My name is Marty Ott and I live at #340 on India. I have been appointed the Neighborhood Watch Liaison for Serendipity MHP by the HOA and Pinellas County Sheriff's Department. My responsibility in this position is to take calls from the residents of Serendipity and give weekly feedback to the park manager and the PCSO Neighborhood Watch Commander, Deputy Chuck Skipper.

If you see something dangerous or feel threatened, you should call 911. If it is just to report something suspicious, call the Sheriff's non-emergency number at (727) 586-6200. Then call me the next morning at (727) 787-3272 and I will note it in the daily log so that we can categorize the types of problems we are having, and the Sheriff can assign manpower to our park at times and places necessary.

Serendipity residents should **ONLY** call me during regular business hours which are 8:00AM - 5:00PM.



Things That Make You Go...Hmmmmmm?

THE REST OF THE STORY

ne of my favorite movies is "Close Encounters of The Third Kind" which came out in 1977. It has been reported that Steven Spielberg, the movie producer, was shown a film by the Defense Department a couple of years before that movie was produced. The film was reported to cover the subject of UFO's. That is only part of the story. A better understanding of the story requires us to discuss a particular Canadian citizen.



Paul Hellyer (1923 -2021) was the Canadian Minister of National Defense, the highest-ranking person in the Department Defense for Canada. He is credited with combining the Air Force, Navy, and Army into the Canadian Forces. While in the defense department most of this time was spent combining the armed forces and did not get involved in the UFO phenomena. He was given a book titled "The Day After Roswell" that started his interest in UFOs. He knew many of the people and places mentioned in the book and proceeded to get more informed on the subject by reading books on the subject. His conclusion was that all the people could not be lying and became well informed on the subject. His conclusion was that UFO's are real as the airplanes we have flying overhead. At this point he was the highest political figure in the world to make such a statement. He was the equivalent of the United States Secretary of Defense. He started to hear from people who had inside knowledge of UFOs in both Canada and the United States. At this point he started attending UFO conferences throughout the world. In his later years he gave a talk on some information about the film "Close Encounters" because he felt it had to be told. He received this information, from what he called his most reliable source, a general in the U.S. military. This is the rest of story!

When the UFO crashed at Roswell, the surviving alien named Ebe (Extraterrestrial Biological Entity) discussed the controls of the craft and how it communicated. Like in the movie-using tonal sounds. The twelve would be exchanged for one alien. Again, just like in the movie. The timing was originally set for 1964 but put off until 1965. The exchange was made at a Nevada atomic test site (Area51). They were gone for 13 years although it was planned for 10. Only eight returned, two died on the alien planet, and two decided to stay. Those that returned

were debriefed for a year. The last one died in 2002. The planet they were on had 650,000 inhabitants and the aliens had been on that planet about 10,00 years. The returnees had high levels of radiation which was the main reason for their short life spans. That is the rest of the story of "Close Encounters of The Third Kind". Did the government get Spielberg to make the movie to prepare you for full disclosure? This whole event is an enigma wrapped in an enigma!



Pineapple- Cool Whip Cake







THE CURIOSITY CORNER

Snake Oil Salesmen

The 1800s saw thousands of Chinese immigrate to the United States seeking a better future, to escape conditions created by war with major European powers jocking for their special, favorable (unequal) trade zone in Chine. The California gold rush brought many seeking their



Traditional Chinese Medicines included scorpions, freeze-dried millipedes, tiger penises, rhino bones, and... snake oil. The only product from that list that has supposedly proven to work is snake oil, even though it has become a term synonymous with quack cures. Whenever we hear the words, Snake Oil, used in a conversation a couple of conclusions immediately spring to mind: 1) A magical elixir capable of curing a multitude of physical ailments that may include chronic pain, headaches, kidney trouble, insomnia, toothaches, backaches, hair loss, earaches, swelling, dandruff, influenza, fever, restless sleep, chest pains, coughs, etc. 2) Possibly a politician.

