Recipes

Stuffed peppers

Ingredients

- 4 large bell peppers (any color)
- 1 lb lean (at least 80%) ground beef
- 2 t ablespoons chopped onion
- 1 cup cooked rice
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 clove garlic, finely chopped
- 1 can (15 oz) Muir GlenTM organic tomato sauce
- 3/4 cup shredded mozzarella cheese (3 oz)



- 2. Cut thin slice from stem end of each bell pepper to remove top of pepper. Remove seeds and membranes; rinse peppers. If necessary, cut thin slice from bottom of each pepper so they stand up straight. In 4-quart Dutch oven, add enough water to cover peppers. Heat to boiling; add peppers. Cook about 2 minutes; drain.
- 3. In 10-inch skillet, cook beef and onion over medium heat 8 to 10 minutes, stirring occasionally, until beef is brown; drain. Stir in rice, salt, garlic and 1 cup of the tomato sauce; cook until hot.
- 4. Stuff peppers with beef mixture. Stand peppers upright in ungreased 8-inch square glass baking dish. Pour remaining tomato sauce over peppers.
- 5. Cover tightly with foil. Bake 10 minutes. Uncover and bake about 15 minutes longer or until peppers are tender. Sprinkle with cheese.

SPAGHETTI & MEATBALLS

MEATBALLS: 2 POUNDS LEAN HAMBERG (GROUND CHUCK)

1 Cup Bread Crumbs

³/₄ Cup grated Romano Cheese

3 eggs

1/4 cup water

1 heaping Tablespoon Parsley

1 Tbsp. basil

1 Tbsp. granulated garlic (or minced)

Salt and Pepper to taste

Mix thoroughly. Rub hands with water, make meatballs (lg. tablespoon), place in microwave dish and micro for 5 minutes. Let cool.

SPAGHETTI SAUCE

2 Cans of Tomato Puree

1 pound pork pieces (neck bones)

1 Can water

Cook Puree and water on moderate heat until starts to boil, stirring constantly. Add: 1 lg. Tbsp. parsley, 1 Tbsp. basil, and 1 Tbsp. granulated garlic. Salt and Pepper to taste

Using cleaned pork neck bones or pork pieces, microwave for 6 minutes, then add to boiling sauce. Cook ½ hour over mod. Heat. Add cooled meatballs and cook for another ½ hour.

I also add $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. baking soda when sauce first starts to boil to counteract the acid taste. OR $\frac{1}{2}$ tsp. allspice

He saw a trainer standing nearby and asked why the elephants made no attempt to get away.




The visitor was amazed. These enormous beasts could break free from their bonds whenever they wanted, but because they thought they couldn't, they were stuck right where they were.
