

Otice: Parking/Towing Regulations

Due to so many Questions and Requests Gateway Management is releasing the following statement about the Parking/Towing issue MANAGER at Gateway Mobile Home Park.

The management office has made several attempts since Feb 2018 to get parking in unauthorized spaces under control (Laundry, office, GRASS & Street) with no response from residents. So with that being said, several meetings have taken place with upper management and HOA. After several negotiations and deliberations this is what we came up with.

- 1. No Parking in Grass at any time (water lines)
- 2. No Parking on street after 11pm (No Exceptions)
- 3. No parking in undesignated spaces (Laundry, office, empty pads)
- 4. Overnight parking allowed at office & Laundry (in ONP spaces with Parking Pass during the week) (must be dated & notarized)
- 5. Overnight Parking allowed at office & laundry (in ONP spaces WITHOUT parking pass over the weekend only)
- 6. There are 12 ONP Parking spaces (First come, First serve basis)

I hope this clears up any confusion. I would like to thank the HOA and Upper management for helping us to come to an agreement and get parking under control.

Watch the boards and our social media and News & Do's calendar for our up-coming summer activities. Wishing all of you a healthy, happy summer.



HY YOU SHOULD PICK UP YOUR DOG'S WASTE

A single gram (about the size of a dime) of dog feces contains 23 million fecal coliform bacteria.

Dog feces may harbor dangerous bacteria and viruses such as: shipworms, roundworms, tapeworms, parvo, giardiasis, salmonellosis and cryptosporidosis.

Dog Waste is not fertilizer. It actually kills plants and grasses.

Improperly disposed of or left unchecked, dog waste pollutes our environment and can even filter into our water supply. Uncollected dog waste that washes into streams and storm drains is the #3 contributor to water contamination.

So, pick up your dog's waste. Not only will it help the environment, but it will ensure you and your dog a clean and safe area to enjoy together.

And cigarette smokers, please take the time to dispose of your 'butts' in trash containers. During the winter dry season especially when there are extended periods between our typical Florida 'car wash' rains there is a noticeable of build up of discarded cigarette 'filters' that tend to accumulate at the edge of the streets and in yards. Please be a courteous and responsible smoker by properly disposing of your butts.






