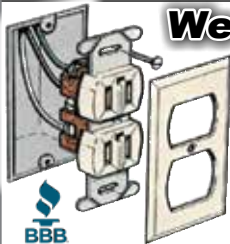

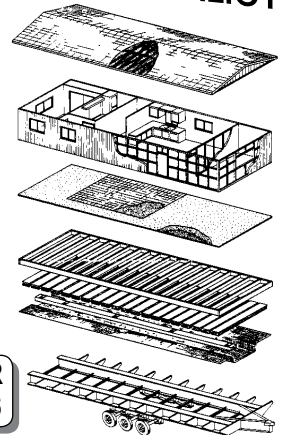

carports and yards and most recently the removal of grass and replacing it with rocks, mulch or other items. We will go over a couple of these items and save the rest for future articles. The exterior of homes will need to be maintained per park standards, so you must pressure wash your home. In the event that you do not, Teakwood Village has the right (per the Rules and Regulations) to have the work done, at your expense, and there will be a fee attached for the handling of this matter.

As you are all aware, you MAY NOT add or change anything about the outside of the home/lot without WRITTEN PERMISSION from Teakwood Village MHP Management. You must submit, in writing, the request and await approval before you begin a project. We are particularly looking at anyone who removed their lawns and replaced with decorative rocks or mulch. The Rules and Regulations specifically state that each lot must be fully sodded unless otherwise approved, in writing, by management. If you have not received written approval for the rocks, mulch, etc. you will be told to remove the unapproved material and replace with sod. Teakwood Village reserves the right to remove said unapproved materials, at your expense.

To recap: Pressure wash or paint your home and make sure you have sod for a yard.

After that sit back, admire your clean home and grass filled yard while you celebrate National Iced Tea Month with a big glass, maybe with a slice of lemon.

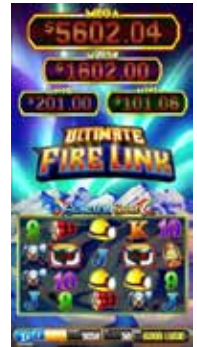

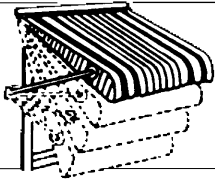

Recently a friend and I went to Miller’s Ale House for a birthday celebration. The company and conversation were great! The cocktails and food were a disappointment. Normally I don’t order cutesy cocktails but on the menu card the “Blackberry Bourbon Smash” just looked sooo good & refreshing. Instead of being a deep purple/red color garnished with mint, my drink was a barely pinkish lavender, watery sweet concoction. If there was more than a thimble full of Marker’s Mark in it, I would be surprised. My friend decided to have a Manhattan. It was supposed to be served straight up but came over ice & it too was extremely weak. She ordered a second straight up and was told that it would cost a little more as they use more alcohol (no ice cubes to take up the space). It was better but still not very good.

The Thursday Special is “Prime Rib” which my friend ordered. At \$15.99 that sounds like a good deal as it comes with mashed potatoes and steamed broccoli. Though it was cooked to order, medium-rare, it was chewy and had no flavor. Instead of the sides that come with the dish my friend ordered “Sweet Potato Fries”. They were crisp on the outside and tender in the middle. They were the best food of the evening. I ordered the “Steak Fajita” (\$14.99). The steak was cooked properly and was tender, but it had absolutely no flavor. It should have had at least a little Mexican zip to it. This restaurant doesn’t do much with seasonings. The menu picture showed the steak sitting on top of a pile of sauteed onions and red, green & orange bell peppers. I got 8-9 onion strips and 2 orange pepper strips. The side of lettuce, tomato & shredded cheese was also very skimpy. The only thing they weren’t stingy with was the sour cream. The guacamole cost extra and not much of it for the price.

They had some interesting looking desserts, but we decided not to go there both because of the calories and the fact that nothing so far had lived up to expectations. Our total bills, before tip, came to about \$78. Not bad for a good meal for two, but too much for such a mediocre one. This is not a restaurant I will go to again.

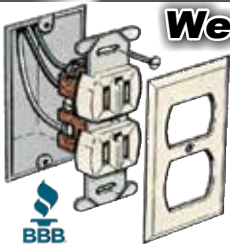

and the cost was more than what we paid at Jupiter Donuts of Largo down Missouri Avenue in the other direction.

Jupiter is a small place at 13002 Seminole Blvd designed predominantly for pick-up and delivery although we were able to garner the only tiny table outside the store. I swear you can gain weight just looking at their donuts. So many heavenly delights made choosing difficult. These donuts are a color burst compared to Dunkin. My first donut was glazed with bright pink icing and a dollop of creme atop. Far too much sugar but, hey, occasionally you have to give in to those distressed cries emanating from your body, “Sugar, sugar.” I actually preferred my second donut, yes, second. It was called a Samoa, like the Girl Scout cookie and had a drizzle of chocolate with toasted coconut. OMG.



These donuts were fairly large. A glazed donut begins at \$2.69. You could try the maple bacon for \$3.50. As a reminder, Jupiter is open for take-out and delivery Wed-Mon from 6 am – 1 pm and Wed – Sat 4 – 11 pm Closed Tuesday. Call 727-732-6358.

