### From the Board of Directors

Things have changed dramatically at Blue Jay over the last month. Most of our snow birders have headed north, leaving the 63 % who are permanent residents to settle in for another warm summer. I hope everyone staying and those returning in the fall remain healthy and happy. I look forward to seeing everyone when I get back.



Blue Jay is looking quite "spiffy" right now. The palms have been given their semi-annual "hurricane haircut." All of our signs have been repainted and are looking sharp. The trim on the mailbox cover has been repainted. Even the trash cans in the pool area are showing a new coat of paint. We thank the volunteers who gave of their time and skill to accomplish the updates.

For our pet owners, a reminder that pets must be on a leash at all times. The leash can be no longer than 6 feet. These are both Pinellas County ordinances. Blue Jay documents state that pet feet can only touch the ground in the pet section. Your cooperation is appreciated.

At this time of year our rental units also begin tying up their winter rentals for next year. If you have plans to rent out your unit you must complete an application and submit it to the Association Resident Occupancy Committee along with a lease agreement. New renters will need to have a background check. All rentals must be approved by the Association. A lease agreement is required, and the term of the lease cannot exceed 1 year. For long-term renters a new agreement and approval must be done annually. This is necessary as part of the Fair Housing Act and our designation as a 55+ community and is detailed in our documents. If you have questions or need paperwork, contact Sheila Voss for assistance.

If you are heading away for more than 1 week, please have someone look after your home for you. Your planter and driveway must be clear of anything that could be tossed around in a storm.

While I am up north I will continue to participate in the Monday operations meetings via telephone and be involved in any projects that arise. There will be four Board members in Blue Jay most of the time. Individuals may take a vacation and be missing for a few days to a couple of weeks, but there should be plenty of Board coverage all summer. 




