





- 2014 Pro Russian group seizes parts of Donetsk and Luhansk on the Russian border.
- 2017 Ukraine association with European Union is ratified.
- 2019 Zelensky is elected president.
- 2022 Russia invades Ukraine.







## **Curiosity Corner**

#### The U.S. Army Camel Corp.

There is a small town in Arizona just off I-10, about 18 miles from the California border, called Quartzsite. It's an extremely arid area, composed mostly of dirt, sand, and rock. Even the tall hills and mountains in the distance seem void of trees and shrubbery. It is one of the hottest places in the United States, with recording temperatures as high as 122° F. There is a truck stop on each side of the interstate highway exit. They give truck drivers their last opportunity to fill up before entering, or to fill up after exiting California where the price of fuel is considerably higher.



In its early history it was a water hole and stage station, called Tyson Wells, for those traveling to California. In the surrounding valley, there had been several successful working gold mines, worked by individual prospectors since the start of the Colorado Gold Rush, today the city relies primarily on tourism. It hosts a Rubber Tramp Rendezvous (for van-dwellers), nine gem shows and 15 swap meets, attracting about 2 million people annually. On the opposite side of the street of the Pilot truck stop, down a narrow road, behind a small park for campers, the road opens into a parking lot, and on the far side is a cemetery, and within it stands a small pyramid with a plaque attached to it. The plaque dedicates the pyramid monument to a man called Hi Jolly and provides a glimpse of an unusual piece of American history.

We usually associate camels with parts of Africa, the Middle East, and Asia carrying heavy loads of cargo across the desert sands to far away destinations. They have been used by humans for thousands of years. Although it isn't known when camels were first domesticated, specially designed saddles appeared around 1200 BC so they could be ridden and modified somewhere

between 500 - 100 BC for military purposes. There is documented use by the Romans and Persians that they also used them in combat. Their scent at close range would scare off horses.

In the 1800s, the belief in Manifest Destiney, free land, and the supposed riches in the Golden Land of California beckoned Americans ever westward. However, they found that their journey was more than just traveling through forests, crossing prairies, or fending off attacks. The journey for many would require them to cross the large, dry, sandy, arid desert regions that claimed parts of Arizona, California, and Utah. This natural barrier could possibly impede development of transportation routes in the Southwestern states, and one man thought of a novel solution. Why not use an animal better suited to the arid environment of the southwest territory, the camel?

The use of camels seemed to be a logical solution, one to be a least explored. They have some unusual physical characteristic especially suited for the arid environment. Camels aren't picky eaters. Their thick lips allow them to eat even thorny plants. They can rehydrate faster than other animals, capable of drinking 30 gallons of water in 13 minutes. (Another source stated as much as 53 gallons in 3 minutes) Their humps consist of stored fat which can be metabolized when food and water is scarce. They do well in temperatures between 20° to 120° F. They have two rows of long eye lashes, and a third, clear eyelid to protect their eyes from blowing sand, and are also able to shut their nostrils to keep out the sand during sandstorms. They can carry 300 - 600 lbs. on their backs, which helped these unique animals earn the nickname, "Ships of the Dessert."

There are two accounts of who came up with the idea. One account gives credit to Captain George H. Crossman. In 1836 he promoted the idea to anyone that would listen at the War Department but to no avail. It wasn't until Major Henry C. Wayne proposed the idea 10 years later, after performing an extensive study on how it would improve Army transportation in the Southwestern region that the idea was acted upon. The second account credits General Edward F. Beale with the idea of using camels for military purposes, when he and Kit Carson were exploring Death Valley, according to an account written by Beale's son. However, in each account it wasn't until in 1853, after the idea reached the Secretary of War, Jefferson Davis (future President of the Confederacy), that the idea was taken seriously. It took two years to persuade President Franklin Pierce and Congress of the anticipated advantages of using camels for military and other purposes. Congress then decided to grant \$30,000 to fund the unusual project.

In 1856 after a three-month voyage, Major Henry C. Wayne, five hired handlers and 33 camels docked in Indianola, Texas. Later in 1857, Secretary of War John B. Floyd, part of James Buchanan's administration would purchase 44 more camels, bringing the total to 77 camels. These camels were taken to Camp Verde, Texas, which became the home of U.S. Camel Corp.

The soldiers were taught by the hired handlers about the camel's peculiarities, proper handling, and care. According to some individuals their odor was atrocious, until you became used to it. Horses were prone to panic around them. They were known for terrible tempers and spitting on people, which also contains some of their stomach contents. Spitting and kicking are defense tactics when the animals feel threatened. The larger camels can make a variety of sounds, one of which was apparently used for Chewbacca's voice in Star Wars. These traits did little to endear them to many common soldiers.

Skeptical officers eventually realized their value as they repeatedly demonstrated their superiority over horses and mules. They could carry considerably more weight, out distance horses and mules, and while slower than horses, had a higher average speed over long distances.

During one demanding survey expedition several horses and mules died, while all the camels took the journey in stride and safely returned without injury. The officer in command of the expedition gave a glowing report about the camel's performance. In 1860, Lt. Col. Robert E. Lee after using them in a long-range patrol, also gave great reviews. In every instance in which they were used, glowing reports were issued. The Secretary of War even requested Congress to purchase 1,000 more camels but that never happened.

No formal reason was ever given for the lack of interest by Congress and others in the military. Some believe that a powerful mule lobby may have torpedoed the idea. Perhaps their feet were not well suited to some of the rocky terrain they had to cross. Others believe that the outbreak of the Civil War prevented the war department's further experimentation with camels for military purposes. Another proposed theory for the failed experiment was that the major supporters became Confederates; Jefferson Davis president of the Confederacy, and Henry Wayne and Robert E. Lee became generals in the Confederate Army.

When Texas seceded, the camels at Camp Verde were scattered to the four winds. Some meandered down to Mexico and up to Colorado, several were used for confederate mail service, the tombstone of one nicknamed Old Douglas, can be found in the confederate cemetery at Vicksburg. In 1864 the U.S. Army auctioned off those still in its possession. By 1866, many had been sold to traveling circuses, mining companies or simply turned loose to fend for themselves. It has been reported that the last sighting of a roaming camel was around 1941, another source stated 1956.

One of the first hired Ottoman (Syrian) caretakers was named Hadji Ali. Soldiers mispronounced his name so badly that they started to call him "Hi Jolly". The name he would answer to for the remainder of his life. "Hi Jolly" was saddened to lose the camels when the army discontinued the program. He tried his hand for a while at gold mining and running a camel freight service but without success. He moved to Tucson to work with the U.S. Army as a scout. In 1880 he became a citizen, changed his name to Philip Tedro, and married Gertrude Serna. In 1889, three years after the surrender of Geronimo, he left his wife and three children, to meander the desert as a prospector. In 1898 declining health forced him to return to Tucson, hoping that his wife would take him back, she refused. He returned to Tyson Wells (Quartzsite), Arizona where he

lived until his death in December 1902, at the age of 64. Three decades later the Arizona highway department built the monument (shown above) for him, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, a pyramid of quartz and petrified wood topped by a copper figure of a camel. The sign says, "The last camp of Hi Jolly."
