



SPORTS COMPLEX PROPOSAL

In an article by Chris George form Tampa Bay Newspapers, it is sighted that a developer is asking for approval to develop the old landfill north of Lincolnshire into a sports tourism destination. The sale of the property to the developer would require voter approval in a referendum in the next election. Please note that only registered Florida voters with voter registration within the city of Largo will be able to vote on this sale and the transformation of the property in to this complex. The site is a former landfill which would be decontaminated and reverse any environmental damage done to the site when it was a landfill. The site consultant is confident that that the recreational use is one of the best uses for remediation efforts

According to the newspaper article, the reporter quotes one of our commissioners as stating, "they are aware of the concerns and think the sports complex is a better fit with the community, which includes the Lincolnshire Estates mobile home park across the street."



The HOA only works through the support of all its members. If the HOA is going to attempt to represent you on your concerns and issues that effect all, we need a majority of the Park as signed up members.

B ased on the number of emails and phone messages that came in while I was away for 2 weeks, regarding the new rent billing system, we learned that the communications from the Park Owner/Management has little to no support in explanation and we understand the confusion.

There are a few ways to pay your rent:

- 1. Allow Rickert Properties to "Auto-Pull" your monthly amount automatically without any input from you. (This is the least appreciated or used for obvious reasons).
- 2. Electronically send your payment using the new Community Resident Portal sign on system each month. You have the option of paying by Checking Account or Credit Card. Don't be surprised if there will be an additional fee for processing Credit Card payments. (This requires you to sign on and process as instructed). Be careful. If you mis-type account information, some owners have already been charged a penalty fee.
- 3. Write out your normal handwritten check and pay directly to the Business Office in the Clubhouse. (I would always recommend you request a written receipt dated with day you delivered it.)

No matter what system you use, you still have to register with "Community Residential Portal." When you register, there is a place to check for monthly email notification that the new invoice is ready for your viewing/downloading/printing. If you forgot to check for email notification, you can sign on and edit your information.

CAUTION: This is a new system and there have already been problems. Especially if you are trying to pay early. I found that the Business Office does not have all information as to water meter reading and/or this new "Admin Fee".



he "dog days of summer" are about to arrive in Lincolnshire. Is your pet prepared? Here are some things you might not know, especially if you have outdoor plans. Don't let fleas and worms ruin the fun. It's heating up in our area, and I want your humans to know what we need to stay comfortable. Pesky fleas and worms will be more active in summer months. Please make sure you pet is protected from fleas, heartworm disease and icky intestinal worms. Hookworms like



humidity and thrive in warm damp soil. Whipworms are hardy and eggs can survive extreme temperatures for years. Roundworm infection is very common and likely if you pet is often outdoors. Heartworm disease is year-round in warm climates. And of course, we all know that flea development depends on increased temperature and humidity and affects cats as much as dogs. Keep you pets safe with proper protection.

Another important thing to remember is that HOT ASPHALT is dangerous to you pet. When the air is 77° the asphalt is about 125° - at 86° the asphalt is 135° - and at 87° it climbs above 143° It takes less than a minute at these temperatures for skin destruction. Paws will get burned – remember – if it's too hot for you bare feet – it's too hot for theirs!



VETERAN'S CORNER

Do you qualify for a Veterans Pension?

any veterans of wartime service are completely unaware of the fact that if they are 65 or older and on a limited income, they may qualify for a VA Pension without being disabled. If you are a wartime veteran with a limited income and you are no longer able to work, you may qualify for a Veterans Disability Pension or the Veterans



Pension for veterans 65 years or older. You may qualify for a veteran's pension if: You were discharged from service under other than dishonorable conditions, AND you served 90 days or more of active duty with at least 1 day during a period of wartime, or; you are permanently and totally disabled or are age 65 or older. You also must have limited income and a limited net worth or assets to qualify for a VA pension. Net worth includes your and your spouse's assets and annual income. When you apply for Veterans Pension benefits, you'll need to report all of these assets and income. The 2022 asset limit for VA pension is \$138,489.

You can apply online through the VA's website.

Affordable Connectivity Program

Discount Internet the Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more. The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price. The Affordable Connectivity Program is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

Who Is Eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program?

A household is eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program if the household income is at or below 200% of the <u>Federal Poverty Guidelines</u>, or if a member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income internet



program; Participates in one of these assistance programs: Medicaid, Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits.

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #48

Te all must recognize that there is still Covid-virus concerns remaining that can affect us both nationally and locally. We also will soon be in the 2022 hurricane season. However, ignoring either won't make this yearly summer-fall weather go away. The Atlantic hurricane season usually runs from June 1st through November 30th. Most finding their roots in West Africa in late August through September. NOAA prediction is more in number and severity. For year-rounders like myself (there are more now in the park) this is our storm and wet season.

Without being specific to any chronic condition let's say that you must have certain medications, oxygen, nursing services, dialysis, just had major surgery, batteries for equipment vital to your survival that require replenishment within 10 days. Why 10 days? In a major weather event or disaster the supply of what you absolutely need to live isn't around the corner anymore, plus the supply lines to vendors, pharmacies, hospitals, clinics, home health can be threatened. Especially now with the severe disruptions caused by world events. We live in a new supply world where large expensive reserves of almost everything are no longer kept close to us. Vital medical supply chains are being further constrained. Dependence on USPS, UPS and FedEx is pervasive. We are somewhat fortunate in we live in a location where supplies most seniors need are more plentiful but not endless. Being a global economy our medical supplies still and often come from outside the U.S!

As an RN in Florida's Disaster response team we start with when to actually start preparing. **TODAY!** Preparing isn't as hard as we think. Take it one step at a time. Starting now means you won't rush and forget something vital.

The first is life sustaining equipment. Oxygen and the equipment required to deliver is #1. Find an invoice from the vendor who brings the oxygen and maintains the devices. Put the invoice in an envelope that you will fill with other information. Take a picture with your phone too. If you have large oxygen canisters, they will be hard to transport. Oxygen concentrators can be heavy though newer versions are much lighter. You can't expect every shelter will have unlimited oxygen available. If any. Always register early with the shelters. Also shelters may not have consistent electricity to power equipment. If your equipment has rechargeable batteries

then keep them charged! **Pinellas County Disaster management can help you know** where the best shelter are for you! Staying at home may not be an option and can be deadly. Mandatory evacuations mean emergency services have shutdown. The police will drive through our park several times and tell us still here that we are now on our own. Don't die in your coach.

The second is medications. If you don't have a current list of your medications then you can write down your own or better have you pharmacy print your list. Medication organizers are a must to have. Also reminds me what day it is! However the downside is that someone else has no idea what each pill is. Believe me. So, keep a least one pill in their original container from the pharmacy. Do not ever wait until the last minute to have your medications including syringes refilled. Remember, shelters don't have pharmacies and getting some vital medications in a disaster can be very difficult if not impossible. Get a plastic container with a locking lid to store all of your medications. Put your full name on the container. Got a pet on meds? Do the same.

Some liquid medications require refrigeration. Often they come in a Styrofoam container. Keep one, always! Don't toss the frozen ice bag either. Get ready and start today. Help a neighbor get ready too. We are a community. Love you all.






