





Investing in cryptocurrency

Ave you dabbled in cryptocurrency? Do you even know what it is? The Pew Research Center reports that 86% of Americans say they've heard at least a little about Bitcoin, Ether, or other forms of cryptocurrency, and 24% say they've heard a lot about them. And 16% say they've invested in cryptocurrency, or traded it, or used it for themselves.

They tend to be younger—about 31% of Americans 18-29 say they've invested in, traded, or used cryptocurrency. They're more likely to be men overall—22%, versus 10% of women. Only 3% of people 50+ have done anything with cryptocurrency.

U.S. consumers want 500 miles for their electric cars

Electric cars may be getting more popular, but not all Americans are in a rush to buy one. One factor: Driving range. Deloitte's 2022 Global Automotive Consumer Study, which surveyed 26,000 people of driving age worldwide (1,031 of them American), found that Americans, on average, won't be comfortable with an electric vehicle unless it has a range of 518 miles between charges.

So far, only one car on the market, the Lucid Air, can satisfy that demand, with an EPA-certified range of 520 miles for its Dream Edition—which sells for \$169,000.

Drivers in other countries aren't quite as demanding. German drivers surveyed said they'd be satisfied with an average of 383 miles, and Chinese drivers would be OK with just 258 miles.



Guard yourself against carjackers

arjackings are all too common these days, and many people are nervous about the possibility of becoming a victim. The Philly Voice website offers these tips for staying safe from carjackers:



- Watch your surroundings. Be extra careful in areas and situations where carjacking is more likely. These include when you're getting into and out of your vehicle, in parking lots and garages, at gas stations and ATMs, and on poorly lit streets.
- Don't linger. Start up and drive away immediately after getting into your car.
- Lock up. Keep your windows and doors locked at all times.
- Hang onto your phone. Don't leave your cell phone in your vehicle. Keep it in your pocket so you can immediately call the police if your vehicle is stolen.
- **Don't stop.** If you see a stranded motorist on the road, don't pull over. Call 911 to report their location to the police.
- **Don't resist.** If you're confronted by a carjacker, don't fight or argue. Give up your car and let them leave.
- **Pay attention.** Do your best to memorize the carjacker's appearance so you can provide a detailed description to the police.
- Child on board? Tell would-be carjackers if you have a small child in the back seat. Most won't want to drive away with a child and risk a kidnapping charge.
- **Beware of "bump and runs."** A team of carjackers bumps your car with their own vehicle. When you get out to check for damage, one of them jumps in your car and steals it. Instead, stay inside with your flashers on and call the police, or drive to the nearest police station.

The ground beneath you is shifting, and either you get sucked in by holding on to old ways, or you take a giant step forward by taking some risks and seeing what happens.
