If you watch channel 13 news in the mornings you are familiar with Charlie Belchers food outings. Recently he touted the smoked fish at Ted Peters in Pasadena. There is a smoke house alongside the restaurant where you can get take out. There is a very small inside sitting area as well as outdoor tables and chairs.

One thing about eating out is you often meet people from other countries who have come here for whatever reason. Ella, our waitperson is from Dusseldorf, Germany I learned upon inquiring as to whether her accent may be German. And just as multitudes of other folks have done, she came for the weather.

We had very large plates of both smoked mullet \$18.99 and smoked mackerel \$23.99. With the fish we had German potato salad which I am not usually fond of, however, this was not Bavarian but a north-west version, and we enjoyed it. Of course, Marty will eat almost anything. I am far more discriminating. There was also coleslaw and a large nice red slice of tomato and white onion. The tomatoes often are a turn off as they are not even red but pale pink. They make their own sauces, and you should not expect the typical tartar sauce. Our sauces had a very mild bite. We had frosty mugs for our wine, the glasses so chilled they stayed cold throughout our meal. I should say, what we were able to eat of our meals. We had huge take-out containers for another meal at another time.

If you like smoked fish, you should definitely try Ted Peters in Pasadena.

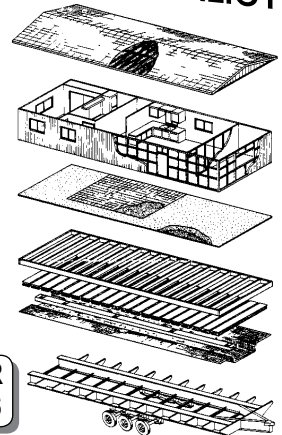

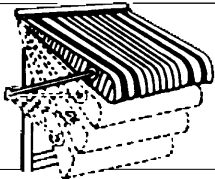

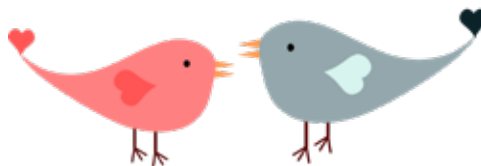

FROM DEE'S KITCHEN TO YOURS

Recipes of the Month by Dee Potenti

Rigatoni with Gorgonzola Cheese

- 4 tablespoons of garlic butter
- 4 links of pesto or Italian sausage
- 1 pint of grape tomatoes
- 4 cups of chicken broth
- One box of rigatoni pasta
- 4 ounces of crumbled Gorgonzola cheese
- 4 cups of baby spinach



Melt garlic butter and sauté sausage till no more pink. Then add tomatoes and cook for a few minutes then set aside. In another pan add chicken broth, when it starts to boil add the pasta. When pasta is cooked add the sausage mixture, spinach, and cheese. When serving add Romano cheese optional.

This is very different but really has a great taste.

Dee's Salmon Patties

- 1 (14.75 oz.) can pink salmon
- 1 egg beaten
- 1 sleeve of a 16oz. box of saltine crackers, crumbled
- Butter flavored Crisco for cooking



Empty salmon into a shallow bowl. Remove skin and bones, retaining liquid with the salmon. Flake salmon with a fork, add egg and stir well. Crush crackers in a separate shallow bowl. Using about 2 tablespoons salmon, roll in cracker crumbs and form into a patty. Fry in a hot skillet using butter flavored Crisco, turn and cook until golden brown on both sides. Drain and serve hot.

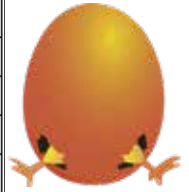
