

#### FREE FOOD EVENTS

his event is put on by Good Neighbors Inc. They bring us the food sometime in the 1 ½ hours before the scheduled times of 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. Several volunteers wait for them and then unload the food and arrange it on the tables. It is every other Monday, and alternates between 11 a.m. for non-perishables and 3 p.m. for perishables. (dates are on the calendar).

If you have a handicap/medical condition that prevents you from standing in line, just go to the last person currently in line and tell them when the doors open you will get in line behind them. You can then return to your car or golfcart to wait... This is for handicap residents (who may use a cane, walker, electric scooter, etc.). It is not intended for lazy people who just do not want to stand in line!

The Insurance people who set up tables at the back of the Clubhouse help support this event; please do not take the items off their tables unless you are interested in what they have to offer and take the time to listen to them. One Lady represents "One Stop Doctoring," which means that your doctors, x-rays, blood work, other tests and prescriptions are all located in one building. The other lady (or man) represents an insurance company which replaces your Medicare and could provide you better coverages, get extra money in your social security check, a quarterly over the counter credit, maybe a grocery card for \$50 a month, etc. It is worth your time to talk to them.

a New Twist" scheduled for January 22, 2023. More details will be forthcoming in the Fall! A note I received from a resident: "When I moved into the Park, there was not one street you can travel down without hearing a hammer pounding, the buzz of a saw or observe people trimming and planting flowers in their front yard. The residents in the Park are displaying pride of ownership. Everywhere I look I can see reconstruction continuing and older mobiles being refurbished."

I took this as a testament to the overall improvement of the Park, including all the common buildings. Take Pride in your home and lot, take Pride in your Park! You are more than someone who "just pays their rent;" you are a resident of Embassy Mobile Park, Inc. where people call almost every day looking to move here because they hear good things about Embassy!

This is a reminder to all the "Snowbirds"—

#### Please read Rule 12:

- 1. You must make arrangements to have your weeds taken care of while you are gone....this means all around your lot and not just once before you return. (NOTE: If you fail to have your lot maintained, first you will receive a letter that it is overgrown, giving you a time frame to have the work done; if not done, then the Park will do the work and you will be billed).
- 2. Any dead tree limbs that fall on the ground during a storm are required to be removed from your lot within 7 days of occurrence.
- 3. You must notify the office if someone in the Park is taking care of your mobile while you are gone-Name and phone number.
- 4. The office must have your "summer address" and phone number.

ALSO, if someone is going to use your mobile home while you are gone, the Park must be notified before they arrive. If you are letting someone park in your driveway, make sure the office is aware of it. This is for your safety; if a car is seen in your driveway and you are not here, we will know something is wrong.

# If you have a Clubhouse key, please turn it in before you leave! (Everyone) Changing the lock before next season

Remember that there is an activities calendar in the cabinet by the back entrance to the clubhouse. **LEGAL FUND**: Nedra Woodroof, Lot 739, 727-538-9507 (leave a message she will return your call) \$10 a year. Call Nedra or talk to Ron Russell if you are new and would like more information about this Fund. (The "year" is November thru October).

Just a reminder, we have the **free food event**, see the dates in the calendar section.

The next Manager's Meeting will be April 20th, 9:00 A.M. for coffee; meeting at 9:30 a.m.

The Social Club annual dues are \$3.00 per person or \$5.00 for 2 people in the same household. At the next meeting, April 6th, there will be a *GUEST SPEAKER* to talk about insurance. This is valuable information about insurance for your mobile home. You are welcome to attend the meeting without joining, you just cannot vote on anything discussed that needs to be voted on.



#### AND LIFE GOES ON.....

arch 20, 2022 marks the second anniversary of a hasty return home to Canada. Indeed, Covid-19 forced us to return to Canada suddenly, missing Embassy's end of the season activities, as everything here was cancelled.

We went home to mandatory isolation, then restrictions of all kinds and limited visitations, etc. It also included a lot of sacrifices and limitations in our usual activities and even going to restaurants. Our way of life changed drastically!

As For winter 2021, it was mild most of the time and we kept warm at home on colder days. But....it was nothing like the heat and sunny weather of Florida and certainly not anything close to the social life at Embassy Park!

On November 12th after nearly two years of being away, we finally entered in our little winter home in this Park.. Everything was just the same as we left it, but a major cleaning inside and outside was much needed. Even after driving for 33 hours (three days) we worked a considerable number of hours, storing our personal belongings, washing, and cleaning everywhere and everything.

As we ate breakfast the next day, admiring the small lake and its active life from our dining room window, Jeannine and I both looked at each other and simultaneously said to ourselves: "We're staying here; this experience that we've been living for ten years with friends (that are almost like family) in this Park, is too special to end like that."


That is how our decision to sell our home never went through!



The wheelchair ramps at the clubhouse and at the hobby house had new paint and safety strips, and looked quite professional. The 12th street laundromat got some fresh painting inside, and I noticed a couple of days ago some more paint going on the exterior, it looks pretty good. And the grates draining the streets had yellow safety paint put on to outline them, another nice touch. I think some of those grates had been outlined before I left. There are new stop signs up too, the old ones were a bit tired.

In the RV section there are more lots occupied, although those lots were gradually filling before we left. At this point there are only a few lots in the RV section that are not occupied. This makes the park a safer place because there are no vacant mobiles left, or very few, to attract questionable residents, and there are lots of "eyes on the street" to watch for strange people. So we don't have strangers wandering around. Our Neighborhood Watch patrols are also a big help in that regard. And Jessie got rid of several undesirables who had managed, by various means, to get into the park.




