gets questions from residents wanting to know where their property lines are. The park was never surveyed so the question is hard to answer. The governing documents state there shall be 5 feet on the rear and either side of each home and 8 feet in the front. Some homes were placed on the right or left of the home's "footprint". Those homes may have more green space on one side and very little, if any, on the other so the question is very difficult to answer but 5 feet on each side and rear and 8 feet in the front is the general rule of thumb.

orders rules have loosened up so our Canadian neighbors are finally able to return to Clearwater Cascade. And, many memberships have been sold, ushering in a new group of neighbors for us to welcome. Events and games are restarting and it looks like things are coming back to normal. This makes it a perfect time to revisit a few Park and Florida rules.

The Park speed limit is 15 mph. As I sit in my living room and look out the windows, few cars driving up our street adhere to this rule. Stop signs aren't a suggestion, they are the law. Several residents have complained about almost being struck by vehicles ignoring stop signs. Pedestrians have the right-of-way and assume they are safe; it's the vehicles operators' responsibility to honor that right. These rules apply to golf carts as well.

Bicyclists in Florida must follow the same rules as motor vehicles. Ride on the right, stop at stop signs and display front and rear lights after dark. Don't assume that cars will yield to you but, instead, follow the same right-of-way rules that cars follow.

Pedestrians are killed more often in Florida than any other state, 5 times more the rules next most dangerous state. Be safe, walk on the left facing traffic. When crossing the street, do so at crosswalks or if one isn't available cross straight across, not on the diagonal. If walking after dark, carry a light and wear light colored clothing.

After surviving the Pandemic, it would be sad to lose your life to a foolish accident. Please respect the rules so everyone can enjoy their time at Clearwater Cascade.
