<u> Dumpsters – Garbage</u>

Just a few reminders:

- Please use garbage bags when possible so that your trash does not fly out of the dumpster, grocery bags are very light and tend to fly when they dump the dumpster into the truck.
- Put everything in the dumpster, not around the dumpster, no one else wants your trash.
- There are 3 dumpsters that everyone is allowed to use. You are not assigned to one dumpster, so if your usual dumpster is full, please take to one of the other two.
- Do not put trash in the blue recycle bins, also no garbage bags or grocery bags in the recycle bins.
- When it comes to recycling, we put out a pamphlet in the newsletter to remind everyone of all the do's and don'ts of recycling in Clearwater (It is different in every county and every state). Please follow the flyer and when you are in doubt, please just throw it out. It is better to throw it out than to put the wrong items into the recycling system.
- If you have any scrap metal or old appliances that you need to get rid of, there is a junkman that will come to your home and pick it up and take it off for free for you. Scrappy (813) 382-6646. He will also come and pick up those items that you are not allowed to put in the dumpster, such as mattresses, furniture, or other large items but he does charge a FEE for this. You can also call a local thrift store such as St Vincent's, hospice, goodwill, or Salvation army and donate to them if the item is in good repair.



- 3oz rice vermicelli noodles
- 12 large shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 1 large carrot, julienned
- 2 cucumbers, julienned
- 8oz cabbage, thinly sliced
- 1tbsp fish sauce
- 1tbsp brown sugar
- 1/4c rice vinegar
- 12 large rice paper sheets
- 2tbsp black sesame seeds
- 12 fresh mint leaves
- 12 fresh basil leaves

Peanut Sauce

- 1/2c peanut butter
- 1tbsp low sodium soy sauce
- 2tbsp rice vinegar
- 1 clove garlic
- 1tbsp freshly grated ginger
- 4tbsp boiling water
- 1/4c crushed toasted peanuts

Directions:

- Place noodles in bowl, cover with boiling water, let stand for 5 minutes, use scissors to cut noodles into random lengths
- Poach shrimp in salted boiling water until pink and opaque. Rinse in cold water and slice lengthwise
- Mix noodles, carrot, cucumber, cabbage, fish sauce, sugar, and vinegar, toss gently to combine
- Assemble rolls, place sheets of rice paper in a medium bow of warm water until just softened, lift out of water carefully, and place on tea-towel -covered board with corner point facing you. Place vegetable filling horizontally in center of sheet, top with one mint, one basil, and three shrimp haves, and sesame seeds. Fold corner facing you up over filling, rolls sheet to enclose filling, folding in sides after first complete turn of roll. Repeat with remaining sheets.

For Peanut Sauce

• Whisk peanut butter, soy sauce, vinegar, garlic, ginger, boiling water until smooth. Top with peanut and sesame seeds and serve.




