UPDATE:

Clubhouse & Pool Key FOB

Gene Arend

he Clubhouse & Pool area will have Key FOB security to replace the key entry system. All registered owners will be issued a key FOB. All tenants or guest will receive the Key FOB from the property owner. A plan will be in place to obtain the key FOB. The key entry will remain in place for 30 days or more during the transition to the new entry system.

The key FOB is required to enter the clubhouse or pool. A FOB is not required to exit the clubhouse or pool area. A post with an exit button will be by each pool gate and the emergency crash bars will provide exiting from the clubhouse. The plan for distribution is

- 1. Available from 8:30 to 9:30 AM at coffee social on Wednesday
- 2. Available at Bingo on Tuesday from 5:30 to 6:30 PM
- 3. Available on Friday from 4 to 6 PM in the clubhouse
- 4. Available by mail. They will be sent in a padded envelope. There will be a minimal charge for the envelope and postage
- 5. There will be a FOB Request/Authorization slip in the Bin by the director's office. Complete that form and place in the Mail slot of the office and the FOB will be placed in your Rock box
- 6. The FOB Request/Authorization slip can be requested by e-mail to <u>briarcreekoff@gmail.com</u>. The FOB will then be mailed or delivered to your rock box.

There will be a \$25 administration fee to replace any FOB that has been lost

Why convert to Key FOB's

Total contract cost for conversion parts, labor, software and key FOB's =\$18,513

Cost per resident 497 total residents = \$37.25

Cost per Unit 317 = \$58.40

Total initial cost = \$15,777.81

Cut Keys have been issued over 40 + years and there is no means to track the keys. They can be duplicated at any hardware store and distributed to anyone. Insurance Liability Cost has already increased to \$25,000 due to a building collapse in Miami. Our pool is identified as having no locks and is unsecured. Our Clubhouse from a legal point is unsecure as we have no control over who has a key to the facility. This offers many legal opportunities to the array of lawyers in the area. The Liability insurance could increase if the pool and or clubhouse is deemed unsecure. That increase will be perpetual.

Medico Keys do provide a second layer of security in so far as the key is registered and most average persons cannot duplicate the key. The keys eventually will migrate and there is no control over who has the key, similar to the many keys now that leave usually when a property is sold. Lost or implied lost keys cannot be disabled. Annually with replacing keys to new owners, as current owners typically do not turn in the key will require 50 x \$19.95 new keys at a cost over \$1,000 per year. In a few years the cost will reach the FOB key cost with less control over who holds the key.

Closing Up for the Summer

Jody Larson

ou can find a lot of information on the internet about what to do with your mobile home when leaving Florida for the summer. Some of it is good, and of course some of it is questionable at

best. Here are my own tips for preparing your home before you go, based on my 20+ years of mobile home living.

- Leave the A/C on. The reason isn't so much for cooling as for dehumidifying. Set the temperature at 80 or 82. This prevents your home from growing mildew in the moist heat.
- Leave the power on, but unplug any devices that don't need to be connected, such as a

printer, modem/router, or TV set. Unplugging is better than just using the on/off switch.

- Call the phone company (if you have a landline) and the TV service. These may have a "vacation" program that gives you a lower cost while you're gone.
- Empty the fridge of perishable foods. Don't turn the refrigerator off—it's better to leave it running—but raise the temperature setting. Do turn off the ice maker!!
- Put plugs in the sink drains, and cover the tops of toilet bowls with plastic wrap. You can also put plastic wrap over shower drains, with a towel or washcloth on top to keep it in place. The primary reason is to prevent evaporation from the drains. Some people say you should add bleach in the drains, but I think this is a really bad idea.
- Of course, you want the home to be clean when you leave to discourage insects. Also put out fresh roach traps and ant traps in likely places.
- Close blinds to keep the sun out.
- Turn off the water to the home at the main shut-off valve (outside).
- Switch off the water heater at the breaker box.
- Make sure to lock everything up, including your shed.

The Pinellas County Sheriff's Office provides vacation house checks, and some owners feel more secure with this service. The deputies do not routinely enter your home, but check the perimeter and the doors and windows. Call (727) 582-6177 to schedule house checks.

- 7. As you look up to the sky, what message might the stars and the heavens above that holds the infinite galaxies share with you?




