THIS MONTH IN HISTORY

pril 4, 1968 - Civil Rights leader Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King was shot and killed by a sniper in Memphis, Tennessee. As head of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, he had championed non-violent resistance to end racial oppression and had been awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964. He is best remembered for his I Have a Dream speech delivered at the 1963 Civil Rights March on Washington. That march and King's other efforts helped the passage of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965. In 1986, Congress established the third Monday in January as a national holiday in his honor.

April 15, 1912 - In the icy waters off Newfoundland, the luxury liner Titanic with 2,224 persons on board sank at 2:27 a.m. after striking an iceberg just before midnight. Over 1,500 persons drowned while 700 were rescued by the liner *Carpathia* which arrived about two hours after *Titanic went down*.

April 24, 1800 - The <u>Library of Congress</u> was established in Washington, D.C. It is America's oldest federal cultural institution and the world's largest library. Among the 145 million items in its collections are more than 33 million books, 3 million recordings, 12.5 million photographs, 5.3 million maps, 6 million pieces of sheet music and 63 million manuscripts. About 10,000 new items are added each day.

April 30, 1789 - George Washington became the first U.S. President as he was administered the

oath of office on the balcony of Federal Hall at the corner of Wall and Broad Streets in New York City.

Birthday - Renaissance artist Raphael (1483-1520) was born in Urbino, Italy. He created some of the world's greatest masterpieces including 300 pictures with a Madonna theme. He died on his 37th birthday in Rome.







The second is the replacing of the benches on the golf course. A subcommittee has been overseeing this project and as of this writing all 22 benches have been purchased by residents as memorials or as special recognition for loved ones. This process has been used in the past, and the nearly \$13000 cost for the new benches is not being borne by the homeowners. Thanks also to our maintenance staff for removing the old benches and assembling and installing the new ones as they come in from the manufacturer. The first six have already been replaced and we are waiting for delivery of the balance of the benches. This project is expected to finish within the next few months, barring any unforeseen problems with manufacturing or delivery.

The golfing activities are finally becoming more normalized and the golf course is experiencing heavy play during our peak season.






