

Not ost all of our residents from up north have returned home. Before some folks left, they had their families down for a visit. You could certainly tell who belongs to who at the pool, or out walking or biking around our park. We have had beautiful weather, not too hot or the other extremes not too chilly or wet. Our evenings seem to cool down with wind coming in off the Gulf of Mexico. I don't think some of our residents understand the weather that we can get from June 1st to November 30th, our hurricane season. Residents who have seasoned at Boca Ciega for years have learned by themselves or from the all year rounders that outdoor furniture, bikes and all the other things that make our outdoors so charming during our season at Boca Ciega, have to be put away when the season ends. We all pray that this hurricane season will be kind again to Boca Ciega.

Before Don Boccinfuso left for the season, he said that there were some projects that he wanted to accomplish. One project was to repair the two driveways, one at #28 and the other at #12, and one sidewalk at #11 that were damaged during improvements being made at our park. These driveways and sidewalk have been repaired. The contractor that did the job made a horizontal mark and a vertical mark on the cement in the driveway after it was laid. These two marks should hopefully eliminate cracks from appearing in the future. Some of us know only too well that cracks happen in our driveways. The other project that he wanted to accomplish was to put the hexagonal pavers and white stones around the remaining foxtail palms in our common areas and some on the lots where the home owners requested them. Don said that approximately 80 foxtail palms have been surrounded with the hexagonal pavers and white stones. Next season, perhaps another 50 trees will be planted. Perhaps some will be around Sunshine Lake and anywhere else where a tree has been removed.

Our Friday breakfasts started before everyone had left for the season. At our first breakfast, twenty-five residents came and enjoyed each other's company at Acropol Family Restaurant at 1170 Starkey Road. As the weeks went on, the number attending decreased because folks were leaving to go home. The three restaurants in our rotation besides Acropol, are Benedict's
