FROM THE BOARD By Tim Caddell



# **ASK MIKE**

ately we've seen an influx of new residents in Clearwater Cascades. As you would expect, these new neighbors are much younger that the neighbors they've replaced. They have also introduced an uptick in the number of golf

cart type vehicles and I've been asked to investigate the rules surrounding their use in and out of the park.

First of all, the term golf cart in the Florida statutes refers to the carts that are used on golf courses. Carts used for other purposes are referred to as "Low Speed Vehicles (LSV) in the statutes.

The CCHOA Rules and Regulations have some rules that apply to golf carts (LSV's) used in the Park. The first of which is:

All vehicles being used at night should have proper light, reflectors, etc. These include bicycles, handicapped vehicles, golf carts, etc.

Another rule pertaining to golf carts is:

A valid driver's license is mandatory to drive any type of motorized vehicle in the Community (handicapped scooter excluded).

A third rule for golf carts as well as other forms of transportation:

Motorcycles, motor bikes, motor scooters, go-carts, ATVs, trikes, or similar types of internal combustion powered forms of transportation are prohibited from the Community. The only exception being if they are stored on a trailer or RV in the compound. The Community reserves the right to ban from the Community any other machines including excessively noisy or unsafe trucks and automobiles. Electricpowered scooters (either 2 or 3 wheel) and battery-powered golf carts are allowed but must adhere to all Florida rules of the road and may be driven ONLY BY ADULT PARK RESIDENTS.

As you can see, this rule allows battery powered bikes, scooters and golf carts driven by ADULT PARK RESIDENTS but prohibits any gasoline powered vehicle other than cars and trucks with compliant exhaust systems.

Lastly, use of these vehicles is limited to roadways in the park. The grassy, common area around the office, clubhouse and pavilion is for walking only.

For golf carts driven outside of the Park, the Florida Statutes outlines requirements for registration, licensing, etc. Hopefully this information will help assist everyone in safe operation in the Park.




