

Wildfires damage ozone layer

The world's ozone layer, which protects Earth from the sun's ultraviolet radiation, was seriously damaged by the catastrophic Australian wildfires of 2019 and 2020, the Science News website reports. An analysis of data from the lower stratosphere has found that smoke particles shot up into the high atmospheric region and start.



that smoke particles shot up into the high atmospheric region and started a series of chemical reactions that drastically altered the balance of gases up there.

Concentrations of ozone in the stratosphere at first rose in early 2020, caused by chemical reactions that create ozone pollution at ground level and can be caused by smoke from wildfires.

The ozone layer was damaged for a long time by chlorofluorocarbons and other substances, but recovered after an international agreement was made to reduce emissions. As massive wildfires caused by climate change occur more frequently, scientists warn that the ozone could start to disappear again.

Tiny 'drug factory' boosts immune system to fight cancer

Scientists have built a minuscule "drug factory" capsule that can manufacture and release medications inside the body and boost the immune system against cancer, the Science Focus website reports.



The capsules, implanted into mice, create doses of a compound called cytokine, a natural substance produced by bodies that tells the immune system when and where to act against infection. The capsules, which are spherical, have an outer layer made of a polymer that's compatible with a human body, covering an inner "factory" of cytokine-producing cells derived from humans. The porous capsule allows nutrients inside to feed the cells, and lets the cytokines out into the body to fight cancer. The drug factories only have to be administered once, and they continue manufacturing and releasing the dose until the cancer is eradicated.

The researchers say that after determining the right number of capsules to implant in mice used as test subjects, they were able to eliminate tumors in 100% of mice with ovarian cancer, along with seven out of eight mice with colorectal cancer.






Guard yourself against carjackers

arjackings are all too common these days, and many people are nervous about the possibility of becoming a victim. The Philly Voice website offers these tips for staying safe from carjackers:



- Watch your surroundings. Be extra careful in areas and situations where carjacking is more likely. These include when you're getting into and out of your vehicle, in parking lots and garages, at gas stations and ATMs, and on poorly lit streets.
- Don't linger. Start up and drive away immediately after getting into your car.
- Lock up. Keep your windows and doors locked at all times.
- **Hang onto your phone.** Don't leave your cell phone in your vehicle. Keep it in your pocket so you can immediately call the police if your vehicle is stolen.
- **Don't stop.** If you see a stranded motorist on the road, don't pull over. Call 911 to report their location to the police.
- **Don't resist.** If you're confronted by a carjacker, don't fight or argue. Give up your car and let them leave.
- Pay attention. Do your best to memorize the carjacker's appearance so you can provide a detailed description to the police.
- Child on board? Tell would-be carjackers if you have a small child in the back seat. Most won't want to drive away with a child and risk a kidnapping charge.
- Beware of "bump and runs." A team of carjackers bumps your car with their own vehicle. When you get out to check for damage, one of them jumps in your car and steals it. Instead, stay inside with your flashers on and call the police, or drive to the nearest police station.

Investing in cryptocurrency

ave you dabbled in cryptocurrency? Do you even know what it is? The Pew Research Center reports that 86% of Americans say they've heard at least a little about Bitcoin, Ether, or other forms of cryptocurrency, and 24% say they've heard a lot about them. And 16% say they've invested in cryptocurrency, or traded it, or used it for themselves.

They tend to be younger—about 31% of Americans 18-29 say they've invested in, traded, or used cryptocurrency. They're more likely to be men overall—22%, versus 10% of women. Only 3% of people 50+ have done anything with cryptocurrency.

U.S. consumers want 500 miles for their electric cars

lectric cars may be getting more popular, but not all Americans are in a rush to buy one. One factor: Driving range. Deloitte's 2022 Global Automotive Consumer Study, which surveyed 26,000 people of driving age worldwide (1,031 of them American), found that Americans, on average, won't be comfortable with an electric vehicle unless it has a range of 518 miles between charges.



So far, only one car on the market, the Lucid Air, can satisfy that demand, with an EPA-certified range of 520 miles for its Dream Edition—which sells for \$169,000.

Drivers in other countries aren't quite as demanding. German drivers surveyed said they'd be satisfied with an average of 383 miles, and Chinese drivers would be OK with just 258 miles.






