Manager's Corner

June...! How can June be here already? It seems like yesterday that our snowbirds (and others) were still here and now they have flown away.

We will anxiously await their return in the fall and bid them all safe travels.

Now that Spring is upon us, so is kitten time. Please remember not to feed feral cats in our park. If you feed them, they will keep coming. They also then grow dependent on us to feed them. This practice also entices raccoons and other critters to come and dine on the cat food and whatever other foods you have left outside as well.

I feel that I must go over "pets" and assistance animals as well. If you see a dog in the park being walked, this dog is *not a pet*. It is either an assistance animal or a service animal. Both are very different, but they are not pets. We cannot refer to them as such either. An assistance animal, formally known as an emotional support animal, and service animals provide two necessary things for their owners. Both have to be prescribed, just as a medication from a healthcare provider. The law has changed regarding the "internet letters". You can still find them, and they are all written in very standard verbiage, but they themselves are no longer "legitimate means" of an animal being allowed in the community. Also, these animals are not allowed into the community without the final approval step, which comes from our attorney. Neither the office, nor the Board of Directors, has any say in this matter. It is our attorney who determines that the qualifications by law and definition are met for them to be here.

People need these animals for various reasons. Please consider this example. If you take a prescription pill, would you want your neighbors telling throughout the community that you don't need to be on that medicine? It really is the same thing. We all need to be considerate of what we are saying about these animals. You never really know the true impact you have on those around you. You never know how much someone needed that smile you gave them or how much your kindness may have turned someone's day completely around. Give a hug, stop and talk to your neighbor, don't wait for someone else to be kind, just do it.

I have been warmly welcomed by many since coming on board here at Sunset Palms. We in the office and the maintenance department strive to keep you all happy. We want you to have a good experience when interacting with any of us. However, we will not tolerate rude behavior and people coming into the office area yelling and using foul language at us. We are here to try to help you. If you come into the office area upset over something, please take a moment to compose yourselves. We realize everyone has "bad days". We are only asking you to treat us in the manner you expect us to treat you.



Lift Station Monthly Reminder – Important

LUSH ONLY: Body waste and toilet paper. It is highly recommended that only one ply toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet.



DON'T FLUSH: Tampons- Sanitary Pads – Diapers – Depends – Swiffer Cloths – Dust Cloths – Wet Wipes – Kleenex – Food, etc.

When we flush, the waste goes into a **holding tank** that has two pumps to expel the waste **<u>UP</u>** and **<u>OUT</u>** into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it, and burns out the motor.

Person of Interest

his month's Person of Interest is the story of two special people (Abel and Nubia), from two different countries in South America, that came to the United States for two different reasons and became citizens of the United States. They met in Pennsylvania and new are harried and enjoying their home in Support Polms. They



now are happily married and enjoying their home in Sunset Palms. The odds that this would happen might be astronomically high, but it did. How this happened and why it happened and the different paths that each one of them took to get here is a very interesting story.

ABEL AQUINO'S STORY OF HIS CHILDHOOD AND EDUCATION

Abel was born and raised in the highlands of Oruro, Bolivia, South America. Elevations in Bolivia reach an impressive 21,463 feet above sea level. Oruro is over 12,200 feet. He was the only child in his family but grew up in a nice neighborhood with many of friends who became his extended family. As a child he was exposed to Catholic and protestant congregations which influenced him a great deal in areas of service and helping the needy. He completed his Elementary and High School education in Oruro.

After graduation he started working at the Mennonite Central Committee. This is a relief and developmental program of the Mennonite Church staffed by Canadian and North American volunteers. His assignment was to be a liaison between Bolivians and volunteers in the areas of

education, health, nutrition and agricultural programs. In 1976 he participated on an international exchange program in the USA for one year, along with 68 young people from Asia, Africa, and Europe. It was an important time for beginning to develop his understanding of other cultures and languages. After completing this program, he began his studies at Goshen College in Goshen, Indiana, and attended graduate school at Regent University in Virginia. There he completed his studies in Communications and Social services. By this time he could speak several different languages, including, Spanish, Quechua, Brazilian, Portuguese and English. Soon after he was married in Puerto Rico. He has two daughters and three Grandchildren, who now reside in Pennsylvania.

A significant part of his career included working at the headquarters of the Mennonite Central Committee at Akron, PA. There he spent about 15 years working in the areas of Peace Education, Draft Counseling, Job Training and Community Development. Assignments that allowed him to travel across the USA, Central America, and South America. In 1984 he spent a month in the USSR. While there he got to visit Kiev, Odessa, Stalingrad, Belarus, Rostov and some areas of Siberia. This time was sponsored by the World Council of Churches, with the purpose of gaining better understanding of Soviet society and easing the political mistrust between communities. The rest of his time was devoted to social service with the non-profit organization in the areas of assisted living for adults with disabilities. He has also worked for the Department of Health in Child Protection and Immigration Services.

NUBIA ALZATE'S STORY OF HER CHILDHOOD AND EDUCATION

Nubia was born and raised in Medellin, Columbia, South America. She came from a large family with 9 men and 3 women. She was the second born and the first daughter. That allowed her to be able to help raise the younger siblings. She was fortunate to have wonderful parents who made sure that they got an education and took them on vacation once or twice a year and usually went to the beach. They are a united family and get together frequently to share their stories of growing up and laughed a lot about their memories. They are an educated family, and she is an accountant, the rest of her brothers and sisters are Medical Doctors, Engineers, Accountants, Agronomist, and teachers.

She has worked as a Fiscal Auditor, and a teacher at the University of Medellin. She got married to a classmate and has one daughter and two beautiful grandchildren. Her first marriage lasted for 5 years and was then single for 15 years. Her daughter and Grandchildren reside in Pennsylvania.

Due to the political and drug unrest in Columbia, Nubia and her daughter immigrated to the USA and resided close to her sister in Pennsylvania. Her sisters and one of her brothers are in the USA and the other brothers are still in Columbia. In 2021, while in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, she met Abel. There, Abel lived close to her brother's house in and that is where she met him. They
