

FROM THE OFFICE Jessie Buchholtz, Park Manager

The park office will be up and running...or very close to it! Thanks to everyone for respecting my privacy and only coming during office hours, but please forget where I live now, all Embassy business will be conducted during office hours!

Throughout this temporary situation, some of you may have gotten Joelle and my cellphone numbers, even my home phone number. Please know that the park DOES NOT pay for our phones, so they are not to be used for park business unless we personally tell you to call us back on it. I have given my cellphone to some people for emergencies or other reasons, not to have park complaints during all hours of the day and night. We will block you!

Speaking of office hours, during renovation we retrieved voicemails on a regular basis; a lot of them could not be understood or were from someone so drunk I couldn't understand them, or no name or Lot number. It is hard enough for Joelle and I to put a name, face, and Lot number together with over 400 lots, let alone identify a voice!

If you are making a complaint, you must identify yourself, the person, lot number and the problem. The reason for this is that I cannot make a court eviction case for rule violations unless you are willing to come forward if I have to take it to court. A lot of times I can fix something you complained about, and I would like to update you on the steps that I took.

Something to be thankful for....that you can walk wherever you want, and that your mobility is not limited to an electric scooter! It is often difficult to maneuver scooters in the Clubhouse; the easiest way for them to be out of the way is to sit (park) at the end of the tables. All disabilities are not visible, and most importantly, not everybody's business! Please respect the residents who are dealing with limited disabilities when they attend park functions. Electric Scooters on the street should be operated the same as a car, on the correct side of the street and observing all the stop signs.

A reminder about wasting water...."In Park" car washes are limited to twice a week, (Rule 16C) the same goes for jet skis and boats; most boat ramp areas provide hoses to wash off the salt water; use them instead of doing it in the Park! Higher water bills can increase rent, so do your share in keeping the water bills down. Once a month, maintenance walks the entire park looking for leaks, leaking hose bibs, valves, etc. in an effort to keep the bills lower.

The lawn mowing is on an "every other week" basis; it will go to weekly once the daily rains begin.
