Golf Tip of the Month - Local Playing Rule - Out of Bounds

Fairway Village Golf Course has placed white stakes to identify all Out of Bounds (OB) areas. These areas also include the permanent Golf Shack and adjacent paving and concrete, all lawn areas behind homes, and an area on No. 2 on the right side of the fairway near where the maintenance equipment is kept. Out of Bounds is defined by the ground level line from White Stake to White Stake and there is a local playing rule that should be followed while playing on our FV course. Except for No. 9 (where there is a drop zone), when a ball goes OB, it must be dropped within two club lengths (using your longest club) perpendicular from the point is **CROSSED** (not where it ended up) the OB line. This might mean that you have a longer distance now for your next shot. PENALTY – 1 STROKE.





Love on the rocks

re love and marriage dying? CNN reports that Americans these days don't seem to be forming relationships, moving in together, and even having as much sex as they once did.



The 2021 General Social Survey found that 26% of Americans 18 and up didn't have sex at all in the past year. That's up from 23% in 2016 and also 2018, so it's not just fear of the pandemic preventing hookups. Only slightly more than 50% reported having sex once a month or less, the first time that figured exceeded 50%.

Americans aren't shacking up as much either. The GSS found that about 62% of Americans 25–54 were living together, married or unmarried, in 2019, far below the 70% who lived together in 1990, which serves as a baseline. Ten percent more men, and seven percent more women, were living alone than in 1990.

Even without living together, partnerships aren't as popular in recent years. The GSS found that 30% of adults 25–54 had a steady partner, down from 20% in 1986.

One bright spot: The divorce rate seems to be dropping. Divorces and annulments dropped, with 2.7 per 1,000 people in 2019, down from four per 1,000 in 2000.

Ninety percent of life is fifty percent indecisive. The rest is confusing.