THE BEST & WORST CHEESES FOR A HEALTHY HEART

If you’ve been watching what you eat to boost your heart health or reduce your waistline, you might be surprised to hear that you can incorporate cheese into a heart-healthy diet. The key lies in choosing the best cheeses for heart health, such as reduced-fat cheeses, and avoiding processed cheese (the worst cheese for heart health). Let this list help guide your cheese choices for heart health:



1. BEST: Reduced Sodium Feta or Goat Cheese – Unripened cheeses contain less fat but can be high in sodium so be sure to get low sodium, even better if you can get reduced fat
2. BEST: Fat-free or reduced fat cottage cheese - Cottage cheese packs a calcium wallop, along with B vitamins and magnesium—all of which are important nutrients for heart health. Be sure to compare labels as some brands are higher in sodium than others.
3. BEST: Reduced Fat Ricotta Cheese - Ricotta cheese not only tastes great, but it contains nearly 1/3 of your daily protein requirement in a 1/2 Cup serving. However, traditional ricotta usually is loaded with saturated fat, so choose low-fat (and low-sodium) versions of ricotta when you feel like enjoying this mild, soft cheese.
4. BEST: Fresh, part-skim mozzarella cheese - This mild cheese is perfect for snacking on because it’s generally lower in sodium and saturated fat than other cheese choices. As a bonus, fresh mozzarella usually contains beneficial active cultures like Lactobacillus, which promote gut health. Some research suggests that good gut health can reduce overall body inflammation, which benefits your blood vessels and heart.

5. **BEST: Reduced-fat Cheddar** - Unripened cheeses make the best choice for heart health, but you can consume harder, ripened cheeses like cheddar and Monterey jack as long as you choose reduced-fat versions. Ripened cheeses contain more fat than unripened varieties, and you should read labels carefully because the amount of fat and sodium can vary between brands and cheese varieties. Remember that a serving size for any ripened cheese is one ounce (or roughly a one-inch cube), so indulge mindfully.
6. **WORST: American cheese slices** - American cheese slices are made from cheesemaking byproducts with added fats and colorants. American cheese is a highly processed product, often with a high sodium content. A single slice of American cheese can contain as much as 25% of the recommended daily intake of saturated fat, which is very high for anyone aiming to improve their heart health.
7. **Worst: Pasteurized Process Cheese Spread** - Whether it comes in a box or a jar, these pasteurized, processed cheeses contain very high levels of calories, saturated fat, and sodium—all of which are bad for your cardiovascular health.
8. **Worst: Brie** - Brie and other super-soft cheeses like Camembert contain far too much fat to make them a healthy choice for the heart or the waistline. These cheeses are made with lots of cream, which makes them soft and luscious — but also far too easy to over-indulge on.

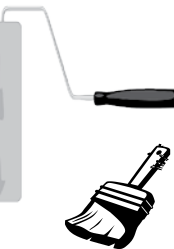

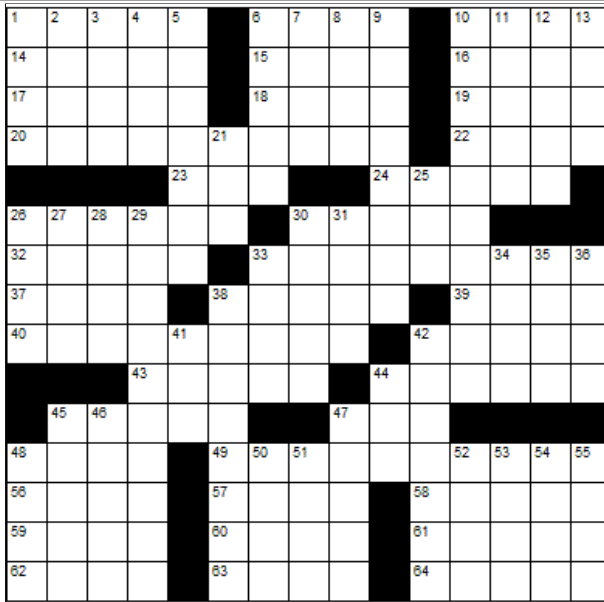

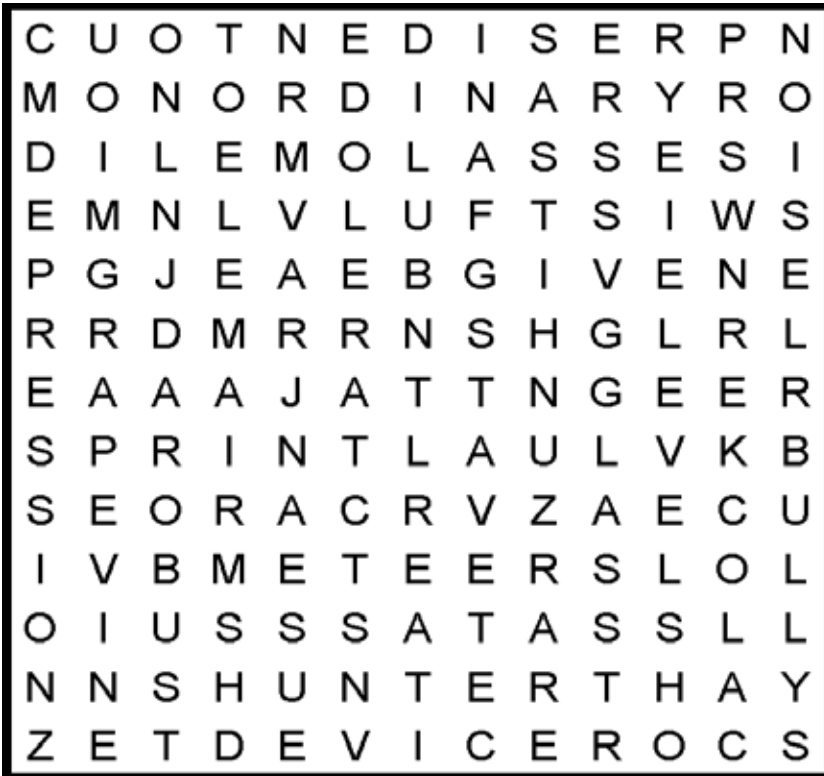
