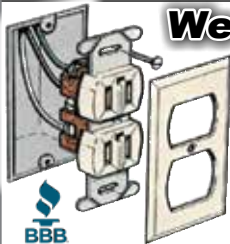

**H**ello from the Main Office. It is now May and slowly creeping from spring hot to summer hot. Let's check out my notes and see if we have a good topic for this month.

We shall talk about yards (yes, again). Per the Rules and Regulations, you are responsible for the upkeep of the lawn, trees, shrubs, etc. thereon including trimming, watering, weeding, edging and general care. This is notice to all residents that if you do not keep your lawn up to the Park standards, Teakwood Village MHP will have the yard maintained and you will be responsible for the cost incurred.

Let me explain. Teakwood provides mowing of the grass. You need to take care of the rest of the yard work. You may not agree with how it gets trimmed if you do not make sure that it does not become overgrown.

Yards are to be grass not stones or mulch.

Satellite dishes are not trees/shrubs/flowers and are not allowed in yards. If you have satellite TV service the dish must be attached to your home. If it is an unused dish in your yard please contact the main office for further instructions.

Pinellas County is still under the same water restrictions. You will find them posted in the clubhouses or you can contact the main office for the information.

Remember to take care of your yard or have a friend or hire a service if you are not able to do so to avoid large bills each month for Teakwood to have it done.

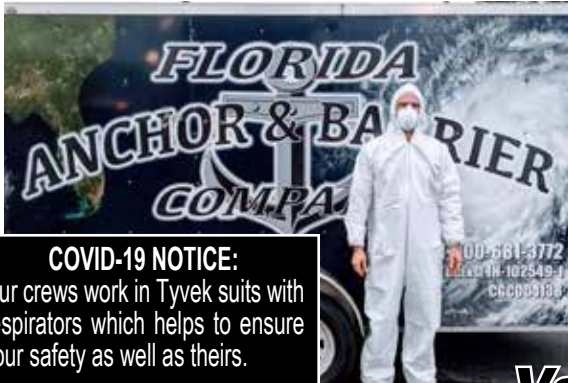

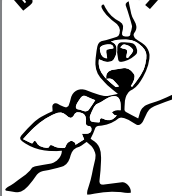

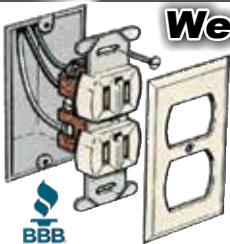

## DINING OUT

**F**renchy's Rockaway Grill located at 7 Rockaway St, Clearwater, FL ; open Sunday through Thursday 11 am – 11 pm, Friday & Saturday 11 am – 12 am; dine-in, drive-thru, no delivery



I got together with some of my favorite snowbirds, before they headed north, for dinner on the beach. We started with a few appetizers to share: Frenchy's Garlic Crab Fries – beer battered topped with garlic aoli & snow crab (\$5.95 ½ order, \$10.95 full order), Baked Oysters Rockaway – oysters topped with finely chopped spinach, spices, onion, bacon & pepper loaf cheese sauce (\$9.95) and Beach Crab Rangoon – crab meat & cream cheese in a fried wonton served with raspberry dipping sauce. All of these were good, but the star was the baked oysters. Even Cathy who is not an oyster fan liked them. The best thing about the crab Rangoon was the dipping sauce.

The entrees we chose were The Three Kings (\$19.95) with Cajun seasoning, the Baked Stuffed Grouper (\$22.95) and the North Beach Scallops (\$18.95) with the Cajun seasoning, All entrees came with two sides. The Three Kings is a seafood delight of 4 shrimp, 4 scallops & a small grouper filet. All were cooked just right which is not as easy as it sounds as they each have slightly different cooking times. Mike had the Cajun seasoned scallops with mixed vegetables. The scallops were cooked to perfection; nicely seared on the outside side and milky white and tender on the inside. The worst thing you can do to a scallop is over cook it. The cauliflower & carrots in the medley were fine but the broccoli was a little over cooked. The Baked Stuffed Grouper was very fresh (funny how you can taste the difference) and had a crab meat, onions, green peppers & celery stuffing topped with a Dijon caper hollandaise sauce. One of my sides was the coconut rice which is cooked in coconut milk so you could really taste that subtle flavor. Desserts were limited so we passed. Besides we were all quite satisfied after our meal.

Though we went on a Tuesday there was still a line to get in, but things moved very quickly. By the time we ordered and got our drinks from one of the several bars, our table was ready. Marcus, our waiter was laid back as you might expect at a beach restaurant but had the answers to our menu questions when asked. Even though the place was very busy he never rushed us but was there when we needed him. All in all, good marks.

Frenchy's has been a favorite of tourists and locals for fresh seafood for over 40 years. Seniors, young families & 20 something singles can all be found here. There are 6 locations of "Frenchy's" restaurants in the Clearwater/Dunedin area, all with the same basic menu. Of course, at the Clearwater location you also get a view of the gulf and spectacular sunsets.

- 3 Tbsp. olive oil
- 1 garlic clove
- 1 tsp. dried dill
- 1/2 c. brine-cured black olives, pitted and cut up fine
- 1/3 cups pine nuts



Cook the beans in boiling water until tender-crisp. In a saute pan, saute the garlic, dill, olives and pine nuts for 3 - 5 minutes or until the nuts are browned. Add the beans and stir until coated.

Place the chicken in a single layer in baking dish. Saute onions in margarine remaining in skillet until tender. Add broth and wine, bring to a boil. Pour around chicken and bake, uncovered, in preheated 350 oven for 40 minutes. Meanwhile, sauté mushrooms in remaining 3 Tbsp. margarine, add to chicken just before serving serves 8

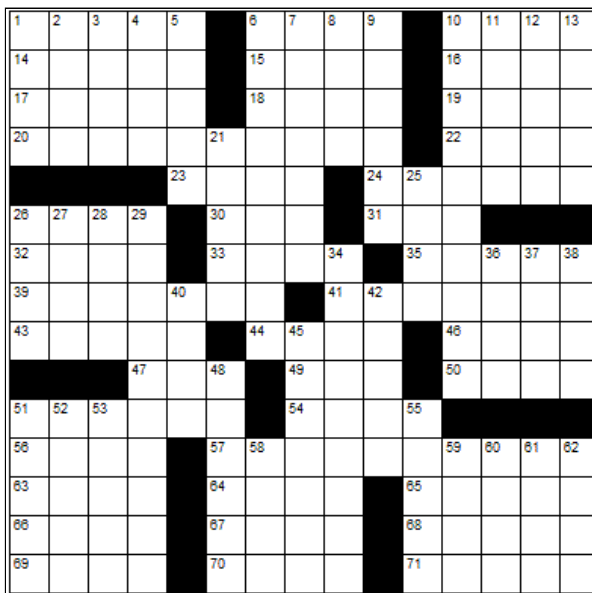

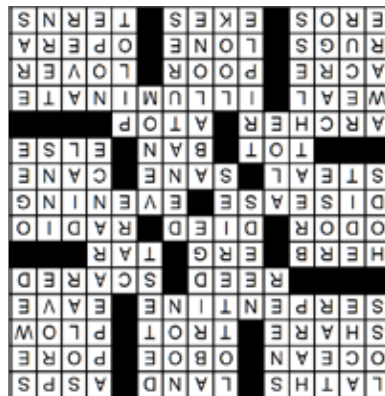
