



The Hot Tub is for Adults Only

o one under 18 is permitted in the Hot Tub. Food and drink, of any kind, are not allowed in the pool or hot tub. The hot tub is meant for short sessions only, no longer than 15 minutes. The use



of alcohol combined with the relaxing heat of the hot tub can be a dangerous combination. A person can easily slip under the water unnoticed, and tragedy can strike quickly. Never swim alone. Use the buddy system for safety.

Also, for the health and wellbeing of everyone, please do not go in the hot tub or pool if you are not feeling well, have wounds or open sores.

Guests

dditional guests staying overnight in the park must be registered and paid for. Cost is \$9 per person per night, \$55 per person per week and \$180 per person per month. Residents must accompany their guests while at the pool or other locations and

are responsible for the behavior of their guests. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult who shall assume full responsibility for their safety and conduct.

Driveways

There have been close calls with residents backing out and not looking. We strongly urge residents to obey the one-way arrows. We have seen many

instances where someone has almost gotten hit because of someone going against the arrows.

e have received many complaints about people not cleaning up after their animals and not walking them in the pet area. Pet areas are marked on the map.

Also, all the sports enthusiasts would appreciate it if you did not allow your pets to defecate in the pits that we use for Volleyball, Horseshoes and Petanque. If an accident should happen, please pick up the poop.

Fire Hydrants

e have been asked to advise you not to hang anything on the fire hydrants. It will hinder the fire department if they must come into the park.











Home Site Alterations

If you are making any changes or additions to your home site or the exterior of your home, please come to the office and submit a completed request (green sheet). Paint colors must be approved, and a request form must be approved. Submit your written request and wait until you have received approval before proceeding with any work. Anyone other than the homeowner working on the home must be licensed and insured and we must have a copy of such on file in the office.

To All Residents - Royal Palm Cemetery

R oyal Palm Cemetery is now off limits to all residents with dogs. The cemetery will be putting up "no trespassing" signs for anyone with a dog. There have been many complaints that people are taking their dogs to the cemetery for walks and not cleaning up after them. Anyone caught on cemetery property will be prosecuted.




