

situation. If settling is noticed, a remediation engineer will be sent to
home for an assessment. If remediation is required, then the Park will pay.
All interior remediation work is at home-owners expense.



A resident saw a County or City Assessor vehicle in the Park. Manager said that Assessor's Office has mentioned seeing that properties are selling at higher prices.

Meeting Agenda: February minutes were approved. President thanked the Santerres and White Elephant workers for another successful event.

Manager's Report: Residents MUST remove mold from homes. Some homes have mold on the North side. Please check them before you leave for your summer homes. Trees with branches hanging over fencing will be trimmed. Some residents continue to put carpets and building materials in the dumpster. This is NOT allowed. Large plastic bags are being used to hide these large items. These items clog the compactor which requires hiring a specialist to clear. These costs will require monthly maintenance fees to be increased. A suggestion was made to rent a dumpster twice yearly for disposal of these items. Another suggestion is to take such items to recycling centers. You can also rent a small dumpster yourself. Contact Sharon at the office for information on prices and vendors who pick up these items.

There will be a Memorial brick walkway to the island. If interested in purchasing a brick, please contact the office. Ceiling fans in the lanai have been replaced. After Clubhouse events, only use water-soaked rags on floor spills. The engineered floors have a special coating that requires a special cleaner. Do not put coffee cups with liquid in them in trash cans. The Board approved purchase of washers and dryers at a cost of \$30,000 or less from Bay Area Laundry Equipment. Machines will be coin-operated. Debra Bannon, title specialist, will give a seminar on title issues on 3/22 at 11 am in Clubhouse. Residents may need permits from city for home remodeling. Check with Office for advice.



Treasurer's Report: Audit was completed. After adjustments are made, a report will be presented. The Reserve Study identifies our 61-year-old park is looking at significant repairs in the future. The actions taken so far have been reactive, not proactive. This study was done in 2013 and updated in 2015. Manager and engineer are following a repair plan of doing work as needed. Mortgage is on target to be fully paid in 2030. At that time, more monies will be deposited in reserve account.

New Business: Siting Committee is reviewing all lots for infractions of Rules and Regulations. Annual Member's meeting is tonight at 7 pm. A quorum is required, 97 units must be represented. Zoom hookup is available. Meeting adjourned. (NOTE: No May meeting is scheduled)

- ½ lb. mushrooms, sliced
- ½ c. Marsala wine
- Parmesan Cheese



Sauté floured veal in the oil and butter. Put into casserole. Add remaining ingredients, sprinkle with Parmesan cheese. Cover and bake 45 minutes at 325 degrees

- 6 c. Rice Krispies

# A VISIT TO MY HOME TOWN – FALMOUTH, CAPE COD, MASSACHUSETTS

was not born in Falmouth but I got here as fast as I could. I was fortunate enough to grow up spending every Summer in Falmouth because my parents and my aunts and uncles

Invested in land on the Coonamessett River in the early 1950s. They paid a whopping \$100 per house lot and joined together as a group to build cottages on each lot. Each cottage cost about \$2300.00, a huge amount for WWII veterans returning to the USA after the war. Those cottages are now worth over \$500,000 each. My parents sold our cottage to cousins in 1955 and promised they would buy us a pony. We never got the pony but we did get my younger brother Patrick in 1956. Luckily my aunt and uncle kept their cottage and I was able to return to Falmouth every summer. When I retired in 2000, Gary and I bought our own place in Falmouth.

If you are thinking of visiting Cape Cod, Falmouth is the ideal starting point to explore the entire Cape. If you look at a map, you will see that Cape Cod is actually an island connected to the mainland by two bridges. The bridge with the least traffic is the Bourne Bridge. If you travel by car, take route 495 which will go directly over the Bourne Bridge. If you fly you should use the



Providence, RI airport (PVD). From September to June Falmouth has a population of 30,000. In July and August the population swells to 140,000 and the traffic is bad. June and September are beautiful months to visit the Cape.

Stop by the Chamber of Commerce on Academy Lane for all kinds of Falmouth information. Falmouth has the longest shoreline on the Cape. There are 9 beaches. I suggest visiting Old Silver Beach because it is open to the public and you can pay a daily fee of \$20 rather than buying a seasonal pass.

There are many fine restaurants in Falmouth. We enjoy the Flying Bridge overlooking Falmouth Harbor. The best pizza can be found at Paul's Pizza. Greek food is great at Estia and Limani. We prefer Limani, more parking and a quieter clientele. Mexican food at Anejo and Casa Vallarta. We prefer Casa Vallarta, less expensive and more parking.

Woods hole is a neighborhood in Falmouth renowned for the Marine Biological Lab and the Woods Hole Oceanographic Institute. Jacque Cousteau and Alvin the one-man submarine. There is very little parking in Woods Hole and it is highly regulated. If you must go, please consider taking the open-air trolley or the shuttle busses for the Martha's Vineyard Ferry. Speaking of Martha's Vineyard, you can take the Island Queen ferry from Falmouth Harbor to Oak Bluffs, MV. Take the ferry ride, have lunch at Nancy's and shop til you drop. Then take the Island Queen back to Falmouth.

#### 6-LAYER CHOCOLATE COCONUT CASHEW GRAHAM BARS

by Karen Durbin

Makes  $32 - 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " bars

- Nonstick vegetable oil spray
- 18 graham crackers (about 2 sleeves)
- ½ c. (1 stick) unsalted butter, melted and slightly cooled
- ½ t. kosher salt
- 6 oz. semisweet chocolate, chopped
- 1 c. unsalted, roasted cashews, coarsely chopped (or your favorite or mixed)
- 1 c. unsweetened coconut flakes
- 1 c. cornflakes
- 1 14 oz. can sweetened condensed milk
- Flaky sea salt

Preheat oven to 350. Lightly coat a 9 x 13 baking dish with nonstick spray, then line with parchment paper, leaving a 2" overhang on long sides. Coat parchment paper with nonstick spray. Pulse graham crackers in a food processor until finely ground. Add butter and kosher salt and pulse to combine. Press graham cracker mixture into bottom of prepared baking dish. Scatter chocolate, cashews, coconut and cornflakes over crust. Pour condensed milk evenly over top. Bake until coconut is pale golden brown, 20-25 minutes. Transfer dish to wire rack and sprinkle bar with sea salt. Let cool. Use parchment paper to lift bar out of pan and onto a cutting board. Trim edges, cut into thirty-two 1½ " squares.
