

Paradise Island Neighborhood Watch

The Paradise Island Neighborhood Watch is up and running. Signs have been posted to announce that suspicious activity will be immediately reported.

The mission of the Paradise Island Neighborhood Watch, in partnership with the Largo Police Department, is to improve the safety, security and well-being of all residents and their property through community awareness and involvement.

ALL residents are encouraged to make thoughtful observations as they go about their normal routines. You may be a people watcher, you may bike or walk around the community. What do you observe? Do you see something that is out of the ordinary, something that is concerning? If you observe something emergent or a crime in progress, 911 is the proper call to make. Be ready to provide as much detailed information as you are able. What did the individual look like? What were they wearing? What was the color and make of the vehicle? Were you able to get the license plate number? Remember report information, DO NOT approach/confront suspicious individuals. Your safety comes first!

If you see someone trespassing, an abandoned vehicle, solicitation, have a nuisance issue (loud noise, party complaint), feel the need for a welfare check (maybe mail or newspapers are piling up), please contact the Police Non-Emergency number - 727-587-6730 - and give them the necessary information.

These are some examples on when to contact the Police Department. You will need to use your best judgment on which number to call. Most importantly, if you see something, say something! After you have contacted the Police Department, please contact your Block/Section Captain. Please make that contact between the hours of 9am and 9pm and within 24 hours of the incident. This enables us to follow up with police and report back to the community as appropriate. Communication and information are powerful tools.

Together as a community, we can improve the safety, security and overall well-being of our neighborhood.



Creature Feature: Gopher tortoise

By Pam Stover

opher tortoises are found in all 67 counties across Florida and have been on the planet for 60 million years! These long lived, gentle reptiles are considered a keystone species because they dig burrows that provide shelter for nearly 350 other native wildlife species. Their burrows, which they excavate with



their front feet, are from 30 to 45 feet in length and up to 10 feet underground. The burrows keep them, and other animals, safe from predators, wildfires and the hot sun. Female tortoises lay ping pong-like eggs after reaching maturity, but only a few of the babies will survive to adulthood.

Our native tortoise faces many threats, including development of their preferred upland habitats. FWF continues to promote gopher tortoise habitat conservation and appropriate land use and management practices. We also educate the public about this important and wonderful creature. Remember to never put a gopher tortoise in water! They do not swim and are strictly land animals.

If you see a gopher tortoise crossing a road, and it is safe for you to do so, you may move it across the road in the same direction it was headed.

VETERAN'S CORNER

he Memorial Day Celebration this year will take place at the Veteran's Memorial at Largo Central Park at 9am on 30 May.



The Department of Veterans Affairs has unveiled a plan that calls for closing 17 aging or underused medical centers, while shifting services to more than 30 new or rebuilt hospitals. In some cases, it would rely on private care. Under the nearly \$2 trillion proposal released Monday, the department would lose a net of three medical centers and 174 outpatient health clinics but would gain 255 health care facilities, including new clinics, stand-alone rehabilitation centers and nursing homes. Medical centers in areas with diminishing veteran populations are among those slated to close, while others would be built in growing urban centers, the West and the South -- areas where veteran populations are growing. The recommendations, which represent the VA's vision for future health care delivery to more than 12 million veterans in the next 25 to 50 years, are the first step in an asset and infrastructure review required by Congress in 2018. The infrastructure modernization proposals will be reviewed next by an independent commission, which will provide its own input. The final plan must be approved by Congress before being enacted. Under the plan, 17 medical centers in 12 states would close, 18 in 16 states would be completely replaced, and 13 new centers would be built in 11 states.

Of the 17 slated for closure, three are in New York City or its suburbs, including Castle





Point, Manhattan and Brooklyn. Two each are in Pennsylvania (Philadelphia and Coatesville), Virginia (Salem and Hampton), and South Dakota (Fort Meade and Hot Springs).

Other medical centers on the proposed closure list include those in: Livermore, California, Dublin, Georgia, Fort Wayne, Indiana, Alexandria, Louisiana, VA Central Western Massachusetts, Battle Creek, Michigan, Chillicothe, Ohio, Muskogee, Oklahoma.

Some of these facilities would shift services to nearby civilian hospital networks or become multi-specialty community outpatient clinics, while others would shift their patients to newly built VA medical centers or bolstered existing hospitals nearby.

New medical centers also would be built at: Newport News and Norfolk, Virginia, Macon and Gwinnett County, Georgia, Huntsville, Alabama, Summerville, South Carolina, Grand Rapids, Michigan, Everett, Washington, Colorado Springs, Colorado, Anthem, Arizona. Another 18 medical centers would be completely rebuilt, either on existing land nearby.

Fortunately, as of right now none of the centers or clinics in Fl will be affected.






