RECYCLING TIPS FROM RHONDA RECYCLER

ello and welcome to all Lincolnshire Estates residents. Most of us will agree that having a 'Green' recycling site located nearby within the Park is a welcome convenience. However, not all residents are familiar with the 'Do's and Don'ts when it comes to disposing of our recyclables.



- Please DO NOT deposit plastic bags and plastic wrappers into the green containers. During the mechanical separating process, plastic bags and wrappers clog the machine and create delays. As a result, the processing company will levy penalty charges which are ultimately passed on to all of us.
- The large green containers are definitely not meant for the deposit of garbage such as kitchen and food waste, diapers, grease and cooking oil, animal litter and waste, grass clippings and yard garden waste, cloth and clothing, and material that you would classify as 'garbage garbage'. You get the idea.
- On a positive note, most residents do put their cardboard, magazines and newspapers in the green containers. What would be most helpful and space-saving would be to cut down or collapse cardboard containers to make them as flat as possible.
- Lastly, cans, bottles, plastic yogurt and ice cream containers, and tetra-packs are acceptable.

OK, thanks for listening. Though some of the above tips may involve a bit of extra effort on your part, I think you'll agree that it's the right thing to do.

COOKING IN LINCOLNSHIRE

Here is a great Easter Brunch recipe for you to try:

12 large eggs

1/3 cups heavy cream

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

1 1/2 cups frozen broccoli florets, thawed

1/2 cup chopped deli ham (about 2 1/2 ounces)

1/2 cup shredded mild Cheddar

1/2 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese



Preheat the oven to 300 degrees F. Whisk the eggs, cream, 1 teaspoon salt and a few grinds of black pepper together in a large bowl until smooth. Fold in the broccoli, ham, Cheddar and Monterey Jack until well combined.

Pour the mixture into an oven-safe, 10-inch nonstick skillet. Bake until the eggs are just set and no longer jiggly in the middle, 50 to 55 minutes. Let sit for 5 minutes before sliding the frittata out of the skillet onto a serving platter. Slice into wedges to serve.



One has to understand that there are many Federal & State Statutes that govern the management and residents in guiding the direction of operations. That also includes the Board of Directors (BOD). The BOD works at the pleasure of its members; the Officers work at the pleasure of the BOD. We are Directors first with an equal voice and second if you have also been selected to be an Officer.

In addition there are various Committees that assist the Board of Directors.

There are also Documents such as Roberts Rules of Order, LHOA By-Laws, Not for Profit Corporation, FL Admin Laws, Board Member Certification courses, and many others that the Directors must abide by.

Recent Park Lot Inspection Notices sent out by Lincolnshire Management for their monthly routine alluding to the fact that you should "contact you HOA representative" was not approved by the BOD. The Board was not given any jurisdiction at this time to intercede on the Manager's authority.

It is their responsibility in their own words from their Rules and Regulations:

- "Management Reserves the Right, in its absolute discretion.....,";
- "Management reserves the right to determine what constitutes,"
- "Management reserves the right to do the necessary work......"
- "Pre-approved by Management in writing...."
- "Management reserves the right, in its sole and exclusive discretion, to prohibit....."
- "...Community Owner in its sole discretion....."

AND ... Rule 49. Just about sums up all the above.

The HOA is very willing to work with Park Management for your concerns, but feels that there has to be some mutual respect to the Unit Owners as Management demand for themselves.

VETERAN'S CORNER

Land Control and Prevention's community COVID-19 guidelines to determine whether troops, employees and visitors must wear masks indoors or be screened for the coronavirus. Defense officials announced Wednesday that commanders should follow the CDC's COVID-19 Community Levels to determine mask and



screening policies on their bases. The move reflects an announcement last week by the CDC that, under new guidance, more than 70% of the U.S. population can shed their masks, depending on where they live. Using calculations that include hospital admissions for COVID-19, the percentage of inpatient beds taken by COVID-19 patients and new case rates, the map shows counties as green, where indoor masking can be dropped; yellow, where masks are optional but at-risk residents should be cautious; and orange, where universal masking is recommended. According to the new Defense Department guidance, masks and screening will not be required for installations in counties where the CDC COVID-19 Community Level is considered to be low. For communities where the level is deemed medium, screening will continue, but indoor mask requirements can be dropped. in areas where the level is high, screening and indoor mask wearing will continue for all, regardless of vaccination status, according to a memo released Wednesday from Under Secretary of Defense Gilbert Cisneros. Although I was at MacDill AFB on Thursday and they were still requiring them.