It's assumed that Chinese laborers would use snake oil to help relieve muscle aches and pains after a long day of strenuous activity. Later they shared the remedy with other laborers and the effectiveness of this unusual remedy eventually spread throughout the country. The demand for the product increased eventually exceeding available supply. So... enterprising, unscrupulous, individuals began to produce their own version of snake oil, using rattlesnake oil, or mineral oil, instead of oil from the Chinese water snake. Whatever your problem, in the 1800s, there was probably a salesman peddling their version of an elixir, containing proprietary ingredients, that could treat or cure whatever ailed you.

The original snake oil actually seemed to work and is on a very short list of Traditional Chinese Medicines, that have been proven to have, supposedly, observable health benefits, along with, for example, Ginger and Ginseng. It is used to relieve inflammation, pain, and treat arthritis and bursitis. The magical property seems to be the high Omega-3 fatty acid content of the Chinese water snake. The American rattlesnake has a much lower Omega-3 fatty acid content and wasn't nearly as effective. Many salesmen sold products that did not even contain snake oil. Their concoctions contained whatever was available at the time. The prosecution of one man in the early 20th century would help shine a light on unscrupulous salesmen.

Clark Stanley worked as a cowboy for 11 years and referred to himself as the "Rattlesnake King". He decided to become a salesman and debut his wares at the 1893 Columbian Exposition

in Chicago. Dressed in a flamboyant, frontiersman fashion, Stanley got up on stage in front of a crowd, dragging behind him a sack. He reached inside and pulled from it a squirming rattlesnake and held it out in front of the audience for everyone to see. He slit the snake open and tossed it into a pot of boiling water and watched the snake fat rise to the surface. Then he scooped it out and placed it into jars that contained his specially chosen blend of herbs. He then offered his product to the crowd: Clark Stanley's Snake Oil Treatment. They were probably among the few to purchase his product that actually contained snake oil.

For about 24 years he traveled around the country selling his product to the

public.

Then around 1916, the Federal Government seized some product manufactured in Massachusetts and tested it. The product was determined to be drastically overpriced and of dubious value. The analyst found that its main ingredient was "a light mineral oil, mixed with about 1 per cent of fatty oil (probably beef

fat), capsicum, and possibly a trace of camphor and turpentine" (No snake oil). Stanley was found guilty in the U.S. District Court for Rhode Island of misbranding and misrepresenting the product and fined \$20 (about \$480). Stanley, the Rattlesnake King, would be forever known as the first snake oil salesman.

The Oxford English Dictionary defines snake oil as "a quack remedy or panacea." Merriman-Websters dictionary defines snake oil as: any various substances of mixtures sold as medicine usually without regard to their medical worth or properties. Then of course the snake oil salesman is a term used to describe scammers, con-artists, or peddlers of products of little value. So, is it hard to believe that the phrase would not occasionally be used to describe politicians?

Theodore Roosevelt is a snake in a 1906 political cartoon concerning Roosevelt and Standard Oil. I'm sure there are older versions of political cartoons depicting politicians pushing a highly controversial program to address a problem. In those instances, some agree with the proposed plan while others think the politician is spouting pure poppycock, nonsense, or foolishness. Most of the political cartoons that I was able to find, depicting various politicians supposedly peddling a version snake oil, are rather current. Bush peddling reasons for the Gulf War, Obama pushing affordable health care, or gun control for his terrorism policy, and the Iran nuclear deal. Then of course there are those depicting Clinton and Trump. The term however seems to be universal, so you will find foreign politicians depicted under the snake oil salesman classification as well.

There may be a kernel of truth in what is being peddled to you as a fantastic product, miracle cure, power food, or political program. However, I believe you should approach it as you should any rumor, look upon what is stated with a healthy dose of skepticism and objectivity. Research it. You may find that the claims are mostly, possibly entirely, B.S.






