



MOTHERS DAY TRIVIA

he official Mother's Day holiday arose in the 1900s as a result of the efforts of Anna Jarvis, daughter of Ann Reeves Jarvis. Following her mother's 1905 death, Anna Jarvis conceived of Mother's Day as a way of honoring the sacrifices mothers made for their children. Gaining financial backing from a Philadelphia department store owner named John Wanamaker, in May 1908 she organized the first official Mother's Day celebration at a Methodist church in Grafton, West Virginia. That same day also saw thousands of people attend a Mother's Day event at one of Wanamaker's retail stores in Philadelphia.

Following the success of her first Mother's Day, Jarvis—who remained unmarried and childless her whole life—resolved to see her holiday added to the national calendar. Arguing that American holidays were biased toward male achievements, she started a massive letter writing campaign to newspapers and prominent politicians urging the adoption of a special day honoring motherhood.

By 1912 many states, towns and churches had adopted Mother's Day as an annual holiday, and Jarvis had established the Mother's Day International Association to help promote her cause. Her persistence paid off in 1914 when <u>President Woodrow Wilson</u> signed a measure <u>officially establishing</u> the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day.

Once Mother's Day became a national holiday, it was not long before florists, card companies and other merchants capitalized on its popularity.

While Jarvis had initially worked with the floral industry to help raise Mother's Day's profile, by 1920 she had become disgusted with how the holiday had been commercialized. She outwardly denounced the transformation and urged people to stop buying Mother's Day flowers, cards and candies.

Jarvis eventually resorted to an open campaign against Mother's Day profiteers, speaking out against confectioners, florists and even charities.

Did you know? More phone calls are made on Mother's Day than any other day of the year. These holiday chats with Mom often cause phone traffic to spike by as much as 37 percent.

- 1 tsp. corn starch
- ½ tsp baking soda
- 1 cup slivered almonds
- 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup sweetened coconut

Directions:

- Cream butter, sugar, egg and extracts.
- 2. Add dry ingredients.
- 3. Fold in chocolate chips, almonds and coconut.
- 4. Chill dough for at least 2 hours.
- 5. Roll into balls, place on greased cookie sheet about 2" apart.
- 6. Bake for 10-11 minutes until edges have set and tops are just set, do not over bake.