Once again, the VA who says that they are always looking at ways to help Veterans will change its disability ratings criteria for mental health conditions, sleep apnea and tinnitus, part of a major overhaul of the review process to ensure that compensation matches veterans' medical conditions and needs, department officials say. The VA plans to update its Schedule for Rating Disabilities -- its guide for determining how it evaluates and provides benefits for service-connected disabilities -- for mental health conditions, to include their impact on veterans' lives, and abolish the "0%" disability rating for any service-connected mental health diagnosis in favor of a 10% minimum, according to a notice published in the Federal Register. For tinnitus, the department will get rid of its stand-alone rating and consider the condition a symptom of whatever underlying disease is its cause. Previously, most conditions were assessed on the number and severity of symptoms, but VA officials said the consideration of lost wages or productivity is needed to ensure that the department compensates veterans appropriately. Officials say the changes, which would go into effect after a period for the public to comment and a final version is published, likely will result in higher disability ratings for veterans with mental health conditions, but fewer qualifying for disability compensation for tinnitus and sleep apnea. Veterans already receiving disability for these conditions will not see their ratings downgraded by any changes, officials said.

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #46

ast month, March, I went over 4 vital steps in using food (sugar.) What we eat, how much we eat, when we eat (a big deal) and movement soon after we have eaten. This month's target is the damage high blood sugars create and testing blood sugar. Medications to mediate the effects of high blood sugar will be in the May edition.

Blood sugar is absolutely needed for life along with oxygen. Our body cells use both to make the energy needed to do their job. The sugar in the blood gets through the cell "door" by insulin, a hormone produced in the



pancreas, which drop kicks the sugar into the cell. A field goal and 3 points millions of times a day everywhere in our body. The blood vessels especially arteries (the smallest pass by each and every body cell) are sensitive to a <u>blood sugar level that stays higher and longer</u> in the blood than usual. Higher blood sugars remaining longer than normal are absolute <u>irritants</u> to the lining of the blood vessel. Over time the lining becomes inflamed especially the very small vessels, called capillaries, and often become "plugged". The blood supply slows and may just stop. We don't get an email or message. The end result can and usually is damage to vital organs like the eyes, heart, kidneys, arteries in the lower legs, nerves and much more. The hard part to swallow is the damage may go undetected until later middle age. Another reason to see our physicians on a regular basis. *Not just when we are sick. Did I say that? Yes I did.*

Basically, there are 2 types of diabetes. Type 1 is where the pancreas ceases to produce insulin or very, very little. Found mostly in young people though can occur when our pancreas becomes severely damaged. Why, teenagers didn't live to middle age before insulin and better monitoring. No cure yet but they take insulin in various ways either continuously by an insulin pump or injections up to 6 times a day. Transplanting with the cells that make insulin is showing promise. Type 2 can be best described as pancreas fatigue or our body cells become insensitive to the insulin we make over time. Prediabetes is simply a warning that our blood sugars remain elevated when the level should be a resting amount but just below graduating to diabetes. You don't want that diploma!

There are 2 basic blood tests for sugar. Yes, blood as that is where we find it. HgbA1c or just "A1c." started about 25 years ago. It measures on a scale of 5 to 16. It is the average "weight" if I can say that of the sugar in the blood over the last 90 days. 5.5 to 6 is normal and the higher the number the higher the average sugar load. Sort of knowing your average driving speed over 90 days. Normal, speeding or reckless. On the spot glucose monitoring with a home meter is exactly what it is, right now. Blood sugars on a monitor should be below 110 starting 2 hours after we have eaten or in the morning before we eat by 8:30 AM. Elevated again right after we eat. Our physicians will tell us when to test, usually fasting (before we put anything and I mean anything in our mouths and swallow) or 2 hours after we have eaten (tells them how we cope with the absorbed sugar.) People who just test anytime to see what their blood sugar is are wasting a valuable test strip for sure. And will certainly remain confused and frustrated. Next month, medications and treatments. Chew well my friends.




